Quilt Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting.

Fabrics are cut to exact length required plus 1/4" seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

Fabric A See instructions to cut (3) Buttons.

Fabric B Cut (1) 8 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (3) 8 1/2" squares.

Fabric C Cut (1) 8 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (3) 8 1/2" squares.

Fabric D Cut (4) 5" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5" x 65 1/2" strips.
Cut (4) 5" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5" x 64 1/2" strips.

Fabric E See instructions to cut (3) Buttons.

Fabric F Cut (1) 8 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (3) 8 1/2" squares.

Fabric G See instructions to cut (3) Buttons.

Fabric H Cut (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 62 1/2" strips.
Cut (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 55 1/2" strips.
See instructions to cut (3) Buttons.

Fabric I Cut (1) 8 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (3) 8 1/2" squares.

You will also need: Fusible web

Fabric J See instructions to cut (3) Buttons.

Fabric K Cut (1) 8 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (3) 8 1/2" squares.

Fabric L Cut (3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (42) 2 1/2" squares.

Fabric M Cut (4) 8 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (15) 8 1/2" squares.
Cut (18) 1 1/2" x WOF strips.

Fabric N Cut (18) 1 1/2" x WOF strips.

Binding Cut (7) 2 1/2" x WOF strips.

Backing Cut (2) 72" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make (1) 72" x 82" backing.

Making the Quilt

Block Assembly

- Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.
- Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the template. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
- Center and press (1) Fabric H button onto (1) 8 1/2" Fabric M square (Diagram 1).
- Finish the raw edges of each button with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make (1) 8 1/2" Block One square (Diagram 1).
- Repeat Steps 3-4 to make an additional (2) Block One squares.
- Repeat Steps 3-4 and refer to Diagrams 2-5 for fabric identification and placement to make (3) of each block square for Block Two through Block Five.

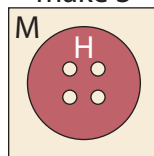

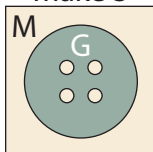

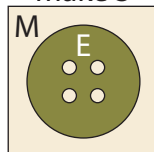

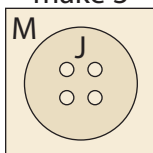

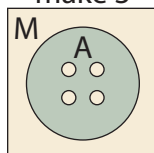

- Sew (1) 1 1/2" x WOF Fabric M strip to the top of (1) 1 1/2" x WOF Fabric N strip lengthwise to make (1) Strip Set (Diagram 6). Repeat to make an additional (17) Strip Sets.

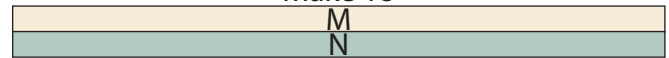

- From the (18) Strip Sets cut (71) 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" Block Six rectangles (Diagram 7).

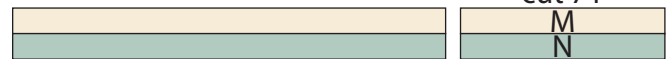

- Paying attention to the block orientations, sew together (6) 2 1/2" Fabric L squares and (5) Block Six rectangles, end to end and alternating them from left to right, to make Row One (Diagram 8). Repeat to make Row Three, Row Five, Row Seven, Row Nine, Row Eleven and Row Thirteen.
- Sew together (1) Block Six rectangle, (1) Block One square, (1) Block Six rectangle, (1) 8 1/2" Fabric B square, (1) Block Six rectangle, (1) Block Two square, (1) Block Six rectangle, (1) 8 1/2" Fabric C square, (1) Block Six rectangle, (1) Block Three square and (1) Block Six rectangle, in that order from left to right, to make Row Two (Diagram 8).
- Repeat Step 10 and refer to Diagram 8 for component identification, placement and orientation to make Row Four, Row Six, Row Eight, Row Ten and Row Twelve.
- Sew together the (13) pieced Rows, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the 52 1/2" x 62 1/2" Quilt Center (Diagram 8).

