Quilt Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting.

Fabrics are cut to exact length required plus 1/4" seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

Fabric A Cut (1) 8 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 8 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (4) 8 7/8" triangles. *Note: You will only use (3) 8 7/8" triangles.*
Cut (1) 6 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (3) 6 1/2" squares and (3) 4 1/2" squares.

Fabric B Cut (1) 8 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 8 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (4) 8 7/8" triangles. *Note: You will only use (3) 8 7/8" triangles.*
Cut (1) 6 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (3) 6 1/2" squares and (3) 4 1/2" squares.

Fabric C Cut (1) 8 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 8 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (4) 8 7/8" triangles. *Note: You will only use (3) 8 7/8" triangles.*
Cut (1) 6 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (3) 6 1/2" squares and (3) 4 1/2" squares.

Fabric D Cut (1) 8 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 8 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (4) 8 7/8" triangles. *Note: You will only use (3) 8 7/8" triangles.*
Cut (1) 6 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (3) 6 1/2" squares and (3) 4 1/2" squares.

Fabric E Cut (1) 8 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 8 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make

Cut (1) 6 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (3) 6 1/2" squares and (3) 4 1/2" squares.

Fabric F Cut (1) 8 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 8 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (4) 8 7/8" triangles. *Note: You will only use (3) 8 7/8" triangles.*

Cut (1) 6 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (3) 6 1/2" squares and (3) 4 1/2" squares.

Fabric G Cut (2) 6 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (12) 6 1/2" squares.
Cut (2) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (12) 4 1/2" squares.

Fabric H Cut (4) 6 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (24) 6 1/2" squares.
Cut (3) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (24) 4 1/2" squares.

Fabric I Cut (1) 8 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 8 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (4) 8 $\frac{7}{8}$ " triangles. *Note: You will only use (3) 8 $\frac{7}{8}$ " triangles.*
Cut (1) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (3) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares and (3) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Fabric J Cut (1) 8 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 8 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (4) 8 $\frac{7}{8}$ " triangles. *Note: You will only use (3) 8 $\frac{7}{8}$ " triangles.*
Cut (1) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (3) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares and (3) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Fabric K Cut (1) 8 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 8 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (4) 8 $\frac{7}{8}$ " triangles. *Note: You will only use (3) 8 $\frac{7}{8}$ " triangles.*
Cut (1) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (3) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares and (3) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Fabric L Cut (1) 8 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 8 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (4) 8 $\frac{7}{8}$ " triangles. *Note: You will only use (3) 8 $\frac{7}{8}$ " triangles.*
Cut (1) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (3) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares and (3) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Fabric M Cut (1) 8 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 8 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (4) 8 $\frac{7}{8}$ " triangles. *Note: You will only use (3) 8 $\frac{7}{8}$ " triangles.*
Cut (1) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (3) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares and (3) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Fabric N Cut (2) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (12) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
Cut (2) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (12) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Fabric O Cut (1) 8 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 8 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (4) 8 $\frac{7}{8}$ " triangles. *Note: You will only use (3) 8 $\frac{7}{8}$ " triangles.*
Cut (1) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (3) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares and (3) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Fabric P Cut (1) 8 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 8 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (4) 8 $\frac{7}{8}$ " triangles. *Note: You will only use (3) 8 $\frac{7}{8}$ " triangles.*
Cut (1) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (3) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares and (3) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Fabric Q Cut (6) 8 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (24) 8 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (48) 8 $\frac{7}{8}$ " triangles.

Fabric R Cut (1) 8 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 8 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (4) 8 $\frac{7}{8}$ " triangles. *Note: You will only use (3) 8 $\frac{7}{8}$ " triangles.*
Cut (1) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (3) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares and (3) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Fabric S Cut (1) 8 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 8 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (4) 8 $\frac{7}{8}$ " triangles. *Note: You will only use (3) 8 $\frac{7}{8}$ " triangles.*
Cut (1) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (3) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares and (3) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Fabric T Cut (1) 8 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 8 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (4) 8 $\frac{7}{8}$ " triangles. *Note: You will only use (3) 8 $\frac{7}{8}$ " triangles.*
Cut (1) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (3) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares and (3) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Binding Cut (6) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips.

Backing Cut (2) 56" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make (1) 56" x 72" backing.

