Quilt Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. Borders are cut to exact length required plus 1/4" seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

Fabric A Cut (1) 4 7/8" square. Cut the square across (1) diagonal to make (2) 4 7/8" triangles.
Note: You will only use (1) 4 7/8" triangle.

Fabric B Cut (1) 4 7/8" square. Cut the square across (1) diagonal to make (2) 4 7/8" triangles.

Fabric C Cut (1) 4 7/8" square. Cut the square across (1) diagonal to make (2) 4 7/8" triangles.
Note: You will only use (1) 4 7/8" triangle.

Fabric D Cut (1) 4 7/8" square. Cut the square across (1) diagonal to make (2) 4 7/8" triangles.

Fabric E Cut (1) 4 7/8" square. Cut the square across (1) diagonal to make (2) 4 7/8" triangles.
Note: You will only use (1) 4 7/8" triangle.

Fabric F Cut (1) 4 7/8" square. Cut the square across (1) diagonal to make (2) 4 7/8" triangles.

Fabric G Cut (1) 4 7/8" square. Cut the square across (1) diagonal to make (2) 4 7/8" triangles.
Note: You will only use (1) 4 7/8" triangle.

Fabric H Cut (1) 4 7/8" square. Cut the square across (1) diagonal to make (2) 4 7/8" triangles.
Note: You will only use (1) 4 7/8" triangle.

Fabric I Cut (1) 4 7/8" square. Cut the square across (1) diagonal to make (2) 4 7/8" triangles.
Note: You will only use (1) 4 7/8" triangle.

Fabric J Cut (1) 4 7/8" square. Cut the square across (1) diagonal to make (2) 4 7/8" triangles.

Fabric K Cut (1) 2 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 2 7/8" squares. Cut each square across (1) diagonal to make (8) 2 7/8" triangles.

Cut (1) 1 1/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 1 1/8" x 3 1/2" strips and (4) 1 1/8" x 4 1/4" strips

Fabric L Cut (1) 2 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 2 7/8" squares. Cut each square across (1) diagonal to make (8) 2 7/8" triangles.

Cut (1) 1 1/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 1 1/8" x 3 1/2" strips and (4) 1 1/8" x 4 1/4" strips

Fabric M Cut (1) 2 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (6) 2 7/8" squares. Cut each square across (1) diagonal to make (12) 2 7/8" triangles.

Cut (1) 1 1/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (6) 1 1/8" x 3 1/2" strips.

Cut (1) 1 1/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (6) 1 1/8" x 4 1/4" strips

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Quilt Cutting Directions - Continued

Fabric N Cut (1) 5 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (1) 5 1/4" square, (6) 4 7/8" squares and (1) 3 1/4" square. Cut the 5 1/4" square across both diagonals to make (4) 5 1/4" triangles. Cut the 4 7/8" squares across (1) diagonal to make (12) 4 7/8" triangles. Cut the 3 1/4" square across both diagonals to make (4) 3 1/4" triangles.

Cut (1) 3 5/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (7) 3 5/8" squares. Cut each square across (1) diagonal to make (14) 3 5/8" triangles.

Cut (2) 2 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strip into (15) 2 7/8" squares. Cut each square across (1) diagonal to make (30) 2 7/8" triangles.

Cut (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (12) 2 1/2" squares.

Fabric O Cut (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (14) 2 1/2" squares.

Cut (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips.

Binding Cut (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips.


Backing Cut (1) 24" x 50" rectangle.

Making the Quilt


Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.

Block Assembly












1. Sew (1) 1 1/8" x 3 1/2" Fabric M strip to the right side of (1) 3 5/8" Fabric N triangle. Sew (1) 1 1/8" x 4 1/4" Fabric M strip to the top of the Fabric N triangle as shown. Trim the Fabric M strips even with the long side of the Fabric N triangle to make (1) Unit 1 triangle (Diagram 1). Repeat to make a second Unit 1 triangle.




2. Sew together (1) Unit 1 triangle and (1) 4 7/8" Fabric B triangle along their long sides to make (1) 4 1/2" Unit 2 square (Diagram 2). Repeat to make a second Unit 2 square.



3. Repeat Steps 1-2 and refer to Diagrams 3-13 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make the indicated number of 4 1/2" unit squares for Unit 3 through Unit 13.



4. Sew together (1) 2 7/8" Fabric M triangle and (1) 2 7/8" Fabric N triangle along short sides as shown to make (1) Unit 14 triangle (Diagram 14). Repeat to make a second Unit 14 triangle.




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- 11.** Repeat Steps 8-10 and refer to Diagram 23 for fabric/unit identification, placement and orientation to make Runner Row Three.

- 12.** Sew (1) $2\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric N triangle to each side of (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric O square as shown to make (1) Unit 22 piece (Diagram 24). Repeat to make an additional (11) Unit 22 pieces.



- 13.** Sew (1) $3\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric N triangle to the top and left side of (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric O square. Sew (1) $2\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric N triangle to the right side of the Fabric O square to make Row One (Diagram 25 on Page 6). Repeat to make Row Fourteen.
- 14.** Sew together Row One, (12) Unit 22 pieces and Row Fourteen as shown to make Runner Row Two (Diagram 25 on Page 6).
- 15.** Sew together Runner Row One, Runner Row Two and Runner Row Three, lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom, to make the Runner Center (Diagram 26 on Page 6). *Note: Ours measured approximately $39\frac{1}{2}$ " x $14\frac{1}{8}$ ".*



Runner Center




Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)

16. Measure the sides of the Runner Center. Sew together the (3) 1 1/2" x WOF Fabric O strips end to end with diagonal seams. Cut (2) strips to the measured length. Sew (1) newly cut strip to each side of the Runner Center.
17. Measure the top and bottom of the Runner Center including the added side borders. From the remaining 1 1/2" Fabric O strip, cut (2) strips to the measured length. Sew (1) newly cut strip to the top and bottom of the Runner Center to complete the Runner Top.

Finishing the Quilt

18. Layer and quilt as desired.
19. Sew together the (4) binding strips end to end with 45-degree seams. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
20. Bind as desired.