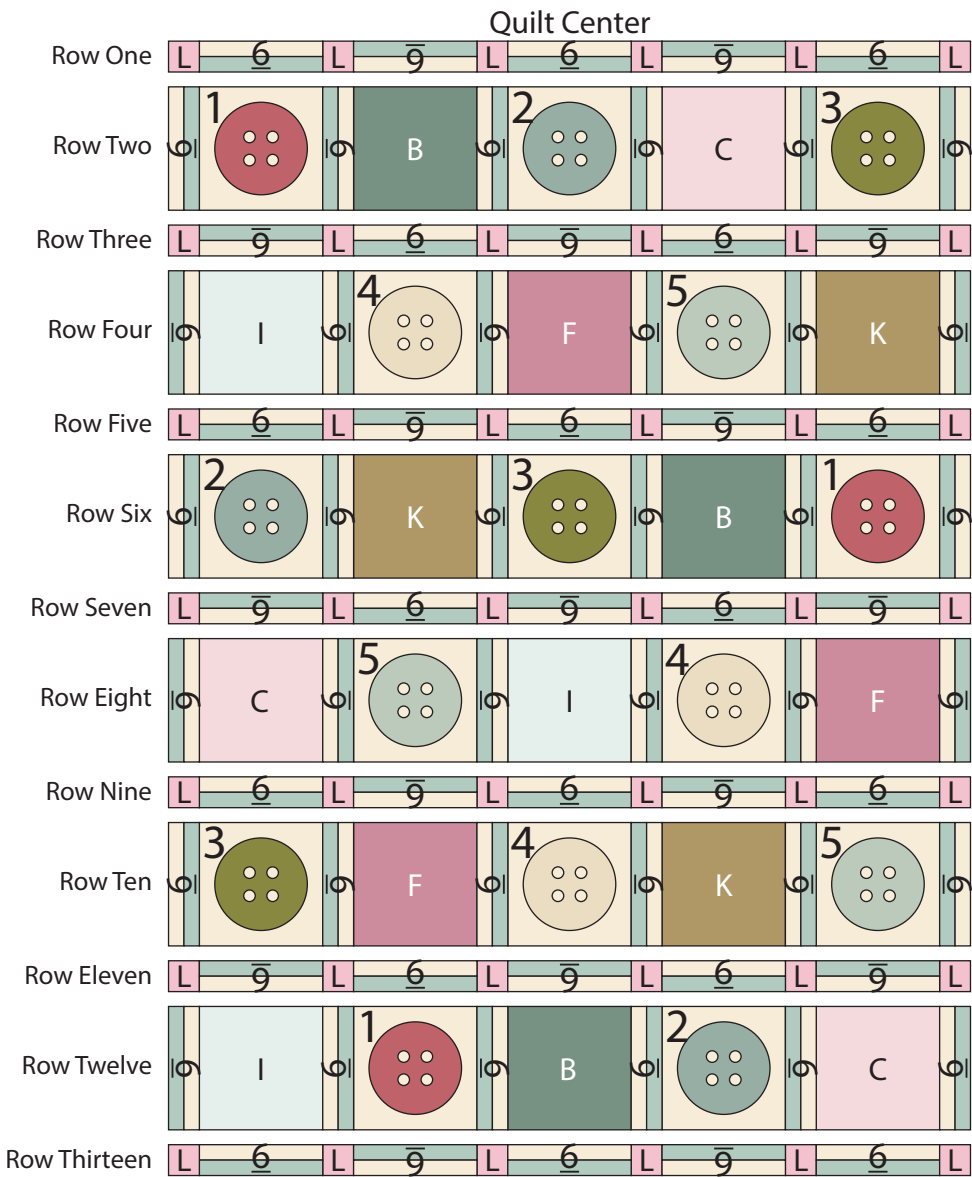

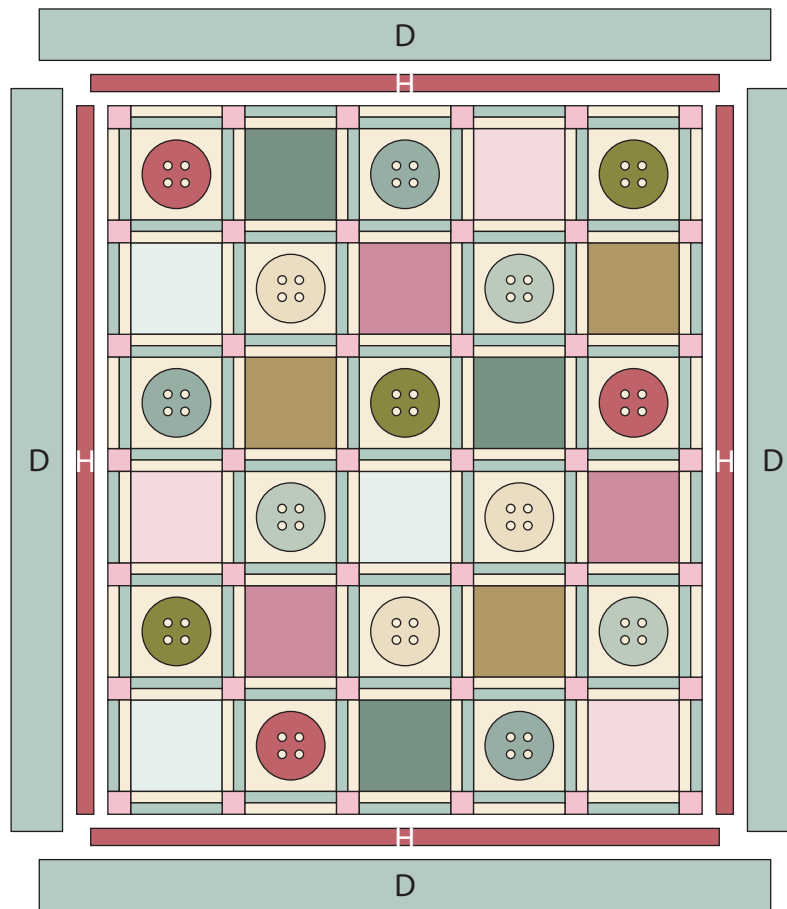
Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)

