Month Four Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. Use ¼" seam allowance throughout. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

- Fabric A** Cut (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 3" x 10 ½" strips.
 Cut (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 3" squares.
- Fabric B** Cut (1) 3 ¾" square. Cut the square across both diagonals to make (4) 3 ¾" triangles.
- Fabric C** Cut (2) 3 ⅜" squares.
- Fabric G** Cut (1) 3 ⅜" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 3 ⅜" squares and (4) 3" x 5 ½" strips.
 Cut (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (12) 3" squares.
- Fabric O** Cut (1) 3 ⅜" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 3 ⅜" squares and (8) 3" squares. Cut the 3 ⅜" squares across (1) diagonal to make (4) 3 ⅜" triangles.
- Fabric P** Cut (1) 3 ¾" square. Cut the square across both diagonals to make (4) 3 ¾" triangles.
- Fabric W** Cut (1) 3 ⅜" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 3 ⅜" squares and (8) 3" squares.
- Fabric Y** Cut (2) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (8) 5 ½" squares.
- Fabric FF** Cut (1) 3 ⅜" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 3 ⅜" squares and (4) 3" x 5 ½" strips.

Making the Block

Note: The arrows in diagrams represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Sew together (1) 3 ¾" Fabric B triangle and (1) 3 ¾" Fabric P triangle along short sides. Sew (1) 3 ⅜" Fabric O triangle to the long side of the newly sewn triangle to make (1) 3" Unit 25 square (Diagram 4-1). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 25 squares.

2. Sew the (4) Unit 25 square together into a 2 x 2 matrix to make (1) 5 ½" Unit 26 square (Diagram 4-2).








3. Place (1) 3 3/8" Fabric W square on top of (1) 3 3/8" Fabric G square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Diagram 4-3). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 4-3). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 4-4) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the blocks to measure 3" square to make (2) Unit 27 squares (Diagram. 4-5). Repeat to make an additional (6) Unit 27 squares.




7. Place another 3" Fabric O square on the right side of the 3" x 5 1/2" Fabric FF strip, right sides together (Diagram 4-10). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Diagram 4-10). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 30 strip (Diagram 4-11).
8. Repeat Steps 6-7 to make an additional (3) Unit 30 strips.




4. Repeat Step 3 and refer to Diagram 4-6 for fabric identification and placement to make (4) 3" Unit 28 squares.




9. Repeat Steps 6-7 and refer to Diagram 4-12 for fabric identification and placement to make (4) 3" x 5 1/2" Unit 31 strips.




5. Sew (1) 3" Fabric G square to the left side of (1) Unit 27 square to make the top row. Sew (1) Unit 27 square to the left side of (1) 3" Fabric A square to make the bottom row. Sew together the (2) rows lengthwise to make (1) 5 1/2" Unit 29 square (Diagram 4-7). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 29 squares.




10. Sew (1) Unit 28 square to each end of (1) Unit 30 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 30 strip to each side of the Unit 26 square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together lengthwise to make (1) 10 1/2" Unit 32 square (Diagram 4-13).



6. Place (1) 3" Fabric O square on the left side of (1) 3" x 5 1/2" Fabric FF strip, right sides together (Diagram 4-8). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 4-8). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 4-9). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.



11. Sew (1) 3" Fabric G square to each end of (1) Unit 31 strip. Sew (1) 3" x 10 1/2" Fabric A strip to the bottom of the newly sewn strip lengthwise to make (1) 10 1/2" x 5 1/2" Unit 33 rectangle (Diagram 4-14). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 33 rectangles.



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12. Place (1) 5 1/2" Fabric Y square on the left side of (1) Unit 33 rectangle, right sides together (Diagram 4-15). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Diagram 4-15). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 4-16). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.





13. Place another 5 1/2" Fabric Y square on the right side of the Unit 33 rectangle, right sides together (Diagram 4-17). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 4-17). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 34 rectangle (Diagram 4-18).





15. Sew (1) Unit 29 square to each end of (1) Unit 34 rectangle to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 34 rectangle to each side of the Unit 32 square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) pieced rows lengthwise to make the 20 1/2" Block Four square (Diagram 4-19).





14. Repeat Steps 12-13 to make an additional (3) Unit 34 rectangles.




