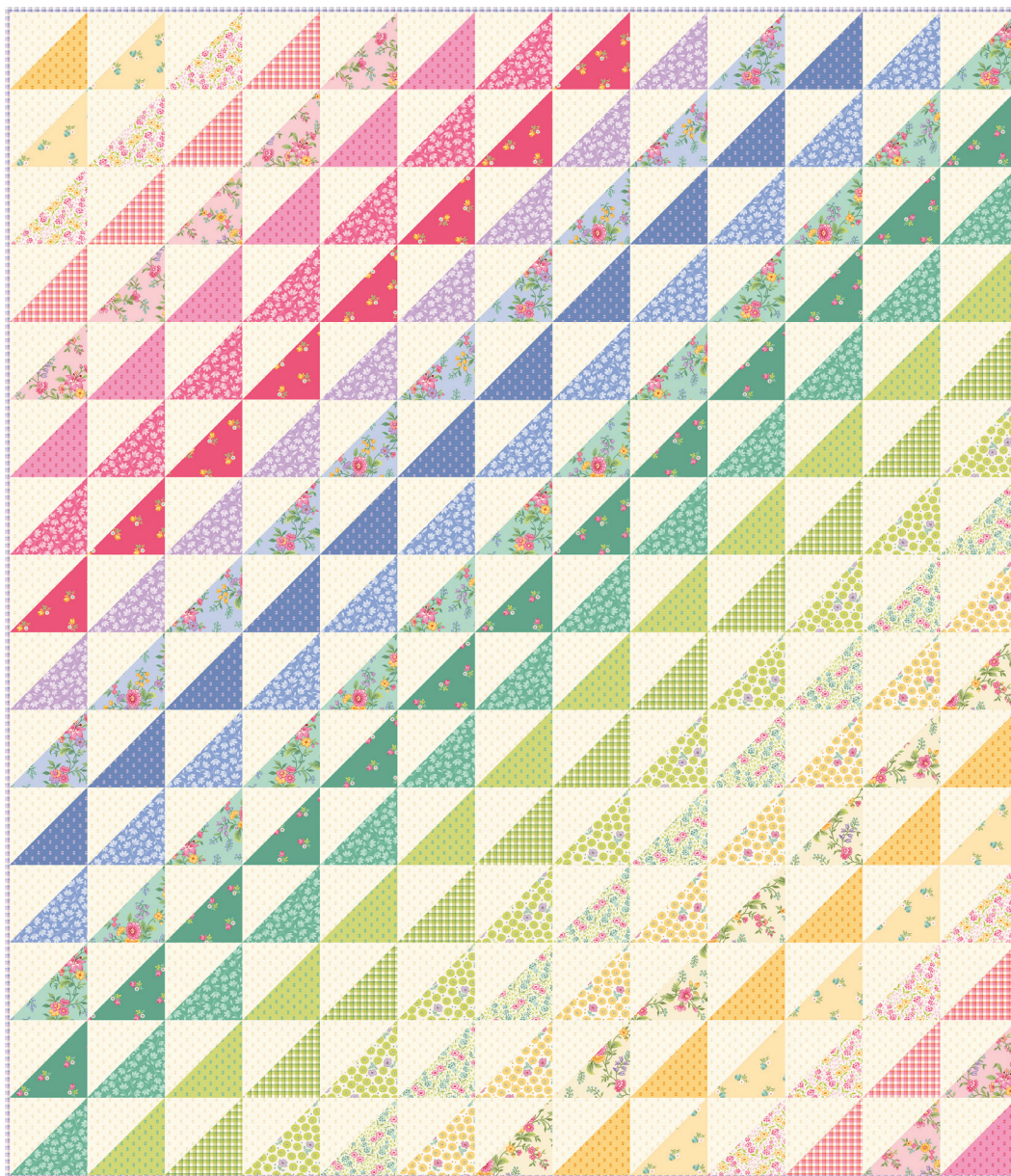

Quilt Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting.
WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

Fabric A	Cut (5) 4 7/8" squares.
Fabric B	Cut (4) 4 7/8" squares.
Fabric C	Cut (4) 4 7/8" squares.
Fabric D	Cut (7) 4 7/8" squares.
Fabric E	Cut (5) 4 7/8" squares.
Fabric F	Cut (4) 4 7/8" squares.
Fabric G	Cut (4) 4 7/8" squares.
Fabric H	Cut (5) 4 7/8" squares.
Fabric I	Cut (4) 4 7/8" squares.
Fabric J	Cut (6) 4 7/8" squares.
Fabric K	Cut (6) 4 7/8" squares.
Fabric L	Cut (4) 4 7/8" squares.
Fabric M	Cut (7) 4 7/8" squares.
Fabric N	Cut (5) 4 7/8" squares.
Fabric O	Cut (6) 4 7/8" squares.
Fabric P	Cut (4) 4 7/8" squares.
Fabric Q	Cut (6) 4 7/8" squares.
Fabric R	Cut (14) 4 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (105) 4 7/8" squares.
Fabric S	Cut (4) 4 7/8" squares.

