

## Quilt Cutting Directions

**Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches.** Borders are cut to exact length required plus  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

**Fabric A** Cut (2) 2  $\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (18) 2  $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares and (2) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

**Fabric B** Cut (1) 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (1) 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " square, (6) 2  $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares and (2) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

**Fabric C** Cut (1) 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (3) 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares and (4) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Cut (2) 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (6) 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Cut (2) 2  $\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (24) 2  $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.

**Fabric D** Cut (1) 2  $\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (12) 2  $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.

**Fabric E** Cut (1) 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (1) 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " square and (6) 2  $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.

**Fabric F** Cut (1) 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (1) 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares and (2) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Cut (2) 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (5) 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips, and (6) 2  $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.

**Fabric G** Cut (1) 2  $\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (12) 2  $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.

**Fabric H** Cut (1) 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (1) 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " square and (6) 2  $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.

**Fabric I** Cut (2) 2  $\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (24) 2  $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.

Cut (1) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (6) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

**Fabric J** Cut (2) 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (7) 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " square and (4) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Cut (2) 2  $\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (24) 2  $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.

**Fabric K** Cut (1) 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares and (6) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Cut (2) 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (5) 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Cut (8) 2  $\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (99) 2  $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.

## Quilt Cutting Directions - Continued

**Fabric L** Cut (11) 2 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (150) 2 7/8" squares.

**Fabric M** Cut (6) 2 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (75) 2 7/8" squares.  
Cut (3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (48) 2 1/2" squares.

**Fabric N** Cut (1) 6 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (1) 6 1/2" square, (6) 2 7/8" squares and (2) 2 1/2" squares.

**Fabric O** Cut (1) 2 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (6) 2 7/8" squares.

**Fabric P** Cut (2) 2 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (18) 2 7/8" squares and (2) 2 1/2" squares.

**Fabric Q** Cut (1) 6 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (3) 6 1/2" square and (6) 2 7/8" squares.

**Fabric R** Cut (1) 2 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (12) 2 7/8" squares.

**Fabric S** Cut (2) 2 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (12) 2 7/8" squares and (2) 2 1/2" squares.

**Fabric T** Cut (1) 6 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 6 1/2" squares and (4) 2 1/2" squares.  
Cut (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 4 1/2" x 10 1/2" strips.  
Cut (1) 2 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (12) 2 7/8" squares.

**Fabric U** Cut (1) 6 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 6 1/2" squares and (4) 2 1/2" squares.  
Cut (2) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (5) 4 1/2" x 10 1/2" strips.  
Cut (2) 2 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (18) 2 7/8" squares.

**Fabric V** Cut (2) 2 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (18) 2 7/8" squares and (4) 2 1/2" squares.

## Fabric W

Cut (2) 2 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (12) 2 7/8" squares and (2) 2 1/2" squares.

## Fabric X

Cut (2) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (5) 4 1/2" x 10 1/2" strips, (6) 2 7/8" squares and (2) 2 1/2" squares.

## Binding

Cut (7) 2 1/2" x WOF strips.

## Backing


Cut (2) 88" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make (1) 68" x 88" backing.

## Making the Quilt


**Note:** Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.

### Block Assembly

1. Place (1) 2 7/8" Fabric K square on top of (1) 2 7/8" Fabric L square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Diagram 1). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 1). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 2) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 2 1/2" square to make (2) Unit 1 squares (Diagram 3). Repeat to make an additional (148) Unit 1 squares.



2. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Diagram 4 for fabric identification and placement to make (150) Unit 2 squares.

3. Sew together (5) Unit 1 squares as shown to make the top row. Sew together (5) Unit 2 squares as shown to make the bottom row. Sew together the (2) rows lengthwise to make (1)  $10\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$  Block One rectangle (Diagram 5). Repeat to make an additional (14) Block One rectangles.

4. Sew together (5) Unit 2 squares as shown to make the top row. Sew together (5) Unit 1 squares as shown to make the bottom row. Sew together the (2) rows lengthwise to make (1)  $10\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$  Block Two rectangle (Diagram 6). Repeat to make an additional (14) Block Two rectangles.



5. Place (1)  $2\frac{1}{8}''$  Fabric P square on top of (1)  $2\frac{1}{8}''$  Fabric U square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Diagram 7). Sew  $\frac{1}{4}''$  away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 8). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 8) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure  $2\frac{1}{2}''$  square to make (2) Unit 3 squares (Diagram 9). Repeat to make an additional (10) Unit 3 squares.







6. Sew together (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}''$  Fabric U square, (3) Unit 3 squares and (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}''$  Fabric M square, in that order from left to right, to make the top row (Diagram 10).

7. Sew together (3) Unit 3 squares as shown. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) newly sewn strip to each side of (1)  $6\frac{1}{2}''$  Fabric J square to make the middle row (Diagram 10).

8. Sew together (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}''$  Fabric M square, (3) Unit 3 squares and (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}''$  Fabric U square, in that order from left to right, to make the bottom row (Diagram 10).

9. Sew together the (3) rows from Steps 6-8 lengthwise to make (1)  $10\frac{1}{2}''$  Block Three square (Diagram 10).







## Quilt Top Assembly


*(Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)*

11. Sew together (1) 4 1/2" x 10 1/2" Fabric T strip, (1) 4 1/2" x 10 1/2" Fabric F strip, (1) 4 1/2" x 10 1/2" Fabric C strip, (1) 4 1/2" x 10 1/2" Fabric U strip, (1) 4 1/2" x 10 1/2" Fabric K strip and (1) 4 1/2" x 10 1/2" Fabric X strip, end to end and in that order from left to right, to make Row One.
12. Repeat Step 11 and refer to the Quilt Layout for component identification, placement and orientation to make Row Four, Row Seven, Row Ten and Row Thirteen.
13. Sew (3) Block One rectangles and (3) Block Two rectangles together end to end and alternating them from left to right to make Row Two. Repeat to make Row Five, Row Eight, Row Eleven and Row Fourteen.
14. Sew (1) Block Three square, (1) Block Four square, (1) Block Five square, (1) Block Six square, (1) Block Seven square and (1) Block Eight square together in that order from left to right to make Row Three.
15. Repeat Step 14 and refer to the Quilt Layout for component identification, placement and orientation to make Row Six, Row Nine and Row Twelve.
16. Sew the (14) rows together lengthwise and in numerical order from the top to the bottom to make the Quilt Top.
17. Layer and quilt as desired.
18. Sew together the (7) binding strips end to end with 45-degree seams. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
19. Bind as desired.




