## Quilt Cutting Directions

**Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches.** Borders are cut to exact length required plus  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

**Fabric A** Cut (8)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " strips from each of the (28)  $11$ " x  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles; for a total of (224) strips.

*Note: You will only use (190) strips.*

**Fabric B** Cut (12)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (190)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Cut (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (8)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Cut (15)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (380)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

**Binding** Cut (5)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips.

**Backing** Cut (1)  $52$ " x WOF strip.

# Here is My Heart

## Making the Quilt

**Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.**

### Block Assembly

1. Place (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B square on the top left corner of (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A strip, right sides together (Diagram 1). Sew across the diagonal of the small square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the sewn seam.





2. Follow Diagram 3 for the seam direction to add a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B square to the lower left corner and (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B square to the upper right corner of the  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A strip to make (1) Unit 1 rectangle (Diagram 4).





3. Repeat Steps 1-2 and refer to Diagram 5 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (1) Unit 2 rectangle, while using a different Fabric A than Steps 1-2.




4. Sew the Unit 1 rectangle to the left side of the Unit 2 rectangle lengthwise to make (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Block One square (Diagram 6).
5. Repeat Steps 1-4 to make an additional (94) Block One squares.



### Quilt Top Assembly

*(Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)*

6. Sew together (11) Block One squares from top to bottom to make Column One (Diagram 7). Repeat to make Column Three, Column Five, Column Seven and Column Nine.
7. Sew together (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip, (10) Block One squares and (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip, in that order from top to bottom, to make Column Two (Diagram 7). Repeat to make Column Four, Column Six and Column Eight.
8. Sew together the (9) pieced Columns, lengthwise and in numerical order from left to right, to make the quilt top.

### Finishing the Quilt

9. Layer and quilt as desired.
10. Sew together the (5) binding strips end to end with 45-degree seams. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
11. Bind as desired.
