Quilt Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. Fabrics are cut to exact length required plus ¼" seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

- Fabric A** Cut (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (6) 4 ½" squares.
- Fabric B** Cut (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (24) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
- Fabric C** Cut (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (48) 2 ½" squares.
- Fabric D** Cut (3) 2 ⅞" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (36) 2 ⅞" squares.
Cut (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (24) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
- Fabric E** Cut (3) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (20) 4 ½" squares.
- Fabric F** Cut (2) 2 ⅞" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (24) 2 ⅞" squares.
- Fabric G** Cut (1) 2 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (12) 2 ⅞" squares.
- Fabric H** Cut (1) 2 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (12) 2 ⅞" squares.
Cut (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (24) 2 ½" squares.
- Fabric I** Cut (1) 2 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (12) 2 ⅞" squares.
Cut (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (24) 2 ½" squares.

- Fabric J** Cut (3) 2 ⅞" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (36) 2 ⅞" squares.
Cut (24) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (372) 2 ½" squares.
Cut (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (24) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
Cut (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 68 ½" strips.
Cut (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 56 ½" strips.
- Fabric K** Cut (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (6) 4 ½" squares.
- Fabric L** Cut (4) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (31) 4 ½" squares.
Cut (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (24) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
- Fabric M** Cut (1) 2 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (12) 2 ⅞" squares.
Cut (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (62) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

Quilt Cutting Directions - Continued

- Fabric N** Cut (3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (48) 2 1/2" squares.
- Fabric O** Cut (7) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (62) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.
- Binding** Cut (7) 2 1/2" x WOF strips.
- Backing** Cut (2) 64" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make (1) 64" x 80" backing.

Making the Quilt

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.

Block Assembly

- Place (1) 2 1/2" Fabric J square on the left side of (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric O strip, right sides together (Diagram 1). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.

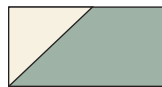

- Place another 2 1/2" Fabric J square on the right side of the 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric O strip, right sides together (Diagram 3). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Diagram 3). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Diagram 4).

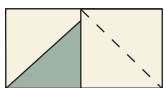

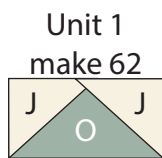

- Repeat Steps 1-2 and refer to Diagrams 5-7 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (62) Unit 2 strips, (24) Unit 3 strips and (24) Unit 4 strips.

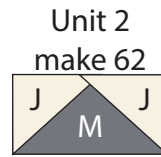

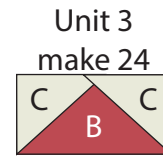

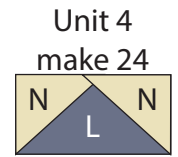

- Place (1) 2 1/2" Fabric J square on the top left corner of (1) 4 1/2" Fabric L square, right sides together (Diagram 8). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 8). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 9). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam.

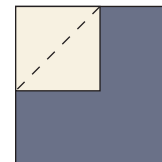

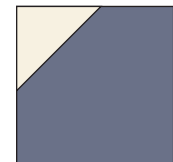

- Follow Diagram 10 for the seam direction to add a 2 1/2" Fabric J square to each of the remaining corners of the 4 1/2" Fabric L square to make (1) Unit 5 square (Diagram 11).

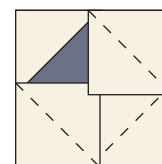

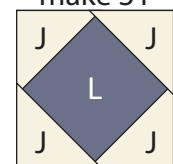

- Repeat Steps 5-6 to make an additional (30) Unit 5 squares.

- Sew together (2) Unit 1 strips, (2) Unit 2 strips and (1) Unit 5 square as shown to make (1) 4 1/2" x 12 1/2" Block One rectangle (Diagram 12). Repeat to make an additional (30) Block One rectangles.

