Block Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches.

Fabric A **Block One**
Cut (4) 5 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (8) 5 7/8" triangles.

Fabric B **Block One**
Cut (2) 6 1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (8) 6 1/4" triangles.
Block Two
Cut (1) 2 3/4" x 7 1/4" strip.

Fabric C **Block One**
Cut (2) 6 1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (8) 6 1/4" triangles.
Block Four
Cut (4) 2 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (8) 2 7/8" triangles.
Cut (4) 2 1/2" squares.

Fabric D **Block Two**
Cut (1) 2 3/4" x 9 1/2" strip.
Block Three
Cut (20) 3 1/2" squares.

Fabric E **Block Two**
Cut (1) 2 3/4" x 7 1/4" strip.

Fabric F **Block Two**
Cut (1) 2 3/4" x 5" strip.

Block Eight
Cut (2) 4 1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (8) 4 1/4" triangles.

Fabric G **Block Two**
Cut (1) 2 3/4" x 5" strip.
Block Eight
Cut (2) 4 1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (8) 4 1/4" triangles.

Fabric H **Block Two**
Cut (1) 2 3/4" square.
Block Three
Cut (5) 6 1/2" squares.

Fabric I **Block Two**
Cut (1) 2 3/4" square.

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Block Cutting Directions - Continued

Fabric J **Block Three**
Cut (2) 7 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (8) 7 ¼" triangles.

Block Seven
Cut (4) 3" squares.

Fabric K **Block Three**
Cut (24) 2 ⅜" squares. Cut (16) of the squares across (1) diagonal to make (32) 2 ⅜" triangles.

Fabric L **Block Four**
Cut (1) 4 ⅞" square. Cut the square across (1) diagonal to make (2) 4 ⅞" triangles.
Cut (3) 2 ½" squares.

Fabric M **Block Four**
Cut (4) 2 ½" squares.
Block Five
Cut (1) 6 ¼" square. Cut the square across both diagonals to make (4) 6 ¼" triangles.

Fabric N **Block Four**
Cut (1) 4 ⅞" square. Cut the square across (1) diagonal to make (2) 4 ⅞" triangles.
Cut (2) 2 ½" squares.

Fabric O **Block Five**
Cut (1) 5 ½" square.
Block Six
Cut (4) 3 ½" squares.
Cut (4) 2 ½" squares.

Fabric P **Block Five**
Cut (2) 6 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (8) 6 ¼" triangles.
Block Seven
Cut (4) 3" x 5 ½" strips.

Fabric Q **Block Five**
Cut (4) 3" squares.
Block Six
Cut (1) 6 ½" square.

Fabric R **Block Five**
Cut (4) 3 ⅜" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (8) 3 ⅜" triangles.
Cut (1) 6 ¼" square. Cut the square across both diagonals to make (4) 6 ¼" triangles.

Fabric S **Block Six**
Cut (4) 2 ½" x 6 ½" strips.
Block Seven
Cut (12) 3" squares.
Block Eight
Cut (4) 4 ⅞" squares cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (8) 4 ⅞" triangles.

Fabric T **Block Five**
Cut (2) 5 ⅞" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (4) 5 ⅞" triangles.


Fabric U **Block Seven**
Cut (4) 3" x 5 ½" strips.

Making the Blocks


Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.

Block One

1. Sew (1) 6 ¼" Fabric B triangle and (1) 6 ¼" Fabric C triangle together along short sides. Sew (1) 5 ⅞" Fabric A triangle to the long side of the newly sewn triangle to make (1) 5 ½" Unit 1 square (Diagram 1-1). Repeat to make an additional (7) Unit 1 squares.




2. Sew together the (8) Unit 1 squares into a 4 x 2 matrix to make the 20 ½" x 10 ½" Block One rectangle (Diagram 1-2).




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Block Two


1. Sew (1) $2\frac{3}{4}$ " Fabric I square to the left side of (1) $2\frac{3}{4}$ " Fabric H square. Sew (1) $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x 5" Fabric G strip to the bottom of the newly sewn strip lengthwise to make (1) 5" Unit 1 square (Diagram 2-1).



2. Sew (1) $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x 5" Fabric F strip to the right side of the Unit 1 square. Sew (1) $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric E strip to the bottom of the newly sewn rectangle to make (1) $7\frac{1}{4}$ " Unit 3 square (Diagram 2-2).





3. Sew (1) $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric B strip to the right side of the Unit 3 square. Sew (1) $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to the bottom of the newly sewn rectangle to make the $9\frac{1}{2}$ " Block Two square (Diagram 2-3).





Block Three

1. Place (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D square on the top left corner of (1) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H square, right sides together (Diagram 3-1). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 3-1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 3-2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the sewn seam.




2. Follow Diagram 3-3 for the seam direction to add a $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D square to each of the remaining corners of the $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H square to make (1) Unit 4 square (Diagram 3-4).




4. Place (1) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " Fabric K square on top of (1) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " Fabric F square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Diagram 3-5). Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 3-5). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 3-6) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 2" x 2" to make (2) Unit 5 squares (Diagram 3-7). Repeat to make an additional (14) Unit 5 squares.



5. Sew (2) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " Fabric K triangles to adjacent sides of (1) Unit 5 square along the Fabric F sides to make (1) Unit 6 triangle (Diagram 3-8). Repeat to make an additional (15) Unit 6 triangles.




