## Month Seven Cutting Directions

**Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches.** Use ¼" seam allowance throughout. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

- Fabric T** Cut (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 3" squares.
- Fabric X** Cut (2) 1 ¾" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (32) 1 ¾" squares.
- Fabric Z** Cut (2) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (8) 5 ½" x 10 ½" strips.  
Cut (5) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (32) 3" x 5 ½" strips.  
Cut (3) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (32) 3" squares.
- Fabric AA** Cut (3) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (32) 3" squares.  
Cut (2) 1 ¾" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (16) 1 ¾" x 3" strips.  
Cut (1) 1 ¾" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (16) 1 ¾" squares.
- Fabric BB** Cut (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 3" squares.  
Cut (2) 1 ¾" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (32) 1 ¾" squares.
- Fabric CC** Cut (3) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (32) 3" squares.  
Cut (2) 1 ¾" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (16) 1 ¾" x 3" strips.  
Cut (1) 1 ¾" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (16) 1 ¾" squares.

## Fabric Requirements

<b>Fabric T</b> blocks	¼ yard	10475-L
<b>Fabric X</b> blocks	¼ yard	10478-L
<b>Fabric Z</b> blocks	1 ⅛ yards	10480-L
<b>Fabric AA</b> blocks	½ yard	10481-B
<b>Fabric BB</b> blocks	¼ yard	10482-L
<b>Fabric CC</b> blocks	½ yard	10483-B

## Making the Block

**Note: The arrows in diagrams represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.**

1. Place (1) 1 ¾" Fabric BB square on the left side of (1) 1 ¾" x 3" Fabric AA strip, right sides together (Diagram 7-1). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 7-1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 7-2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance.

2. Place another 1 ¾" Fabric BB square on the right side of the 1 ¾" x 3" Fabric AA strip, right sides together (Diagram 7-3). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Diagram 7-3). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 45 strip (Diagram 7-4).
3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make an additional (15) Unit 45 strips.




4. Repeat Steps 1-2 and refer to Diagram 7-5 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (16) 1 3/4" x 3" Unit 46 strips.



5. Sew (1) 1 3/4" Fabric AA square to each end of (1) Unit 45 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 45 to each side of (1) 3" Fabric BB square to make (1) 5 1/2" Unit 47 square (Diagram 7-6). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 47 squares.






7. Place (1) 3" Fabric AA square on the left side of (1) 3" x 5 1/2" Fabric Z strip, right sides together (Diagram 7-8). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 7-8). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 7-9). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.




8. Place another 3" Fabric AA square on the right side of the 3" x 5 1/2" Fabric Z strip, right sides together (Diagram 7-10). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Diagram 7-10). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 49 strip (Diagram 7-11).


9. Repeat Steps 7-8 to make an additional (15) Unit 49 strips.
10. Repeat Steps 7-8 and refer to Diagram 7-12 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (16) Unit 50 strips.



11. Sew (1) 3" Fabric Z square to each end of (1) Unit 49 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 49 strip to each side of (1) Unit 47 square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) pieced rows lengthwise to make (1) 10 1/2" Block Seven A square (Diagram 7-13). Repeat to make an additional (3) Block Seven A squares.




12. Sew (1) 3" Fabric Z square to each end of (1) Unit 50 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 50 strip to each side of (1) Unit 48 square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) pieced rows lengthwise to make (1) 10 1/2" square (Diagram 7-14). Sew (1) 5 1/2" x 10 1/2" Fabric Z strip to each side of the newly sewn square to make (1) 20 1/2" x 10 1/2" Block Seven B rectangle (Diagram 7-14). Repeat to make an additional (3) Block Seven B rectangles.