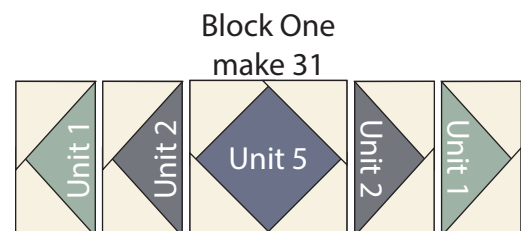
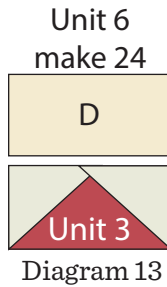


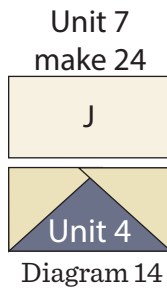

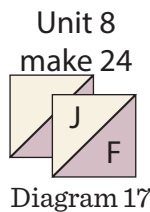
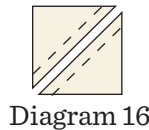
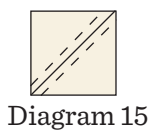
9. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric D strip to the top of (1) Unit 3 strip to make (1) 4 1/2" Unit 6 square (Diagram 13). Repeat to make an additional (23) Unit 6 squares.



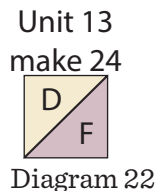
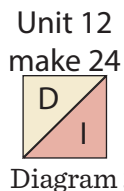
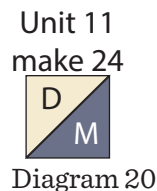
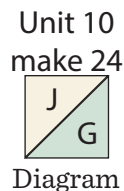
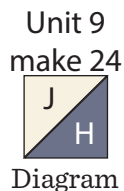
10. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric J strip to the top of (1) Unit 4 strip to make (1) 4 1/2" Unit 7 square (Diagram 14). Repeat to make an additional (23) Unit 7 squares.



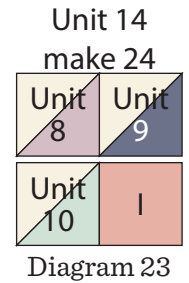
11. Place (1) 2 7/8" Fabric J square on top of (1) 2 7/8" Fabric F square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Diagram 15). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 15). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 16) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 2 1/2" to make (2) Unit 8 squares (Diagram 17). Repeat to make an additional (23) Unit 8 squares.



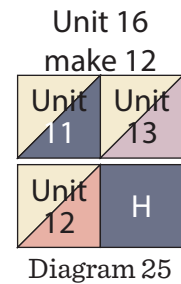
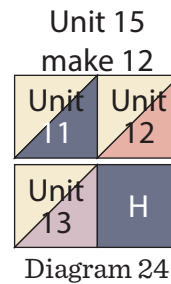
12. Repeat Step 11 and refer to Diagrams 18-22 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make the indicated number of 2 1/2" unit squares for Unit 9 through Unit 13.



13. Sew (1) Unit 8 square to the left side of (1) Unit 9 square to make the top row. Sew (1) Unit 10 square to the left side of (1) 2 1/2" Fabric I square to make the bottom row. Sew together the (2) pieced rows lengthwise to make (1) 4 1/2" Unit 14 square (Diagram 23). Repeat to make an additional (23) Unit 14 squares.

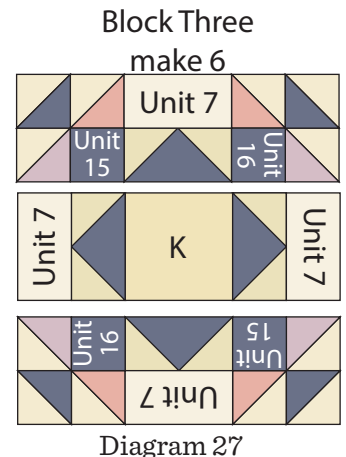
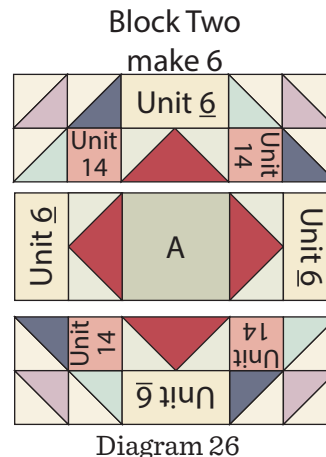


14. Repeat Step 13 and refer to Diagrams 24-25 for fabric/unit identification, placement and orientation to make (12) Unit 15 squares and (12) Unit 16 squares.



15. Sew (1) Unit 14 square to each side of (1) Unit 6 square to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 6 square to each side of (1) 4 1/2" Fabric A square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) pieced rows lengthwise to make (1) 12 1/2" Block Two square (Diagram 26). Repeat to make an additional (5) Block Two squares.