13. Sew (1) 2" x 62 ½" Fabric H strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew (1) 2" x 55 ½" Fabric H strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center.
14. Sew (1) 5" x 65 ½" Fabric D strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew (1) 5" x 64 ½" Fabric D strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center to make the Quilt Top.

Finishing the Quilt

15. Layer and quilt as desired.
16. Sew together the (7) binding strips end to end with 45-degree seams. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
17. Bind as desired.

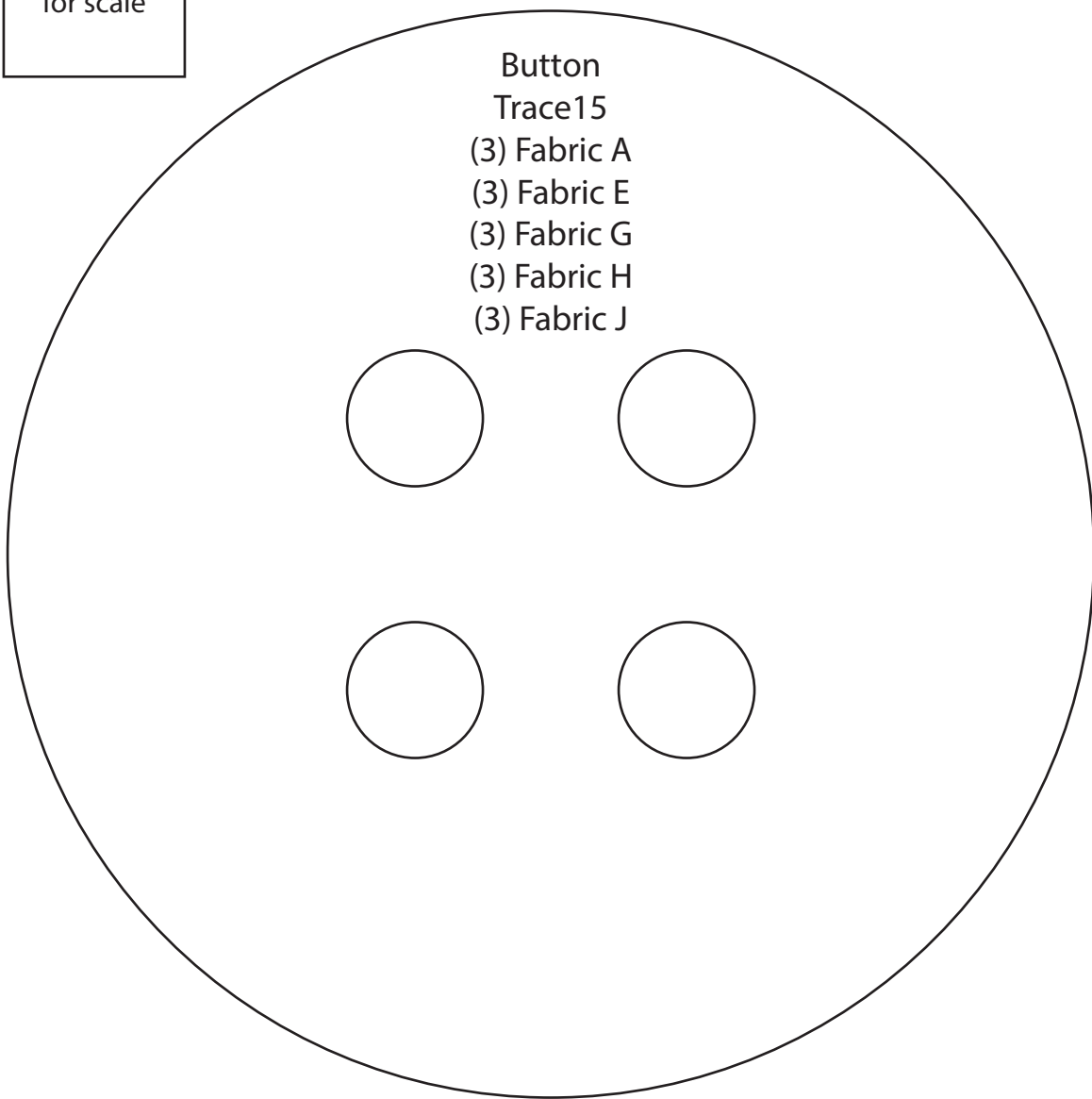


Quilt Layout
