Month Five Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. Use $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance throughout. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

Fabric H Cut (1) $3\frac{3}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) $3\frac{3}{8}$ " squares and (4) 3 " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Fabric K Cut (1) 3 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (8) 3 " squares.

Fabric M Cut (1) 3 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 3 " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
Cut (1) 3 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 3 " squares.

Fabric Q Cut (1) $3\frac{3}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) $3\frac{3}{8}$ " squares and (4) 3 " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
Cut (1) 3 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (12) 3 " squares.

Fabric S Cut (2) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (8) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Fabric U Cut (1) $6\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (1) $6\frac{1}{4}$ " square and (2) $3\frac{3}{8}$ " squares. Cut the $6\frac{1}{4}$ " square across both diagonals to make (4) $6\frac{1}{4}$ " triangles. *Note: You will only use (2) $6\frac{1}{4}$ " triangles.*

Fabric V Cut (1) $6\frac{1}{4}$ " square. Cut the square across both diagonals to make (4) $6\frac{1}{4}$ " triangles. *Note: You will only use (2) $6\frac{1}{4}$ " triangles.*

Fabric W Cut (1) $3\frac{3}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) $3\frac{3}{8}$ " squares and (8) 3 " squares.

Making the Block

Note: The arrows in diagrams represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Place (1) $3\frac{3}{8}$ " Fabric W square on top of (1) $3\frac{3}{8}$ " Fabric Q square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Diagram 5-1). Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 5-1). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 5-2) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 3 " square to make (2) Unit 35 squares (Diagram 5-3). Repeat to make an additional (6) Unit 35 squares.


2. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Diagram 5-4 for fabric identification and placement to make (4) 3 " Unit 36 squares.





3. Sew (1) 3" Fabric Q square to the left side of (1) Unit 35 square to make the top row. Sew (1) Unit 35 square to the left side of (1) 3" Fabric M square to make the bottom row. Sew the (2) rows together lengthwise to make (1) 5 1/2" Unit 37 square (Diagram 5-5). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 37 squares.



4. Refer to Diagram 5-6 and sew together (2) 6 1/4" Fabric V triangles and (2) 6 1/4" Fabric U triangles as shown to make (1) 5 1/2" Unit 38 square.



5. Place (1) 3" Fabric K square on the left side of (1) 3" x 5 1/2" Fabric H strip, right sides together (Diagram 5-7). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 5-7). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 5-8). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.




6. Place another 3" Fabric K square on the right side of the 3" x 5 1/2" Fabric H strip, right sides together (Diagram 5-9). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Diagram 5-9). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 39 strip (Diagram 5-10).






8. Repeat Steps 5-6 and refer to Diagram 5-11 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (4) Unit 40 strips.



9. Sew (1) Unit 36 square to each end of (1) Unit 39 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 39 strip to each side of the Unit 38 square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) 10 1/2" Unit 41 square (Diagram 5-12).



10. Sew (1) 3" Fabric Q square to each end of (1) Unit 40 strip. Sew (1) 3" x 10 1/2" Fabric M strip to the bottom of the newly sewn strip lengthwise to make (1) 10 1/2" x 5 1/2" Unit 42 rectangle (Diagram 5-13). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 42 rectangles.



11. Place (1) 5 1/2" Fabric S square on the left side of (1) Unit 42 rectangle, right sides together (Diagram 5-14). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Diagram 5-14). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 5-15). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.





12. Place another 5 1/2" Fabric S square on the right side of the Unit 42 rectangle, right sides together (Diagram 5-16). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 5-16). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 43 rectangle (Diagram 5-17).

13. Repeat Steps 11-12 to make an additional (3) Unit 43 rectangles.





14. Sew (1) Unit 37 to each end of (1) Unit 43 rectangle to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 44 rectangle to each side of the Unit 41 square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make the 20 1/2" Block Five square (Diagram 5-18).





