## Block Cutting Directions

**Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches.**

### Fabric A Block One

Cut (4) 3" squares.

### Fabric B Block One

Cut (12) 3" squares.

### Block Four

Cut (8) Template 3.

### Block Seven

Cut (4) 3 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (8) 3 7/8" triangles.

### Fabric C Block One

Cut (4) 3" x 5 1/2" strips.

### Block Two

Cut (4) 3" squares.

### Block Six

Cut (2) 4 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (4) 4 7/8" triangles.

### Fabric D Block One

Cut (4) 3" x 5 1/2" strips.

### Block Two

Cut (2) 5 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (4) 5 7/8" triangles.

### Fabric E Block Two

Cut (1) 5 1/2" square.

Cut (2) 6 1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (8) 6 1/4" triangles.

Cut (2) 4 1/2" squares.

Cut (2) 2 1/2" squares.

### Block Five

Cut (1) 4 1/2" square.

Cut (4) 2 1/2" squares.

### Block Six

Cut (1) 5 1/4" square. Cut the square across both diagonals to make (4) 5 1/4" triangles.

Cut (1) 4 7/8" square. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (2) 4 7/8" triangles.

<b>Fabric I</b>	<b>Block Three</b> Cut (6) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
<b>Fabric J</b>	<b>Block Three</b> Cut (4) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. <b>Block Five</b> Cut (4) $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (8) $2\frac{7}{8}$ " triangles.
<b>Fabric K</b>	<b>Block Three</b> Cut (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. <b>Block Five</b> Cut (1) $5\frac{1}{4}$ " square. Cut the square across both diagonals to make (4) $5\frac{1}{4}$ " triangles.

Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (4) $4\frac{7}{8}$ " triangles. <b>Block Seven</b> Cut (1) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square. <b>Block Eight</b> Cut (1) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " square. Cut (4) 2" x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Cut (4) 2" squares.

Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (8) $2\frac{7}{8}$ " triangles. <b>Block Seven</b> Cut (4) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Cut (2) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. <b>Block Eight</b> Cut (4) 2" x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Cut (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square.
<b>Fabric T</b>	<b>Block Six</b> Cut (4) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. <b>Block Seven</b> Cut (8) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

## Making the Blocks

**Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.**

### Block One

- Place (1) 3" Fabric B square on the left side of (1) 3" x 5 1/2" Fabric C strip, right sides together (Diagram 1-1). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 1-1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 1-2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.



- Place another 3" Fabric B square on the right side of the 3" x 5 1/2" Fabric C strip, right sides together (Diagram 1-3). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Diagram 3). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 1 rectangle (Diagram 1-4).
- Repeat Steps 1-2 to make an additional (3) Unit 1 rectangles.
- Repeat Steps 1-2 and refer to Diagram 1-5 for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make (4) 3" x 5 1/2" Unit 2 rectangles.







- Sew (1) Unit 1 rectangle to the top of (1) Unit 2 rectangle lengthwise to make (1) 5 1/2" Unit 3 square (Diagram 1-6). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 3 squares.



- Sew together the (4) Unit 3 squares into a 2 x 2 matrix to make the 10 1/2" Block One square (Diagram 1-7).



### Block Two

- Sew (2) 3 3/8" Fabric E triangles to adjacent sides of (1) 3" Fabric C square. Sew (1) 5 7/8" Fabric D triangle to the long side of the newly sewn triangle to make (1) 5 1/2" Unit 4 square (Diagram 2-1). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 4 squares.



- Sew together (2) 6 1/4" Fabric F triangles and (2) 6 1/4" Fabric E triangles to make (1) 5 1/2" Unit 5 square (Diagram 2-2). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 5 squares.



- Sew (1) Unit 4 square to each side of (1) Unit 5 square to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 5 square to each side of (1) 5 1/2" Fabric E square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) pieced rows lengthwise to make the 15 1/2" Block Two square (Diagram 2-3).






## Block Three


1. Sew together (1) 2 1/2" Fabric K square, (1) 2 1/2" Fabric J square and (1) 2 1/2" Fabric I square, in that order from left to right, to make the top row (Diagram 3-1).
2. Sew together (1) 2 1/2" Fabric J square, (1) 2 1/2" Fabric I square and (1) 2 1/2" Fabric H square, in that order from left to right, to make the middle row (Diagram 3-1).
3. Sew (1) 2 1/2" Fabric I square to the left end of (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric H strip to make the bottom row (Diagram 3-1).

4. Sew together the (3) pieced rows from Steps 1-3 lengthwise to make (1) 6 1/2" Unit 6 square (Diagram 3-1).




5. Repeat Steps 1-4 to make a second Unit 6 square.

6. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric H strip to the left side of (1) 2 1/2" Fabric G square to make the top row. Sew (1) 4 1/2" Fabric G square to the left side of (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric H strip to make the bottom row. Sew together the (2) pieced rows lengthwise to make (1) 6 1/2" Unit 7 square (Diagram 3-2). Repeat to make a second Unit 7 square.




7. Sew (1) Unit 6 square to the left side of (1) Unit 7 square to make the top row. Sew (1) Unit 7 square to the left side of (1) Unit 6 square to make the bottom row. Sew together the (2) pieced rows lengthwise to make the 12 1/2" Block Three square (Diagram 3-3).