6. Sew (2) Unit 6 triangles to the short sides of (1) $7\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric J triangle to make (1) Unit 7 rectangle (Diagram 3-9). Repeat to make an additional (7) Unit 7 rectangles.



3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make an additional (4) Unit 4 squares.

7. Sew together (2) Unit 7 rectangles lengthwise to make (1) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 8 square (Diagram 3-10). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 8 squares.



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- Sew (1) Unit 4 square to each side of (1) Unit 8 square to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 8 square to each side of (1) Unit 4 square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) pieced rows lengthwise to make the 18 1/2" Block Three square (Diagram 3-11).



Block Four

- Sew (2) 2 7/8" Fabric C triangles to adjacent sides of (1) 2 1/2" Fabric N square. Sew (1) 4 7/8" Fabric L triangle to the long side of the newly sewn triangle to make (1) 4 1/2" Unit 9 square (Diagram 4-1). Repeat to make a second Unit 9 square.



- Sew (2) 2 7/8" Fabric C triangles to adjacent sides of (1) 2 1/2" Fabric L square. Sew (1) 4 7/8" Fabric N triangle to the long side of the newly sewn triangle to make (1) 4 1/2" Unit 10 square (Diagram 4-2). Repeat to make a second Unit 10 square.




Diagram 4-2

- Sew (1) 2 1/2" Fabric C square to the left side of (1) 2 1/2" Fabric M square to make (1) 4 1/2" x 2 1/2" Unit 11 rectangle (Diagram 4-3). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 11 rectangles.



- Sew together (1) Unit 9 square, (1) Unit 11 rectangle and (1) Unit 10 square, in that order from left to right, to make the top row (Diagram 4-4).
- Sew (1) Unit 11 rectangle to each side of (1) 2 1/2" Fabric L square to make the middle row (Diagram 4-4).
- Sew together (1) Unit 10 square, (1) Unit 11 rectangle and (1) Unit 9 square, in that order from left to right, to make the bottom row (Diagram 4-4).
- Sew the (3) rows from Steps 4-6 together lengthwise to make the 10 1/2" Block Four square (Diagram 4-4).



Block Five

- Sew (2) 3 3/8" Fabric R triangles to adjacent sides of (1) 3" Fabric Q triangle. Sew (1) 5 7/8" Fabric T triangle to the long side of the newly sewn triangle to make (1) 5 1/2" Unit 12 square (Diagram 5-1). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 12 squares.



- Sew together (2) 6 1/4" Fabric P triangles, (1) 6 1/4" Fabric R triangle and (1) 6 1/4" Fabric M triangle to make (1) 5 1/2" Unit 13 square (Diagram 5-2). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 13 squares.




Diagram 5-2

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- Sew (1) Unit 12 square to each side of (1) Unit 13 square to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 13 square to each side of (1) 5 1/2" Fabric O square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) pieced rows lengthwise to make the 15 1/2" Block Five square (Diagram 5-3).



Block Six

- Place (1) 3 1/2" Fabric O square on the top left corner of (1) 6 1/2" Fabric Q square, right sides together (Diagram 6-1). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 6-1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 6-2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam.





- Follow Diagram 6-3 for the seam direction to add a 3 1/2" Fabric O square to each of the remaining corners of the 6 1/2" Fabric Q square to make (1) Unit 14 square (Diagram 6-4).





- Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" Fabric S strip to each side of the Unit 14 square. Sew (1) 2 1/2" Fabric O square to each end of (1) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" Fabric S strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) newly sewn strip to the top and bottom of the Unit 14 square to make the 10 1/2" Block Six square (Diagram 6-5).



Block Seven

- Place (1) 3" Fabric S square on the left side of (1) 3" x 5 1/2" Fabric P strip, right sides together (Diagram 7-1). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 7-1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 7-2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.





- Place another 3" Fabric S square on the right side of the 3" x 5 1/2" Fabric P strip, right sides together (Diagram 7-3). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Diagram 7-3). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 15 rectangle (Diagram 7-4).






- Repeat Steps 1-2 to make an additional (3) Unit 15 rectangles.

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
4. Repeat Steps 1-2 and refer to Diagram 7-5 for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make (4) 3" x 5 1/2" Unit 16 rectangles.



5. Sew (1) Unit 15 rectangle to the top of (1) Unit 16 rectangle lengthwise to make (1) 5 1/2" Unit 17 square (Diagram 7-6). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 17 squares.




6. Sew together the (4) Unit 17 squares into a 2 x 2 matrix to make the 10 1/2" Block Seven square (Diagram 7-7).




Block Eight


1. Sew together (1) 4 1/4" Fabric G triangle and (1) 4 1/4" Fabric F triangle along short sides. Sew (1) 4 5/8" Fabric S triangle to the long side of the newly sewn triangle to make (1) 4 1/4" Unit 18 square (Diagram 8-1). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 18 squares.



2. Sew together (1) 4 1/4" Fabric F triangle and (1) 4 1/4" Fabric G triangle along short sides. Sew (1) 4 5/8" Fabric S triangle to the long side of the newly sewn triangle to make (1) 4 1/4" Unit 19 square (Diagram 8-2). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 19 squares.



3. Sew together the (4) Unit 18 squares to make the top row. Sew the (4) Unit 19 squares together to make the bottom row. Sew together the (2) pieced rows lengthwise to make the 15 1/2" x 8" Block Eight rectangle (Diagram 8-3).