16. Repeat Step 15 and refer to Diagram 27 for fabric/unit identification, placement and orientation to make (6) 12 1/2" Block Three squares.

17. Sew together (4) 4 1/2" Fabric E squares and (3) Block One rectangles, end to end and alternating them from left to right, to make Row One (Diagram 28). Repeat to make Row Three, Row Five, Row Seven and Row Nine.
18. Sew together (4) Block One rectangles, (2) Block Two squares and (1) Block Three square as shown to make Row Two (Diagram 28). Repeat to make Row Six.
19. Sew together (4) Block One rectangles, (2) Block Three squares and (1) Block Two square as shown to make Row Four (Diagram 28). Repeat to make Row Eight.
20. Sew together the (9) pieced Rows, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the 52 1/2" x 68 1/2" Quilt Center (Diagram 28).

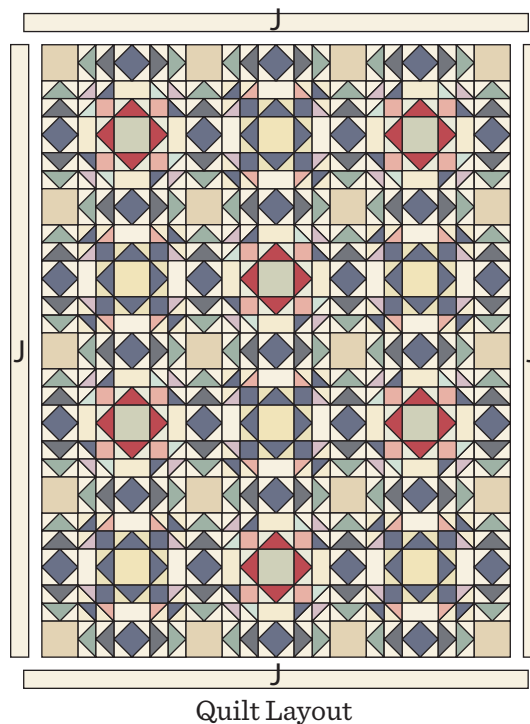
Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)

21. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 68 1/2" Fabric J strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 56 1/2" Fabric J strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center to make the Quilt Top.

Finishing the Quilt

22. Layer and quilt as desired.
23. Sew together the (7) binding strips end to end with 45-degree seams. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
24. Bind as desired.

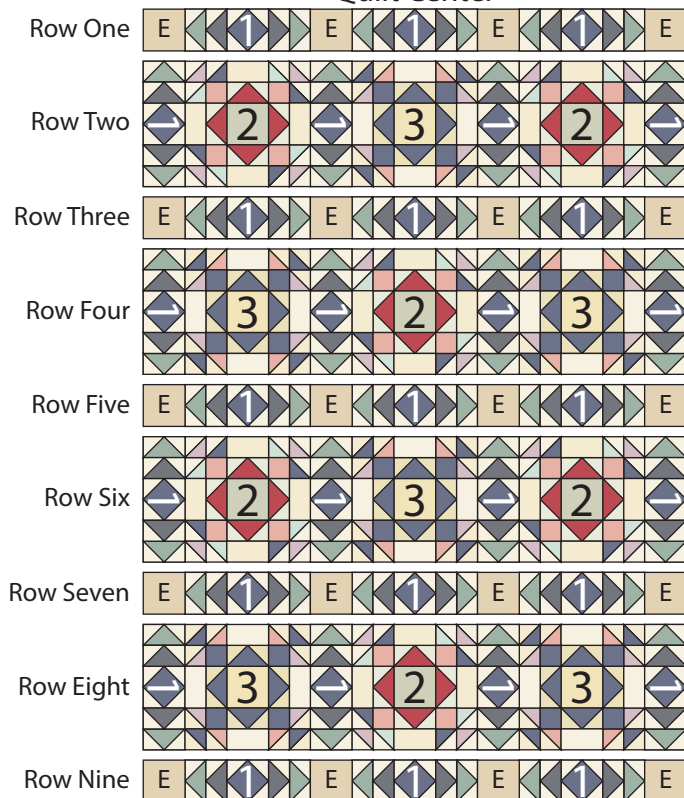
