Runner Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting

patches. Borders are cut to exact length required plus ¼" seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

- Fabric A** Cut (2) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (12) 4 ½" squares.
- Fabric B** Cut (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (24) 2 ½" squares.
- Fabric C** Cut (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (8) 2 ½" squares.
- Fabric D** Cut (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 4 ½" x 14 ½" strips.
Cut (3) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 ½" x 54 ½" strips.
- Fabric E** Cut (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 4 ½" squares.
- Fabric F** Cut (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (24) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
- Fabric G** Cut (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 1 ½" x 12 ½" strips.
Cut (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 46 ½" strips.
- Fabric H** Cut (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 4 ½" squares.
Cut (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (12) 2 ½" squares.
- Fabric I** Cut (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (24) 2 ½" squares.
- Fabric J** Cut (1) 8 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (3) 8 ½" squares.

Backing Cut (1) 62" x 30" WOF strip for the backing.

Floral Fun Table Set

Place Mat Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. Borders are cut to exact length required plus $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

Fabric A Cut (1) $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Fabric B Cut (1) $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Fabric C Cut (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (8) 2" x $11\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
Cut (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (8) 2" x $17\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Fabric D Cut (8) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the binding.

Fabric E Cut (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (8) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
Cut (3) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (8) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Fabric F Cut (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (8) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Fabric G Cut (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (8) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Backing Cut (2) 18" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 18" x 21" rectangles.

Making the Runner

Note: The arrows in diagrams represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

Block Assembly

1. Place (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A square on the top left corner of (1) $8\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J square, right sides together (Diagram 1). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the sewn seam.





2. Follow Diagram 3 for the seam direction to add a $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A square to each of the remaining corners of the $8\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Diagram 4).
3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make an additional (2) Unit 1 squares.





4. Place (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I square on the left side of (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip, right sides together (Diagram 5). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 5). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 6). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.







Floral Fun Table Set

5. Place (1) 2 1/2" Fabric B square on the right side of the 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric F strip, right sides together (Diagram 7). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 7). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 2 rectangle (Diagram 8).




6. Repeat Steps 4-5 to make an additional (11) Unit 2 rectangles.


7. Repeat Steps 4-5 and refer to Diagram 9 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (12) Unit 3 rectangles.




8. Sew (1) Unit 2 rectangle to the left end of (1) Unit 3 rectangle along the Fabric B sides to make (1) 8 1/2" x 2 1/2" Unit 4 rectangle (Diagram 10). Repeat to make an additional (11) Unit 4 rectangles.



9. Place (1) 2 1/2" Fabric C square on the bottom left corner of (1) 4 1/2" Fabric H square, right sides together (Diagram 11). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Diagram 11). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 12). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam.




10. Follow Diagram 13 for the seam direction to add a 2 1/2" Fabric C square to the lower right corner of the 4 1/2" Fabric H square to make (1) 4 1/2" Unit 5 square (Diagram 14).




11. Repeat Steps 9-10 to make an additional (3) Unit 4 squares.

12. Sew (1) 2 1/2" Fabric H square to each end of (1) Unit 4 rectangle to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 4 rectangle to each side of (1) Unit 1 square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) pieced rows lengthwise to make (1) 12 1/2" Block One square (Diagram 15). Repeat to make an additional (2) Block One squares.



13. Sew (1) Unit 5 square to the top and bottom of (1) 4 1/2" Fabric E square to make (1) 4 1/2" x 12 1/2" Block Two rectangle (Diagram 16). Repeat to make a second Block Two rectangle.



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
Runner Top Assembly

(Refer to the Runner Layout in Diagram 17 when assembling the runner top.)

14. Sew together (3) Block One squares and (2) Block Two rectangles, alternating them from left to right, to make the 44 ½" x 12 ½" Runner Center Block.
15. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric G strip to each end of the Runner Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 46 ½" Fabric G strip to the top and bottom of the Runner Center Block.
16. Sew (1) 4 ½" x 14 ½" Fabric D strip to each end of the Runner Center Block. Sew (1) 4 ½" x 54 ½" Fabric D strip to the top and bottom of the Runner Center Block to make the Runner Top.

Finishing the Quilt

17. Layer and quilt as desired.
18. Sew together the (4) binding strips end to end with 45-degree seams. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
19. Bind as desired.



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Making the Place Mats

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.

- 20.** Sew (1) 1 ½" x 9 ½" Fabric E strip to each side of (1) 9 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric B strip (Diagram 18).
- 21.** Sew (1) 1 ½" Fabric F square to the left end and (1) 1 ½" Fabric G square to the right end of (1) 1 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric E strip. Sew the newly sewn strip to the top of the 9 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric B strip (Diagram 18).
- 22.** Sew (1) 1 ½" Fabric G square to the left end and (1) 1 ½" Fabric F square to the right end of (1) 1 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric E strip. Sew the newly sewn strip to the bottom of the 9 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric B strip to make (1) 14 ½" x 11 ½" Unit 6 rectangle (Diagram 18).

- 23.** Repeat Steps 20-22 to make a second Unit 6 rectangle.



- 24.** Repeat Steps 20-22 and refer to Diagram 19 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (2) 14 ½" x 11 ½" Unit 7 rectangles.



- 25.** Sew (1) 2" x 11 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of (1) Unit 6 rectangle. Sew (1) 2" x 17 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and bottom of the Unit 6 rectangle to make the 17 ½" x 14 ½" Place Mat #1 Top (Diagram 20). Repeat to make a second Place Mat #1 Top.



- 26.** Repeat Step 25 and refer to Diagram 21 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (2) 17 ½" x 14 ½" Place Mat #2 Tops.



Finishing the Place Mats


- 27.** Layer and quilt as desired.
- 28.** Sew together the (8) Fabric D binding strips end to end with 45-degree seams. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press. Cut the strip into (4) equal pieces
- 29.** Bind as desired.
