Month Two Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. Use ¼" seam allowance throughout. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

- Fabric B** Cut (1) Template T-2 square.

- Fabric E** Cut (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 3" squares.
 Cut (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 3" x 10 ½" strips.

- Fabric I** Cut (2) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (8) 5 ½" squares.

- Fabric O** Cut (4) Template T-1 shapes.

- Fabric P** Cut (2) 2 ⅞" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (4) 2 ⅞" triangles.

- Fabric R** Cut (1) 3 ⅜" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 3 ⅜" squares and (4) 3" x 5 ½" strips.
 Cut (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (12) 3" squares.

- Fabric W** Cut (1) 3 ⅜" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 3 ⅜" squares and (8) 3" squares.

- Fabric FF** Cut (1) 7 ¼" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (1) 7 ¼" square and (4) 2 ½" squares. Cut the 7 ¼" square across both diagonals to make (4) 7 ¼" triangles.

Making the Block

Note: The arrows in diagrams represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

- Sew (1) 2 ⅞" Fabric P triangle to the bottom of (1) 2 ½" Fabric FF square (Diagram 2-1). Sew (1) Fabric O Template 1 segment to the left side of the newly sewn piece to make (1) Unit 10 piece (Diagram 2-1). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 10 pieces.

- Sew (1) 7 ¼" Fabric FF triangle to each side of (1) Unit 10 piece to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 10 piece to each side of (1) Fabric B Template 2 square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) 10 ½" Unit 11 square (Diagram 2-2).




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3. Place (1) $3\frac{3}{8}$ " Fabric W square on top of (1) $3\frac{3}{8}$ " Fabric R square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Diagram 2-3). Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 2-3). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 2-4) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 3" square to make (2) Unit 12 squares (Diagram. 2-5). Repeat to make an additional (6) Unit 12 squares.





4. Sew (1) 3" Fabric R square to the left side of (1) Unit 12 square to make the top row. Sew (1) Unit 12 square to the left side of (1) 3" Fabric E square to make the bottom row. Sew together the (2) rows lengthwise to make (1) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 13 square (Diagram 2-6). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 13 squares.



5. Place (1) 3" Fabric W square on the left side of (1) $3\frac{3}{8}$ x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric R strip, right sides together (Diagram 2-7). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 2-7). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 2-8). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

6. Place another 3" Fabric W square on the right side of the Fabric R strip, right sides together (Diagram 2-9). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Diagram 2-9). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance to make (1) Unit 14 strip (Diagram 2-10).

7. Repeat Steps 5-6 to make an additional (3) Unit 14 strips.





8. Sew (1) 3" Fabric R square to each end of (1) Unit 14 strip. Sew (1) $3\frac{3}{8}$ x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to the bottom of the newly sewn strip lengthwise to make (1) $10\frac{1}{2}$ x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 15 rectangle (Diagram 2-11). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 15 rectangles.



9. Place (1) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I square on the left side of (1) Unit 15 rectangle, right sides together (Diagram 2-12). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Diagram 2-12). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 2-13). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.





10. Place another $5\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I square on the right side of the Unit 15 rectangle, right sides together (Diagram 2-14). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 2-14). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance to make (1) Unit 16 rectangle (Diagram 2-15).

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11. Repeat Steps 9-10 to make an additional (3) Unit 16 rectangles.




12. Sew (1) Unit 13 square to each end of (1) Unit 16 rectangle to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 16 rectangle to each side of the Unit 11 square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) pieced rows lengthwise to make the 20 1/2" Block Two square (Diagram 2-16)