## Block Four

1. Using your favorite paper piecing method and the templates provided on Page 10-11, make (8) 3" x 10 1/2" Unit 8 rectangles (Diagram 4-1). *Note: Pay attention to the sewing order of the triangles as listed on the templates.*




2. Sew together the (4) Unit 8 rectangles lengthwise as shown to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew together the (2) pieced rows to make the 10 1/2" x 20 1/2" Block Four rectangle (Diagram 4-2).





## Block Five


1. Sew (2)  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric J triangles to adjacent sides of (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G square. Sew (1)  $4\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric O triangle to the long side of the newly sewn triangle to make (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 9 square (Diagram 5-1). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 9 squares.



2. Sew together (2)  $5\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric M triangles, (1)  $5\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric N triangle and (1)  $5\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric K triangle as shown to make (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 10 square (Diagram 5-2). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 10 squares.




3. Sew (1) Unit 9 square to each side of (1) Unit 10 square to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 10 square to each side of (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) pieced rows lengthwise to make the  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " Block Five square (Diagram 5-3).



## Block Six

1. Sew (2)  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric S triangles to adjacent sides of (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric T square. Sew (1)  $4\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric C triangle to the long side of the newly sewn triangle to make (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 11 square (Diagram 6-1). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 11 squares.



2. Place (1)  $4\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric Q square on top of (1)  $4\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric R square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Diagram 6-2). Sew  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 6-2). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 6-3) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " to make (2) Unit 12 squares (Diagram 6-4). Repeat to make an additional (2) Unit 12 squares.



3. Sew together (1)  $5\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric Q triangle and (1)  $5\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric G triangle along short sides (Diagram 5). Sew (1)  $4\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric M triangle to the long side of the newly sewn triangle to make (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 13 square (Diagram 6-5). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 13 squares.



4. Repeat Step 3 and refer to Diagrams 6-6 – 6-7 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (2)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 14 squares and (2)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 15 squares.



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
- Sew together (1) Unit 11 square, (1) Unit 12 square, (1) Unit 13 square and (1) Unit 11 square, in that order from left to right, to make Row One (Diagram 6-8).
- Repeat Step 5 and refer to Diagram 6-8 for component identification, placement and orientation to make Row Two, Row Three and Row Four.
- Sew together the (4) pieced rows, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the 16 1/2" Block Six square (Diagram 6-8).




- Sew (2) 3 7/8" Fabric B triangles to adjacent sides of (1) Unit 16 square to make (1) Unit 17 triangle (Diagram 7-4). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 17 triangles.



- Sew (1) 6 7/8" Fabric R triangle to the long side of (1) Unit 17 triangle to make (1) 6 1/2" Unit 18 square (Diagram 7-5). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 18 squares.



- Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" Fabric T strip to the top and bottom of (1) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" Fabric S strip lengthwise to make (1) 6 1/2" Unit 19 square (Diagram 7-6). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 19 squares.



- Place (1) 3 1/2" Fabric Q square on the top left corner of (1) 6 1/2" Fabric M square, right sides together (Diagram 7-7). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 7-7). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 7-8). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam.



- Follow Diagram 7-9 for the seam direction to add a 3 1/2" Fabric Q square to each of the remaining corners of the 6 1/2" Fabric M square to make (1) Unit 20 square (Diagram 7-10).





## Block Seven

- Place (1) 3 7/8" Fabric S square on top of (1) 3 7/8" Fabric Q square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Diagram 7-1). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 7-1). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 7-2) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" to make (2) Unit 16 squares (Diagram 7-3). Repeat to make an additional (2) Unit 16 squares.



# Palette Play Club - Dusk

- Sew (1) Unit 18 square to each side of (1) Unit 19 square to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 19 square to each side of the Unit 20 square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) pieced rows lengthwise to make the 18 1/2" Block Seven square (Diagram 7-11).



## Block Eight

- Place (1) 2" Fabric G square on the left side of (1) 2" x 3 1/2" Fabric S strip, right sides together (Diagram 8-5). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 8-5). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 8-6). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.
- Place (1) 2" Fabric M square on the right side of the 2" x 3 1/2" Fabric S strip, right sides together (Diagram 8-7). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Diagram 8-7). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 23 rectangle (Diagram 8-8).
- Repeat Steps 3-4 to make an additional (3) Unit 23 rectangles.



- Place (1) 3 7/8" Fabric M square on top of (1) 3 7/8" Fabric P square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Diagram 8-1). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 8-1). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 8-2) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" to make (2) Unit 21 squares (Diagram 8-3).





- Place (1) 2" Fabric G square on the left side of (1) 2" x 3 1/2" Fabric M strip, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) 2" x 3 1/2" Unit 24 rectangle (Diagram 8-9). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 24 rectangles.




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
7. Sew (1) Unit 23 rectangle to the top of (1) Unit 24 rectangle lengthwise to make (1) 3 1/2" Unit 25 square (Diagram 8-10). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 25 squares.



8. Sew (1) Unit 21 square, (1) Unit 25 rectangle and (1) Unit 22 square together in that order from left to right to make the top row (Diagram 8-11).
9. Sew (1) Unit 25 square to each side of (1) 3 1/2" Fabric S square to make the middle row (Diagram 8-11).
10. Sew together (1) Unit 22 square, (1) Unit 25 square and (1) Unit 21 square, in that order from left to right, to make the bottom row (Diagram 8-11).
11. Sew together the (3) pieced rows from Steps 8-10 lengthwise to make the 9 1/2" Block Eight square (Diagram 8-11).


