Month One Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. Use ¼" seam allowance throughout. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

- Fabric H** Cut (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 3" x 5 ½" strips and (4) 3" squares.
- Fabric J** Cut (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 3" squares.
Cut (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 3" x 10 ½" strips.
- Fabric N** Cut (1) 3 ⅜" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 3 ⅜" squares and (4) 3" x 5 ½" strips.
Cut (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (12) 3" squares.
- Fabric O** Cut (2) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (8) 5 ½" squares.
- Fabric P** Cut (1) 3 ⅜" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 3 ⅜" squares and (4) 3" squares.
- Fabric S** Cut (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 3" squares.
- Fabric V** Cut (1) 3 ⅜" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 3 ⅜" squares.
- Fabric W** Cut (1) 3 ⅜" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 3 ⅜" squares and (8) 3" squares.



Fabric S blocks	¼ yard	10475-B
Fabric V blocks	¼ yard	10477-L
Fabric W blocks	¼ yard	10478-B


Making the Block

Note: The arrows in diagrams represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Place (1) 3 ⅜" Fabric P square on top of (1) 3 ⅜" Fabric V square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Diagram 1-1). Sew ¼" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 1-1). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 1-2) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 3" square to make (2) Unit 1 squares (Diagram 1-3). Repeat to make an additional (2) Unit 1 squares.



2. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Diagram 1-4 for fabric identification and placement to make (8) 3" Unit 2 squares.



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- Sew together (4) Unit 1 squares into a 2 x 2 matrix to make (1) 5 1/2" Unit 3 square (Diagram 1-5).
- Sew (1) 3" Fabric N square to the left side of (1) Unit 2 square to make the top row. Sew (1) Unit 2 square to the left side of (1) 3" Fabric J square to make the bottom row. Sew together the (2) rows lengthwise to make (1) 5 1/2" Unit 4 square (Diagram 1-6). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 4 squares.





- Place (1) 3" Fabric P square on the left side of (1) 3" x 5 1/2" Fabric H strip, right sides together (Diagram 1-7). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 1-7). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 1-8). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.



- Place (1) 3" Fabric S square on the right side of the 3" x 5 1/2" Fabric H strip, right sides together (Diagram 1-9). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Diagram 1-9). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 5 strip (Diagram 1-10).





- Repeat Steps 5-6 and refer to Diagram 1-11 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (4) 3" x 5 1/2" Unit 6 strips.



- Sew (1) 3" Fabric H square to each end of (1) Unit 5 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 5 strip to each side of (1) Unit 3 square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) pieced rows lengthwise to make (1) 10 1/2" Unit 7 square (Diagram 1-12).



- Sew (1) 3" Fabric N square to each end of (1) Unit 6 strip. Sew (1) 3" x 10 1/2" Fabric J strip to the bottom of the newly sewn strip lengthwise to make (1) 10 1/2" x 5 1/2" Unit 8 rectangle (Diagram 1-13). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 8 rectangles.



- Place (1) 5 1/2" Fabric O square on the left side of (1) Unit 8 rectangle, right sides together (Diagram 1-14). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Diagram 1-14). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 1-15). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.





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12. Place another 5 1/2" Fabric O square on the right side of the Unit 8 rectangle, right sides together (Diagram 1-16). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 1-16). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 9 rectangle (Diagram 1-17).

13. Repeat Steps 11-12 to make an additional (3) Unit 9 rectangles.



14. Sew (1) Unit 4 square to each end of (1) Unit 9 rectangle to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 9 rectangle to each side of the Unit 7 square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) pieced rows lengthwise to make the 20 1/2" Block One square (Diagram 1-18).






