Quilt #1 Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. Borders are cut to exact length required plus ¼" seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

Fabric A Fussy cut (8) 10 ½" squares each centered on a block.

Fabric B Cut (1) 10 ½" square.

Fabric C Cut (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (24) 2 ½" x 10 ½" strips.

Fabric D Cut (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (16) 2 ½" squares.

Fabric E Cut (2) 2 ½" x 38 ½" WOF strips.
Cut (2) 2 ½" x 42 ½" WOF strips, piece as needed.

Fabric F Cut (2) 4" x 42 ½" WOF strips, piece as needed.
Cut (3) 4" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4" x 49 ½" strips.

Binding Cut (5) 2 ½" x WOF strips.

Backing Cut (2) 57" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make (1) 57" x 57" backing.

Quilt #2 Cutting Directions

- Fabric A** Fussy cut (1) 22 ½" x 43 ½" rectangle, centered on panel.
- Fabric B** Cut (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 43 ½" strips. Cut (2) 2 ½" x 26 ½" WOF strips.
- Fabric C** Cut (3) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 ½" x 47 ½" strips. Cut (2) 4 ½" x 34 ½" WOF strips.
- Binding** Cut (5) 2 ½" x WOF strips.
- Backing** Cut (1) 42" x 63" rectangle.

Runner Cutting Directions


- Fabric A** Fussy cut (3) 10 ½" squares each centered on the blocks.
- Fabric B** Cut (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (10) 2 ½" x 10 ½" strips.
- Fabric C** Cut (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (8) 2 ½" squares.
- Fabric D** Cut (2) 1 ½" x 40 ½" strips. Cut (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 1 ½" x 14 ½" strips.
- Fabric E** Cut (2) 4 ½" x 40 ½" strips. Cut (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 4 ½" x 16 ½" strips.
- Fabric F** Cut (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 4 ½" squares.
- Binding** Cut (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips.
- Backing** Cut (1) 32" x 56" rectangle.

Making Quilt #1

Note: The arrows in diagrams represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

Quilt #1 Block Assembly

- Sew together (4) 2 ½" Fabric D squares and (3) 2 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric C strips, end to end and alternating them from left to right, to make Row One (Diagram 1). Repeat to make Row Three, Row Five and Row Seven.
- Sew together (4) 2 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric C strips and (3) 10 ½" Fabric A squares, alternating them from left to right, to make Row Two (Diagram 1). Repeat to make Row Six.
- Sew together (4) 2 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric C strips, (2) 10 ½" Fabric A squares and (1) 10 ½" Fabric B square as shown to make Row Four (Diagram 1).
- Sew together the (7) pieced Rows, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the 38 ½" x 38 ½" Quilt #1 Center.


Quilt #1 Top Assembly

(Refer to the *Quilt Layout* when assembling the quilt top.)

5. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 38 ½" Fabric E strip to each side of the Quilt #1 Center. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 42 ½" Fabric E strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt #1 Center.
6. Sew (1) 4" x 42 ½" Fabric F strip to each side of the Quilt #1 Center. Sew (1) 4" x 49 ½" Fabric F strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt #1 Center to make the Quilt #1 Top.

Finishing Quilt #1

7. Layer and quilt as desired.
8. Sew together the (5) binding strips end to end with 45-degree seams. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
9. Bind as desired.

Making Quilt #2

Note: The arrows in diagrams represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the quilt top.


Quilt #2 Top Assembly

(Refer to the *Quilt Layout* when assembling the quilt top.)

10. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 43 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the 22 ½" x 43 ½" Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 26 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the 26 ½" x 47 ½" Quilt #2 Center.
11. Sew (1) 4 ½" x 47 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of the Quilt #2 Center. Sew (1) 4 ½" x 34 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt #2 Center to make the Quilt #2 Top.

Finishing Quilt #2

12. Layer and quilt as desired.
13. Sew together the (5) binding strips end to end with 45-degree seams. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
14. Bind as desired.



Quilt #2 Layout



Making the Runner

Note: The arrows in diagrams represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

Runner Block Assembly

15. Sew together (4) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C squares and (3) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strips, end to end and alternating them from left to right, to make the top row (Diagram 2). Repeat to make the bottom row.
16. Sew together (4) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strips and (3) $10\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A squares, alternating them from left to right, to make the middle row (Diagram 2).
17. Sew together the (3) pieced Rows lengthwise to make the $38\frac{1}{2}$ " x $14\frac{1}{2}$ " Runner Center (Diagram 2).




Runner Top Assembly

(Refer to the Runner Layout when assembling the runner top.)

18. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $14\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to each side of the Runner Center. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $40\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to the top and bottom of the Runner Center.
19. Sew (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $16\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to each side of the Runner Center. Sew (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F square to each end of (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $40\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) newly sewn strip to the top and bottom of the Runner Center to make the Runner Top.

Finishing the Runner

20. Layer and quilt as desired.
21. Sew together the (4) binding strips end to end with 45-degree seams. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
22. Bind as desired.
