## Quilt Cutting Directions

**Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches.** Borders are cut to exact length required plus 1/4" seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

### Version #1

**Fabric A** *No cutting required*

**Fabric B** Cut (2) 2 3/4" x 42 1/2" strips, piece as needed.  
Cut (2) 2" x 41" strips.

**Fabric C** Cut (1) 36 1/2" x 42 1/2" rectangle.

**Binding** Cut (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips.

**Backing** Cut (2) 58" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make (1) 58" x 62" backing.

### Version #2

**Fabric A** *No cutting required*

**Fabric B** Cut (2) 2 3/4" x 43 1/2" strips, piece as needed.  
Cut (2) 1 1/2" x 41" strips.

**Fabric C** Fussy cut (1) 22 1/2" x 43 1/2" rectangle centered on the panel.

**Fabric D** Cut (3) 7 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end and cut  
(2) 7 1/2" x 43 1/2" rectangle.

**Binding** Cut (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips.

**Backing** Cut (2) 58" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make (1) 58" x 62" backing.

<b>Fabric A</b> borders	(1) pack of (42) 5" squares	
<b>Fabric B</b> borders	1/2 yard	10505-E
<b>Fabric C</b> center	1 1/3 yard	10500-E
<b>Binding</b>	1/2 yard	10505-E
<b>Backing</b>	3 1/4 yards	10502-L

Quilt Version #2	Yardage	Fabric
<b>Fabric A</b> borders	(1) pack of (42) 5" squares	
<b>Fabric B</b> borders	1/2 yard	10505-E
<b>Fabric C</b> center	2/3 yard	10499-E
<b>Fabric D</b>	3/4 yard	10502-G
<b>Binding</b>	1/2 yard	10505-E
<b>Backing</b>	3 1/4 yards	10502-L

## Making the Quilt

**Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.**

### Quilt Top Assembly - Version #1


*(Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)*

1. Sew (1) 2 3/4" x 42 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the 36 1/2" x 42 1/2" Fabric C rectangle. Sew (1) 2" x 41" Fabric B strip to the top and bottom of the Fabric C rectangle to make the Quilt Center.
2. Sew together (10) assorted 5" Fabric A squares end to end to make the Left Side Border. Repeat to make the Right Side Border. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and right sides of the Quilt Center.
3. Sew together (11) assorted 5" Fabric A squares end to end to make the Top Border. Repeat to make the Bottom Border. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Side Border to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center to make the Quilt Top.

## Finishing the Quilt

4. Layer and quilt as desired.
5. Sew together the (6) binding strips end to end with 45-degree seams. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
6. Bind as desired.


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## Making the Quilt

**Note:** *Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.*

### Block Assembly - Version #2

7. Sew (1)  $7\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $43\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D rectangle to each side of the  $22\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $43\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C rectangle to make the  $36\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $43\frac{1}{2}$ " Quilt Center (Diagram 1).



### Quilt Top Assembly - Version #2

*(Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)*


8. Sew (1)  $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x  $43\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $41$ " Fabric B strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center.
9. Sew together (10) assorted 5" Fabric A squares end to end to make the Left Side Border. Repeat to make the Right Side Border. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and right sides of the Quilt Center.
10. Sew together (11) assorted 5" Fabric A squares end to end to make the Top Border. Repeat to make the Bottom Border. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Side Border to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center to make the Quilt Top.

## Finishing the Quilt

11. Layer and quilt as desired.
12. Sew together the (6) binding strips end to end with 45-degree seams. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
13. Bind as desired.
