


Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.

Block One


- Using your favorite paper piecing method and the templates provided on Page 11, make (4) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " x 8" Unit 1 rectangles (Diagram 1-1). *Note: Pay attention to the sewing order of the triangles as listed on the templates.*



- Using your favorite paper piecing method and the templates provided on Page 11, make (4) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " x 8" Unit 2 rectangles (Diagram 1-2). *Note: Pay attention to the sewing order of the triangles as listed on the templates.*




- Sew together the (4) Unit 1 rectangles lengthwise to make the top row (Diagram 1-3). Sew together the (4) Unit 2 rectangles lengthwise to make the bottom row (Diagram 1-3). Sew together the (2) pieced rows as shown to make (1) 8 " x $15\frac{1}{2}$ " Block One rectangle (Diagram 1-3).




Block Two


- Place (1) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric G square on top of (1) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric B square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Diagram 2-1). Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 2-1). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 2-2) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " to make (2) Unit 3 squares (Diagram 2-3).



- Repeat Step 1 and refer to Diagram 2-4 for fabric identification and placement to make (2) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 4 squares.




- Place (1) 2" Fabric F square on the left side of (1) 2 " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip, right sides together (Diagram 2-5). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 2-5). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 2-6). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.




- Place (1) 2" Fabric G square on the right side of the 2 " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip, right sides together (Diagram 2-7). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Diagram 2-7). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance to make (1) Unit 5 rectangle (Diagram 2-8).

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
5. Repeat Steps 3-4 to make a second Unit 5 rectangle.



6. Repeat Steps 3-4 and refer to Diagrams 2-9 – 2-11 for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make (2) of each unit rectangle for Unit 6 through Unit 8.



7. Sew (1) Unit 5 to the top of (1) Unit 6 lengthwise to make (1) 3 1/2" Unit 9 square (Diagram 2-12). Repeat to make a second Unit 9 square.




8. Sew (1) Unit 7 to the top of (1) Unit 8 lengthwise to make (1) 3 1/2" Unit 10 square (Diagram 2-13). Repeat to make a second Unit 10 square.

9. Sew together (1) Unit 3 square, (1) Unit 9 square and (1) Unit 4 square, in that order from left to right, to make the top row (Diagram 2-14).

10. Sew (1) Unit 10 to each side of (1) 3 1/2" Fabric B square to make the middle row (Diagram 2-14).


11. Sew together (1) Unit 4 square, (1) Unit 9 square and (1) Unit 3 square, in that order from left to right, to make the bottom row (Diagram 2-14).




12. Sew together the (3) rows from Steps 9-11 lengthwise to make (1) 9 1/2" Block Two square (Diagram 2-14).


1. Sew (2) 2 7/8" Fabric J triangles to adjacent sides of (1) 2 1/2" Fabric U square. Sew (1) 4 7/8" Fabric D triangle to the long side of the newly sewn triangle to make (1) 4 1/2" Unit 11 square (Diagram 3-1). Repeat to make a second Unit 11 square.



2. Sew (2) 2 7/8" Fabric J triangles to adjacent sides of (1) 2 1/2" Fabric I square. Sew (1) 4 7/8" Fabric U triangle to the long side of the newly sewn triangle to make (1) 4 1/2" Unit 12 square (Diagram 3-2). Repeat to make a second Unit 12 square.



3. Sew (1) 2 1/2" Fabric J square to the left side of (1) 2 1/2" Fabric H square to make (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Unit 13 rectangle (Diagram 3-3). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 13 rectangles.




4. Sew together (1) Unit 11 square, (1) Unit 13 rectangle and (1) Unit 12 square, in that order from left to right, to make the top row (Diagram 3-4).

5. Sew (1) Unit 13 rectangle to each side of (1) 2 1/2" Fabric I square to make the middle row (Diagram 3-4).

6. Sew together (1) Unit 12 square, (1) Unit 13 rectangle and (1) Unit 11 square, in that order from left to right, to make the bottom row (Diagram 3-4).

7. Sew together the (3) pieced rows from Steps 4-6 lengthwise to make the 10 1/2" Block Three square (Diagram 3-4).



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Block Four

- Place (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J square on the left side of (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric L strip, right sides together (Diagram 4-1). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 4-1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 4-2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.





- Place (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K square on the right side of the $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric L strip, right sides together (Diagram 4-3). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Diagram 4-3). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance to make (1) Unit 14 rectangle (Diagram 4-4).



- Sew together (1) $6\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric K triangle and (1) $6\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric I triangle along shorts sides (Diagram 4-9). Sew (1) $6\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric I triangle and (1) $6\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric G

triangle together along short sides (Diagram 4-9). Sew together the (2) newly sewn triangles along their long sides to make (1) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 19 square (Diagram 4-9). Repeat to make a second Unit 19 square.

- Repeat Step 5 and refer to Diagram 4-10 for fabric identification and placement to make (1) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 20 square.






- Sew together (1) Unit 14 rectangle, (1) Unit 15 rectangle and (1) Unit 16 rectangle, end to end and in that order from left to right, to make Row One (Diagram 11).
- Repeat Step 7 and refer to Diagram 11 for component identification, placement and orientation to make Row Two through Row Five.
- Sew together the (5) rows, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the $18\frac{1}{2}$ " Block Four square (Diagram 11).



