

## Quilt Cutting Directions

**Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches.** Borders are cut to exact length required plus ¼" seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

**Fabric A** Cut (6) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (50) 4 ½" squares.  
Cut (7) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (20) 4 ½" x 12 ½" strips.  
Cut (4) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 ½" x 68 ½" strips.  
Cut (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 64 ½" strips.  
Cut (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (4) 2 ½" x 56 ½" strips.

**Fabric B1** From each 10" square cut:  
(1) 3 ½" x 6" strip  
(1) 3 ½" x 3" strip  
(2) 3" x 8 ½" strips

**Fabric B2** From each 10" x 20" rectangle cut:  
(2) 3 ½" x 6" strips  
(2) 3 ½" x 3" strips  
(4) 3" x 8 ½" strips

**Fabric C1** From each 9 ½" x 20" rectangle cut:  
(4) 4 ½" x 8 ½" strips

**Fabric C2** Cut (5) 4 ½" x 8 ½" strips.

**Binding** Cut (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips.

**Backing** Cut (2) 72" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make (1) 72" x 80" backing.

# Happy Houses

## Making the Quilt

**Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.**

### Block Assembly

- Place (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A square on the left side of (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C1 or C2 strip, right sides together (Diagram 1). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.



- Place another  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A square on the right side of the  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip, right sides together (Diagram 3). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Diagram 3). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Diagram 4).



- Select (2)  $3$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and (1)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3$ " strip of the same color from either the Fabric B1 or Fabric B2 groups. Sew (1)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3$ " Fabric B strip to the top of (1)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6$ " contrasting Fabric B1 or B2 strip (Diagram 5). Sew (1)  $3$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the newly sewn strip lengthwise to make (1)  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 2 square (Diagram 5).



- Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to the top of (1) Unit 2 square to make (1)  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " Block One rectangle (Diagram 6).



- Repeat Steps 1-4 to make an additional (24) Block One rectangles.
- Sew together (5) Block One rectangles and (4)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A strips, alternating them from left to right, to make Row One (Diagram 7). Repeat to make Row Two through Row Five.
- Sew together the (5) pieced Rows and (4)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $56\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A strips, alternating them from top to bottom, to make the  $56\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $68\frac{1}{2}$ " Quilt Center (Diagram 7).




## Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the *Quilt Layout* when assembling the quilt top.)

8. Sew (1) 4 ½" x 68 ½" Fabric A strip to each side of the Quilt Center.
9. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 64 ½" Fabric A strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center to make the Quilt Top.

## Finishing the Quilt

10. Layer and quilt as desired.
11. Sew together the (7) binding strips end to end with 45-degree seams. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
12. Bind as desired.
