**Block Two**  
Cut (4) 5 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (8) 5 7/8" triangles.

**Fabric B**      **Block One**  
Cut (4) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.

**Fabric C**      **Block One**  
Cut (16) 2 1/2" squares.  
**Block Two**  
Cut (2) 6 1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (8) 6 1/4" triangles.

**Fabric D**      **Block One**  
Cut (4) 4 7/8" squares.  
**Block Two**  
Cut (2) 6 1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (8) 6 1/4" triangles.

**Fabric E**      **Block One**  
Cut (4) 4 7/8" squares.  
Cut (6) 2 7/8" squares. Cut (4) of the squares across (1) diagonal to make (8) 2 7/8" triangles.

**Fabric F**      **Block One**  
Cut (2) 2 7/8" squares.



## Making the Blocks


**Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.**

### Block One


- Place (1)  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric E square on top of (1)  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric F square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Diagram 1-1). Sew  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 1-1). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 1-2) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " to make (2) Unit 1 squares (Diagram 1-3). Repeat to make an additional (2) Unit 1 squares.




- Sew (2)  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric E triangles to the Fabric F sides of (1) Unit 1 square to make (1) Unit 2 triangle (Diagram 1-4). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 2 triangles.




- Sew (1)  $4\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric G triangle to the long side of (1) Unit 2 triangle to make (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 3 square (Diagram 1-5). Repeat to make (3) additional Unit 3 squares.




- Place (1)  $4\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric D square on top of (1)  $4\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric E square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Diagram 1-6). Sew  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 1-6). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 1-7) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " to make (2) Unit 4 squares (Diagram 1-8). Repeat to make an additional (6) Unit 4 squares.



- Place (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C square on the left side of (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A strip, right sides together (Diagram 1-9). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 1-9). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 1-10). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.




- Place another  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C square on the right side of the  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A strip, right sides together (Diagram 1-11). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Diagram 1-11). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance to make (1) Unit 5 rectangle (Diagram 1-12).




- Repeat Steps 5-6 to make an additional (3) Unit 5 rectangles.

- Repeat Steps 5-6 and refer to Diagram 1-13 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction and to make (4) Unit 6 rectangles.



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
9. Sew (1) Unit 5 rectangle to the top of (1) Unit 6 rectangle lengthwise to make (1) 4 1/2" Unit 7 square (Diagram 1-14). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 7 squares.



10. Sew together (1) Unit 3 square, (2) Unit 4 squares and (1) Unit 3 square, in that order from left to right, to make Row One (Diagram 1-15). Repeat to make Row Four.


11. Sew together (1) Unit 4 square, (2) Unit 7 squares and (1) Unit 4 square, in that order from left to right, to make Row Two (Diagram 1-15). Repeat to make Row Three.

12. Sew together the (4) pieced rows, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the 16 1/2" Block One square (Diagram 1-15).




## Block Two

1. Sew together (1) 6 1/4" Fabric D triangle, (1) 6 1/4" Fabric C triangle and (1) 5 7/8" Fabric A triangle as shown to make (1) 5 1/2" Unit 8 square (Diagram 2-1). Repeat to make an additional (7) Unit 8 squares.




2. Sew together the (8) Unit 8 squares into a 4 x 2 matrix to make the 20 1/2" x 10 1/2" Block Two rectangle (Diagram 2-2).




## Block Three


1. Sew (1) 5" Fabric M square to the left side of (1) 5" Fabric L square. Sew (1) 5" x 9 1/2" Fabric J strip to the bottom of the newly sewn strip to make (1) 9 1/2" Unit 9 square (Diagram 3-1).



2. Sew (1) 5" x 9 1/2" Fabric K strip to the right side of the Unit 9 square. Sew (1) 5" x 14" Fabric I strip to the bottom of the newly sewn rectangle to make (1) 14" Unit 10 square (Diagram 3-2).



3. Sew (1) 5" x 14" Fabric O strip to the right side of the Unit 10 square. Sew (1) 5" x 18 1/2" Fabric H strip to the bottom of the newly sewn rectangle to make the 18 1/2" Block Three square (Diagram 3-3).