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Block Five

- Place (1) 2 1/2" Fabric O square on the left side of (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric J strip, right sides together (Diagram 5-1). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 5-1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 5-2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.





- Place (1) 2 1/2" Fabric O square on the right side of the 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric J strip, right sides together (Diagram 5-3). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Diagram 5-3). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 21 rectangle (Diagram 5-4).







- Repeat Steps 1-2 and refer to Diagram 5-5 for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make (4) Unit 22 rectangles.

- Sew (1) Unit 21 rectangle to the top of (1) Unit 22 rectangle lengthwise to make (1) 4 1/2" Unit 23 square (Diagram 5-6). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 23 squares.



- Place (1) 2 7/8" Fabric O square on top of (1) 2 7/8" Fabric N square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Diagram 5-7). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 5-7). Cut the (2) squares apart on the

drawn diagonal line (Diagram 5-8) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" to make (2) Unit 24 squares (Diagram 5-9). Repeat to make an additional (2) Unit 24 squares.

- Repeat Step 6 and refer to Diagram 5-10 for fabric identification and placement to make (4) 2 1/2" Unit 25 squares.

- Sew (2) 2 7/8" Fabric O triangles to adjacent sides of (1) Unit 24 square to make (1) Unit 26 triangle (Diagram 5-11). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 26 triangles.
- Sew (1) 4 7/8" Fabric M to the long side of (1) Unit 26 triangle to make (1) 4 1/2" Unit 27 square (Diagram 5-12). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 27 squares.
- Refer to Diagram 5-13 and sew together (4) Unit 25 squares into a 2 x 2 matrix to make (4) 4 1/2" Unit 28 square.




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Block Six

1. Sew together (2) 5 1/4" Fabric R triangles, (1) 5 1/4" Fabric H triangle and (1) 5 1/4" Fabric K triangle to make (1) 4 1/2" Unit 29 square. Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 29 squares (Diagram 6-1).




2. Sew (1) 4 1/2" Fabric H square to each side of (1) Unit 29 square to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 29 square to each side of (1) 4 1/2" Fabric L square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) pieced rows lengthwise to make (1) 12 1/2" Block Six square (Diagram 6-2).




1. Place (1) 3 3/8" Fabric Q square on top of (1) 3 3/8" Fabric R square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Diagram 7-1). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 7-1). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 7-2) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 3" x 3" to make (2) Unit 30 squares (Diagram 7-3). Repeat to make an additional (2) Unit 30 squares.




2. Sew (2) 3 3/8" Fabric Q triangles to adjacent sides of (1) Unit 30 square to make (1) Unit 31 triangle (Diagram 7-4). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 31 triangles.



3. Sew (1) 5 7/8" Fabric S triangle to the long side of (1) Unit 31 triangle to make (1) 5 1/2" Unit 32 square (Diagram 7-5). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 32 squares.



4. Place (1) 3" Fabric Q square on the left side of (1) 3" x 5 1/2" Fabric T strip, right sides together (Diagram 7-6). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 7-6). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 7-7). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.



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5. Place another 3" Fabric Q square on the right side of the 3" x 5 1/2" Fabric T strip, right sides together (Diagram 7-8). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Diagram 7-8). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 33 rectangle (Diagram 7-9).





6. Repeat Steps 4-5 to make an additional (3) Unit 33 rectangles.

7. Repeat Steps 4-5 and refer to Diagram 7-10 for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make (4) 3" x 5 1/2" Unit 34 rectangles.



8. Sew (1) Unit 33 rectangle to the top of (1) Unit 34 rectangle lengthwise to make (1) 5 1/2" Unit 35 square (Diagram 7-11). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 35 squares.



9. Place (1) 3" Fabric P square on the top left corner of (1) 5 1/2" Fabric N square, right sides together (Diagram 7-12). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 7-12). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 7-13). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam.



Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 8-1). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 8-2) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " to make (2) Unit 37 squares (Diagram 8-3). Repeat to make an additional (2) Unit 37 squares.




- Sew (2) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric O triangles to adjacent sides of (1) Unit 37 square to make (1) Unit 38 triangle (Diagram 8-4). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 38 triangles.



- Sew (1) $6\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric N triangle to the long side of (1) Unit 38 triangle to make (1) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 39 square (Diagram 8-5). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 39 squares.




- Sew together (2) $7\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric R triangles and (2) $7\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric P triangles as shown to make (1) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 40 square (Diagram 8-6). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 40 squares.



Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 8-7). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 8-8). Trim away


the excess fabric from behind the triangle $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the sewn seam.




- Follow Diagram 8-9 for the seam direction to add a $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric S square to each of the remaining corners of the $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric O square to make (1) Unit 41 square (Diagram 8-10).




- Sew (1) Unit 39 square to each side of (1) Unit 40 square to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 40 square to each side of the Unit 41 square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) pieced rows lengthwise to make the $18\frac{1}{2}$ " Block Eight square (Diagram 8-11).




