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

## Month Three Cutting Directions

**Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches.** Use ¼" seam allowance throughout. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

**Fabric B** Cut (1) 5 ½" square.

**Fabric F** Cut (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 3" x 10 ½" strips.  
 Cut (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 3" squares.

**Fabric L** Cut (1) 3 ⅜" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 3 ⅜" squares and (2) 3" squares.  
 Cut (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (14) 3" squares.  
 Cut (2) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (8) 3" x 5 ½" strips.

**Fabric P** Cut (1) 3 ⅜" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 3 ⅜" squares.

**Fabric U** Cut (1) 3 ⅜" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 3 ⅜" squares and (8) 3" squares.

**Fabric Y** Cut (1) 3 ⅜" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 3 ⅜" squares.

**Fabric EE** Cut (2) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (8) 5 ½" squares.

## Making the Block

**Note: The arrows in diagrams represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.**

- Place (1) 3 ⅜" Fabric U square on top of (1) 3 ⅜" Fabric L square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Diagram 3-1). Sew ¼" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 3-1). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 3-2) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 3" square to make (2) Unit 17 squares (Diagram 3-3). Repeat to make an additional (6) Unit 17 squares.





- Repeat Step 1 and refer to Diagram 3-4 for fabric identification and placement to make (8) 3" Unit 18 squares.



# Whispered Wishes BOM - Month Three

3. Sew (1) 3" Fabric L square to the left side of (1) Unit 17 square to make the top row. Sew (1) Unit 17 square to the left side of (1) 3" Fabric F square to make the bottom row. Sew together the (2) rows lengthwise to make (1) 5 1/2" Unit 19 square (Diagram 3-5). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 19 squares.



4. Place (1) 3" Unit 18 square on the left side of (1) 3" x 5 1/2" Fabric L strip, right sides together (Diagram 3-6). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 3-6). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 3-7). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.





5. Place another 3" Unit 18 square on the right side of the Fabric L strip, right sides together (Diagram 3-8). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Diagram 3-8). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 20 strip (Diagram 3-9).






7. Repeat Steps 4-5 and refer to Diagram 3-10 while using (8) 3" Fabric U squares and (4) 3" x 5 1/2" Fabric L strips to make (4) Unit 21 strips.



8. Sew (1) 3" Fabric L square to each end of (1) Unit 20 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 20 strip to each side of (1) 5 1/2" Fabric B square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) 10 1/2" Unit 22 square (Diagram 3-11).



9. Sew (1) 3" Fabric L strip to each end of (1) Unit 21 strip. Sew (1) 3" x 10 1/2" Fabric F strip to the bottom of the newly sewn strip to make (1) 10 1/2" x 5 1/2" Unit 23 rectangle (Diagram 3-12). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 23 rectangles.



10. Place (1) 5 1/2" Fabric EE square on the left side of (1) Unit 23 rectangle, right sides together (Diagram 3-13). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Diagram 3-13). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 3-14). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.





11. Place another 5 1/2" Fabric EE square on the right side of the Unit 23 rectangle, right sides together (Diagram 3-15). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 3-15). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 24 rectangle (Diagram 3-16).

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12. Repeat Steps 10-11 to make an additional (3) Unit 24 rectangles.





13. Sew (1) Unit 19 square to each end of (1) Unit 24 rectangle to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 24 rectangle to each side of the Unit 22 square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) pieced rows lengthwise to make the 20 1/2" Block Three square (Diagram 3-17).