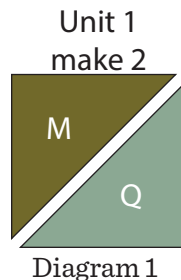

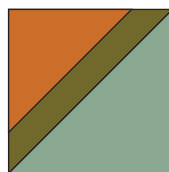
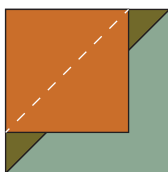
Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.

Block Assembly

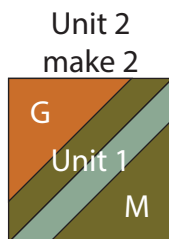
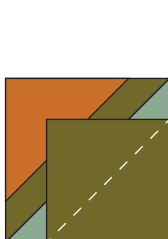
1. Sew together (1) $8\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric M triangle and (1) $8\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric Q triangle along their long sides to make (1) $8\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 1 square (Diagram 1). Repeat to make a second Unit 1 square.



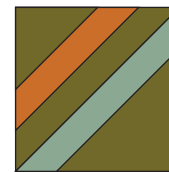
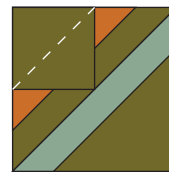
2. Place (1) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G square on the top left corner of (1) Unit 1 square, right sides together (Diagram 2). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 2). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 3). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the sewn seam.



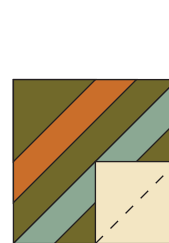
3. Follow Diagram 4 for the seam direction to add a $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric M square to the lower right corner of the Unit 1 square to make (1) $8\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 2 square (Diagram 5).
4. Repeat Steps 2-3 to make a second Unit 2 square.



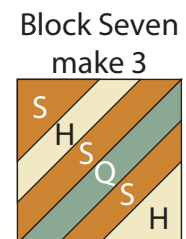
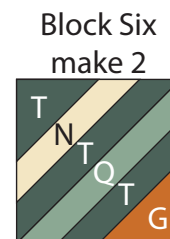
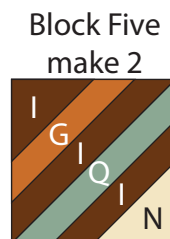
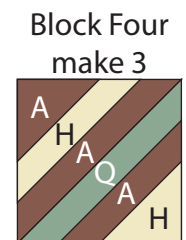
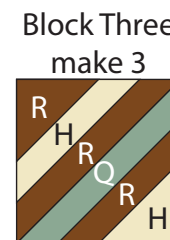
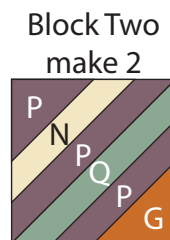
5. Place (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric M square on the top left corner of (1) Unit 2 square, right sides together (Diagram 6). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 6). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 7). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the sewn seam.



6. Follow Diagram 8 for the seam direction to add a $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric N square to the lower right corner of the Unit 2 square to make (1) $8\frac{1}{2}$ " Block One square (Diagram 9).
7. Repeat Steps 5-6 to make a second Block One square.



8. Repeat Steps 1-6 and refer to Diagrams 10-32 for fabric identification and placement to make the indicated number of $8\frac{1}{2}$ " block squares for Block Two through Block Twenty-Four.