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## Block Four

- Place (1) 3 1/2" Fabric R square on the top left corner of (1) 6 1/2" Fabric Q square, right sides together (Diagram 4-1). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 4-1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 4-2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam.





- Follow Diagram 4-3 for the seam direction to add a 3 1/2" Fabric R square to each of the remaining corners of the 6 1/2" Fabric Q square to make (1) Unit 11 square (Diagram 4-4).
- Repeat Steps 1-2 to make an additional (3) Unit 11 squares.
- Repeat Steps 1-2 and refer to Diagram 4-5 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (1) 6 1/2" Unit 12 square.






- Place (1) 2 3/8" Fabric P square on top of (1) 2 3/8" Fabric H square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Diagram 4-6). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 4-6). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 4-7) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 2" x 2" to make (2) Unit 13 squares (Diagram 4-8). Repeat to make an additional (14) Unit 13 squares.


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## Block Five


1. Sew (2)  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric L triangles to adjacent sides of (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H square. Sew (1)  $4\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric K triangle to the long side of the newly sewn triangle to make (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 17 square (Diagram 5-1). Repeat to make a second Unit 17 square.




2. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Diagram 5-2 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (2)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 18 squares.



3. Sew (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric L square to the left side of (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric S square to make (1) Unit 19 rectangle (Diagram 5-3). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 19 rectangles.





4. Sew together (1) Unit 17 square, (1) Unit 19 rectangle and (1) Unit 18 square, in that order from left to right, to make the top row (Diagram 5-4).
5. Sew (1) Unit 19 rectangle to each side of (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I square to make the middle row (Diagram 5-4).
6. Sew (1) Unit 18 square, (1) Unit 19 rectangle and (1) Unit 17 square together in that order from left to right to make the bottom row (Diagram 5-4).
7. Sew together the (3) pieced rows from Steps 4-6 lengthwise to make the  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " Block Five square (Diagram 5-4).





## Block Six


1. Place (1)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric N square on the top left corner of (1)  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F square, right sides together (Diagram 6-1). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 6-1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 6-2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the sewn seam.



2. Follow Diagram 6-3 for the seam direction to add a  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric N square to each of the remaining corners of the  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F square to make (1) Unit 20 square (Diagram 6-4).



3. Sew (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G square to each end of (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric O strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric O strip to each side of (1) Unit 20 square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) pieced rows lengthwise to make the  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " Block Six square (Diagram 6-5).

- Place (1)  $3 \frac{3}{8}$ " Fabric S square on top of (1)  $3 \frac{3}{8}$ " Fabric H square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Diagram 7-1). Sew  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 7-1). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 7-2) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure  $3" \times 3"$  to make (2) Unit 21 squares (Diagram 7-3).














## Block Eight

1. Place (1) 2 1/2" Fabric Q square on the left side of (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric J strip, right sides together (Diagram 8-1). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 8-1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 8-2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.




2. Place another 2 1/2" Fabric Q square on the right side of the 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric J strip, right sides together (Diagram 8-3). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Diagram 8-3). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 35 rectangle (Diagram 8-4).





6. Place (1) 2 7/8" Fabric Q square on top of (1) 2 7/8" Fabric N square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Diagram 8-7). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 8-7). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 8-8) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" to make (2) Unit 38 squares (Diagram 8-9). Repeat to make an additional (2) Unit 38 squares.




9. Sew (1)  $4\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric R triangle to the long side of (1) Unit 40 triangle to make (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 41 square (Diagram 8-12). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 41 squares.



10. Sew together the (4) Unit 39 squares into a  $2 \times 2$  matrix to make (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 42 square (Diagram 8-13).



11. Paying attention to the orientation of the units, sew (1) Unit 37 square to each side of (1) Unit 41 square to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 41 square to each side of the Unit 42 square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) pieced rows lengthwise to make (1)  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " Block Eight square (Diagram 8-14).
