Quilt Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. Borders are cut to exact length required plus ¼" seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

Fabric A Cut (1) 12 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (3) 12 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (6) 12 7/8" triangles.

Fabric B Cut (1) 3 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 3 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (8) 3 7/8" triangles.

Fabric C Cut (1) 3 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (5) 3 7/8" squares.

Fabric D Cut (1) 3 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (5) 3 7/8" squares.

Fabric E Cut (1) 3 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (6) 3 7/8" squares.

Fabric F Cut (1) 3 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (6) 3 7/8" squares.

Fabric G Cut (1) 3 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (7) 3 7/8" squares.

Fabric H Cut (1) 3 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (7) 3 7/8" squares.

Fabric I Cut (1) 3 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (8) 3 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (16) 3 7/8" triangles.

Fabric J Cut (1) 12 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (3) 12 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (6) 12 7/8" triangles.

Fabric K Cut (2) 3 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (12) 3 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (24) 3 7/8" triangles.

Fabric L Cut (2) 3 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (13) 3 7/8" squares.

Fabric M Cut (2) 3 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (13) 3 7/8" squares.

Fabric N Cut (2) 3 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (14) 3 7/8" squares.

Fabric O Cut (2) 3 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (14) 3 7/8" squares.

Fabric P Cut (2) 3 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (15) 3 7/8" squares.

Fabric Q Cut (2) 3 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (15) 3 7/8" squares.

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Quilt Cutting Directions - Continued

Fabric R Cut (2) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (16) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (32) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " triangles.

Fabric S Cut (2) $12\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (4) $12\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (8) $12\frac{7}{8}$ " triangles.

Binding Cut (6) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips.

Backing Cut (2) 56 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make (1) 56 " x 68 " backing.

Making the Quilt

Note: *The arrows represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.*

Block Assembly

- Place (1) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric D square on top of (1) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric C square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Diagram 1). Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 1). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 2) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square to make (2) Unit 1 squares (Diagram 3). Repeat to make an additional (8) Unit 1 squares.

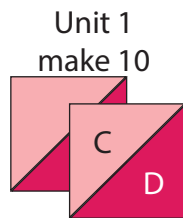

- Repeat Step 1 and refer to Diagrams 4-8 for fabric identification and placement to make the indicated number of $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for Unit 2 through Unit 6.

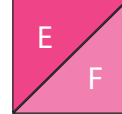

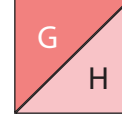

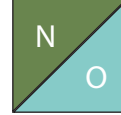

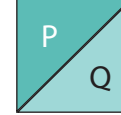

- Sew together (4) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " triangles, (3) Unit 1 squares, (2) Unit 2 squares and (1) Unit 3 square as shown to make (1) Unit 7 triangle (Diagram 9). Repeat to make a second Unit 7 triangle.

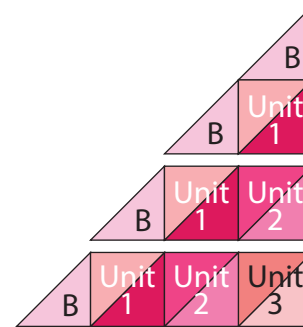

4. Repeat Step 3 and refer to Diagrams 10-12 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (4) Unit 8 triangles, (6) Unit 9 triangles and (8) Unit 10 triangles.

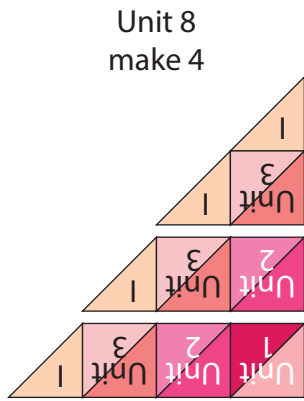

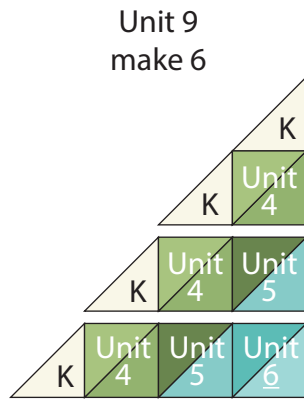

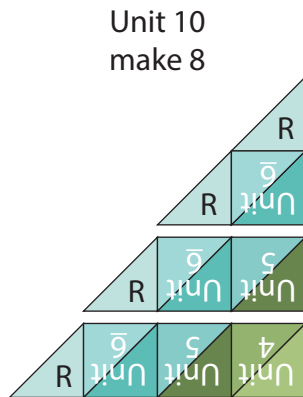

5. Sew together (1) 12 7/8" Fabric A triangle and (1) Unit 7 triangle along their long sides to make (1) 12 1/2" Block One square (Diagram 13).