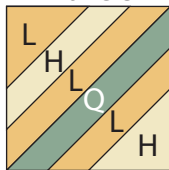

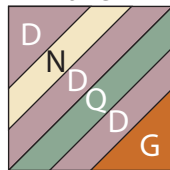

make 1

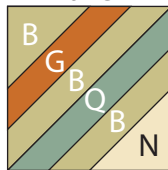

make 1

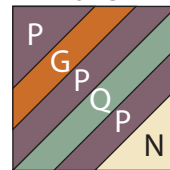

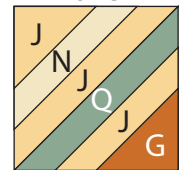

make 3

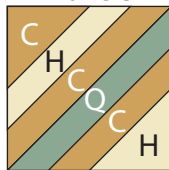

make 3

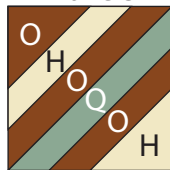

make 2

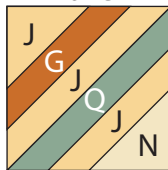

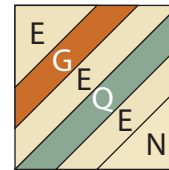

make 2

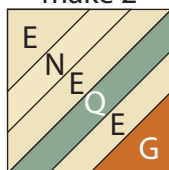

make 3

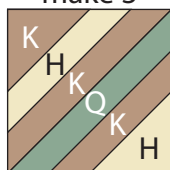

make 3

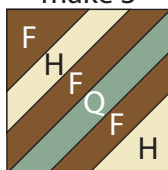

make 1

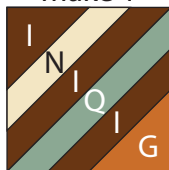

make 2

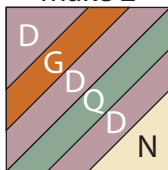

make 2

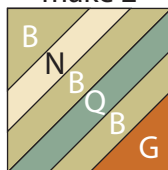

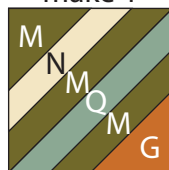

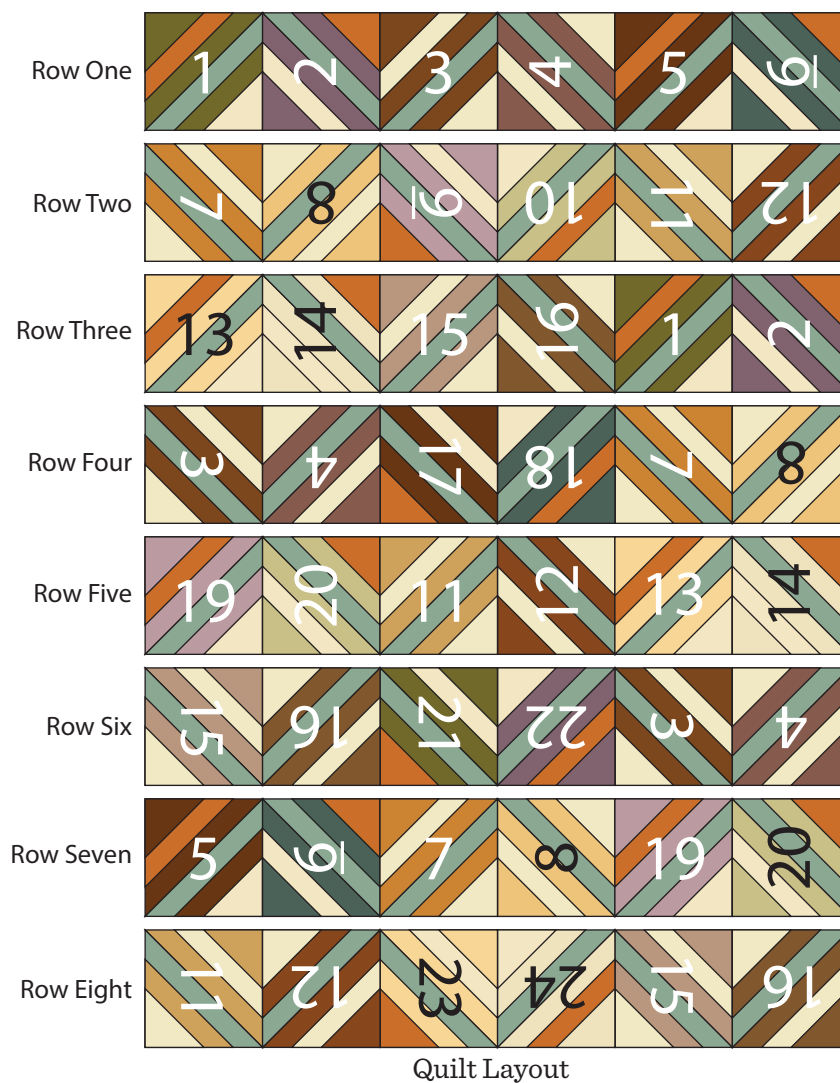
Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the *Quilt Layout* when assembling the quilt top.)

9. Sew together (6) assorted block squares as shown to make Row One.
10. Repeat Step 9 and refer to the *Quilt Layout* for block identification, placement and orientation to make Row Two through Row Eight.
11. Sew together the (8) pieced Rows, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the Quilt Top.

Finishing the Quilt

12. Layer and quilt as desired.
13. Sew together the (6) binding strips end to end with 45-degree seams. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
14. Bind as desired.



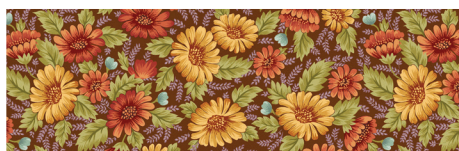