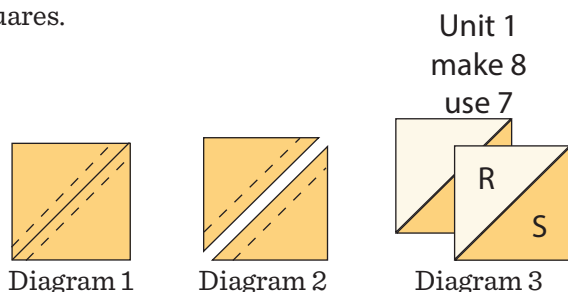
Fabric T	Cut (4) 4 7/8" squares.
Fabric U	Cut (7) 4 7/8" squares.
Fabric V	Cut (4) 4 7/8" squares.
Binding	Cut (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips.
Backing	Cut (2) 60" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make (1) 60" x 68" backing.

Making the Quilt

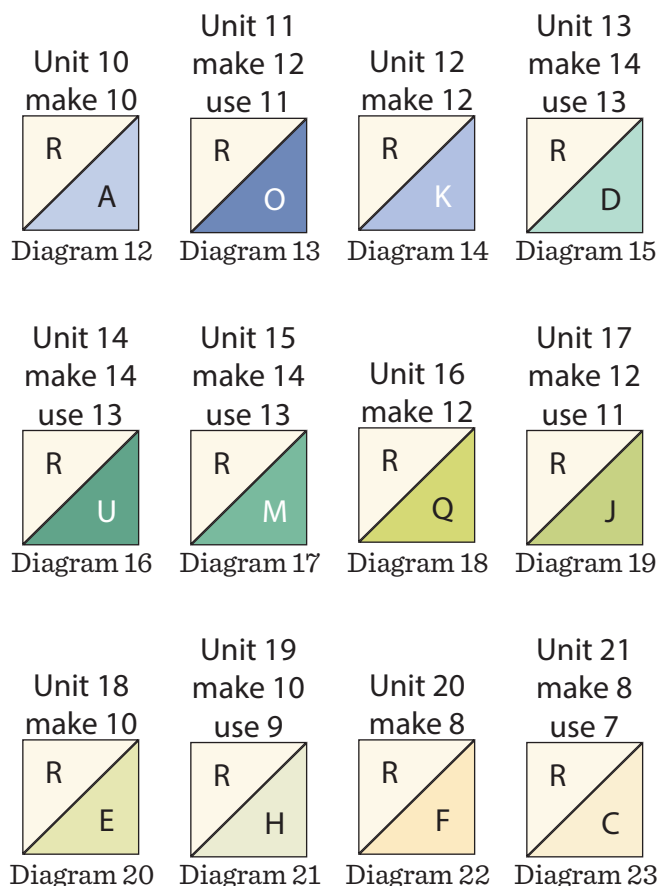
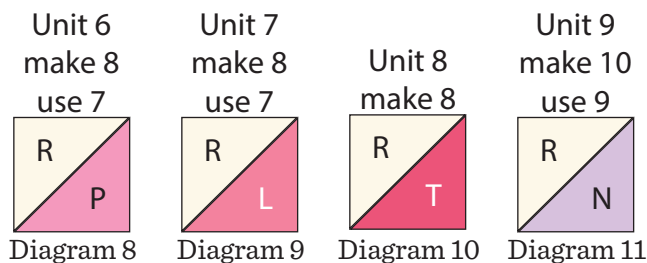
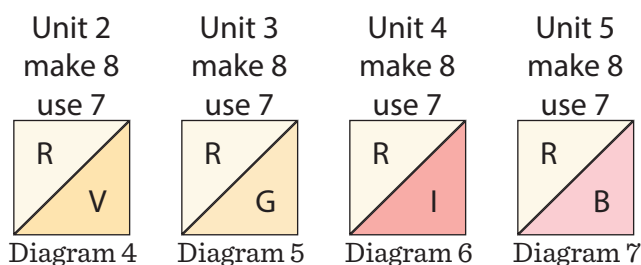
Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.

Block Assembly

- Place (1) $4\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric S square on top of (1) $4\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric R square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Diagram 1). Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 1). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 2) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " to make (2) Unit 1 squares (Diagram 3). Repeat to make an additional (6) Unit 1 squares.



- Repeat Step 1 and refer to Diagrams 4-23 for fabric identification and placement to make the indicated number of $4\frac{1}{2}$ " unit squares for Unit 2 through Unit 21. **Note: A total of (210) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " unit squares will be made, but (195) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " unit squares will be used.**



Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)

- Paying attention to the unit orientations, sew together (13) assorted $4\frac{1}{2}$ " unit squares as shown to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Two through Row Fifteen.
- Sew together the (15) pieced Rows, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the Quilt Top.

Finishing the Quilt

- Layer and quilt as desired.
- Sew the (6) binding strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- Bind as desired.