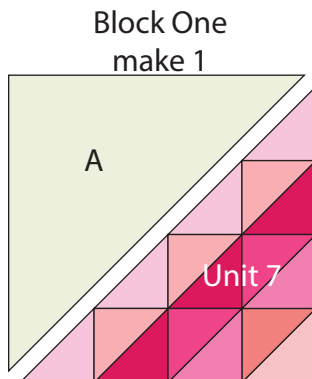

6. Repeat Step 5 and refer to Diagrams 14-19 for component identification, placement and orientation to make the indicated number of 12 1/2" block squares for Block Two through Block Seven.

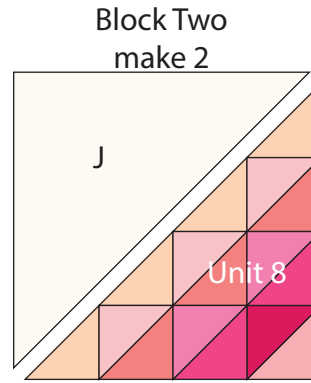

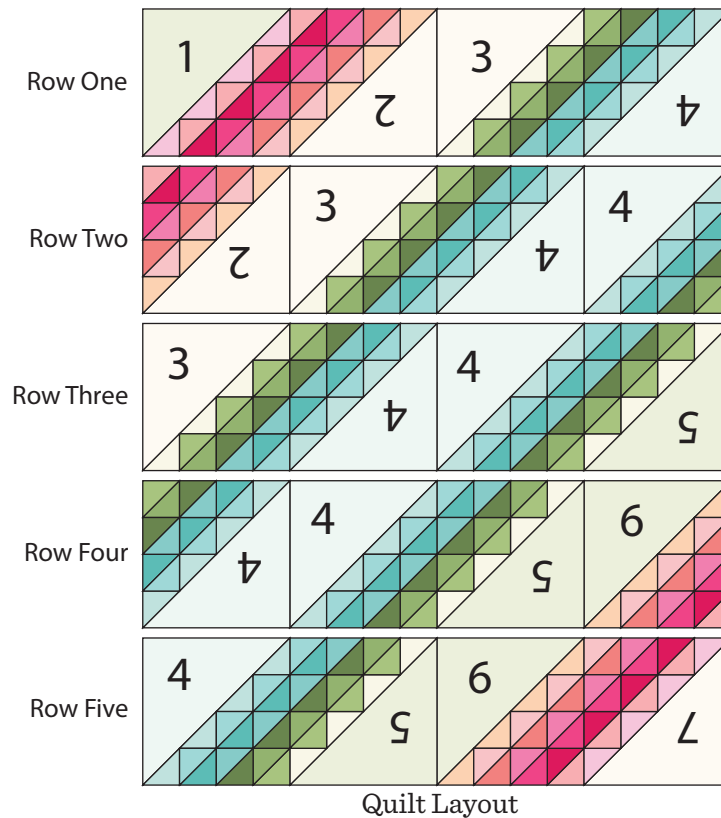
Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the *Quilt Layout* when assembling the quilt top.)

7. Paying attention to the block orientations, sew together (1) Block One square, (1) Block Two square, (1) Block Three square and (1) Block Four square, in that order from left to right, to make Row One.
8. Repeat Step 7 to make Row Two through Row Five.
9. Sew together the (5) pieced Rows, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the 48 1/2" x 60 1/2" Quilt Top.

Finishing the Quilt

10. Layer and quilt as desired.
11. Sew together the (8) binding strips end to end with 45-degree seams. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
12. Bind as desired.

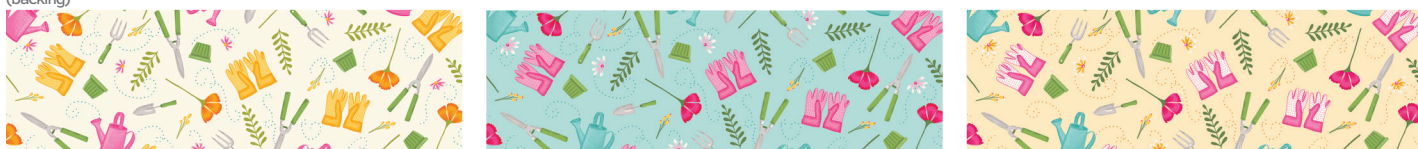

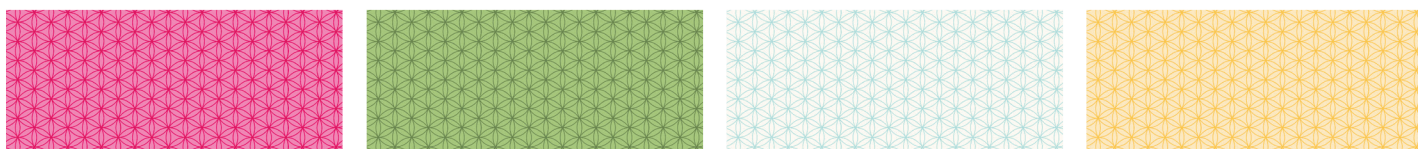
