

Quilt Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. Borders are cut to exact length required plus ¼" seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

LOF designates the length of fabric running parallel to the selvages.

Fabric A Cut (1) 4 ½" x 8 ½" strip.
Cut (4) 4 ½" squares.

Fabric B Cut (1) 4 ½" x 8 ½" strip.
Cut (4) 4 ½" squares.

Fabric C Cut (2) 4 ½" x 55 ½" LOF strips.
From the remaining fabric cut:
(2) 4 ½" x 63 ½" WOF strips, piece as needed.
(1) 4 ½" x 8 ½" strip.
(4) 4 ½" squares.

Fabric D Cut (1) 8 ½" x 4 ½" strip.
Cut (4) 4 ½" squares.

Fabric E Cut (1) 4 ½" x 8 ½" strip.
Cut (4) 4 ½" squares.

Fabric F Cut (1) 4 ½" x 8 ½" strip.
Cut (4) 4 ½" squares.

Fabric G Cut (1) 4 ½" x 8 ½" strip.
Cut (4) 4 ½" squares.

Fabric H Cut (1) 4 ½" x 8 ½" strip.
Cut (4) 4 ½" squares.

Fabric I Cut (1) 4 ½" x 8 ½" strip.
Cut (4) 4 ½" squares.

Fabric J Cut (1) 4 ½" x 8 ½" strip.
Cut (4) 4 ½" squares.

Fabric K Cut (1) 4 ½" x 8 ½" strip.
Cut (4) 4 ½" squares.

Fabric L Cut (1) 4 ½" x 8 ½" strip.
Cut (4) 4 ½" squares.

Fabric M Cut (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 55 ½" strips.
Cut (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 52 ½" strips.

Fabric N Cut (6) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (12) 4 ½" x 16 ½" strips.
Cut (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 52 ½" strips.
Cut (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 48 ½" strips.
Cut (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (24) 2 ½" x 8 ½" strips.
Cut (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (48) 2 ½" squares.
Cut (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (96) 1 ½" squares.

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Quilt Cutting Directions - Continued

Binding Cut (7) 2 1/2" x WOF strips.

Backing Cut (2) 71" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make (1) 71" x 71" backing.

Making the Quilt


Note: The arrows in diagrams represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

Block Assembly


1. Place (1) 1 1/2" Fabric N square on the top left corner of (1) 4 1/2" Fabric I square, right sides together (Diagram 1). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam.

2. Follow Diagram 3 for the seam direction to add a 1 1/2" Fabric N square to the lower left corner and a 2 1/2" Fabric N square to the upper right corner of the 4 1/2" Fabric I square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Diagram 4).

3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make a second Unit 1 square.




4. Repeat Steps 1-2 and refer to Diagram 5 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (2) 4 1/2" Unit 2 squares.




5. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to the top of (1) Unit 2 square to make (1) 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" Unit 3 rectangle (Diagram 6). Repeat to make a second Unit 3 rectangle.










6. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric N strip to the top and bottom of (1) 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric I strip lengthwise to make (1) 8 1/2" Unit 4 square (Diagram 7).



7. Sew (1) Unit 3 rectangle to each side of the Unit 4 square to make the 16 1/2" x 8 1/2" Unit 5 rectangle (Diagram 8).



8. Repeat Steps 1-7 and refer to Diagrams 9-19 for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make (1) of each unit rectangle for Unit 6 through Unit 16.



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

9. Sew (1) 4 1/2" x 16 1/2" Fabric N strip to each side of the Unit 6 rectangle lengthwise. Sew the Unit 5 rectangle to the top of the newly sewn rectangle lengthwise to make the 16 1/2" x 24 1/2" Block One rectangle (Diagram 20).



10. Repeat Step 9 and refer to Diagrams 21-25 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (1) of each block rectangle for Block Two through Block Six.



11. Sew together the (6) block rectangles into a 3 x 2 matrix as shown to make the 48 1/2" x 48 1/2" Quilt Center (Diagram 26).



Quilt Top Assembly


(Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)

12. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 48 1/2" Fabric N strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 52 1/2" Fabric N strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center.
13. Sew (1) 2" x 52 1/2" Fabric M strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew (1) 2" x 55 1/2" Fabric M strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center.
14. Sew (1) 4 1/2" x 55 1/2" Fabric C strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew (1) 4 1/2" x 63 1/2" Fabric C strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center to make the Quilt Top.

Finishing the Quilt


15. Layer and quilt as desired.
16. Sew together the (7) binding strips end to end with 45-degree seams. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
17. Bind as desired.






