

Quilt Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. Borders are cut to exact length required plus 1/4" seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

Fabric A Cut (20) 6 1/2" squares.

Fabric B Cut (2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (20) 2 1/2" x 4" strips.
Cut (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (20) 2" x 2 1/2" strips.

Fabric C Cut (8) 2 1/2" x 4" strips.
Cut (8) 2" x 2 1/2" strips.

Fabric D Cut (2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (20) 2 1/2" x 4" strips.
Cut (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (20) 2" x 2 1/2" strips.

Fabric E Cut (12) 2 1/2" x 4" strips.
Cut (12) 2" x 2 1/2" strips.

Fabric F Cut (8) 2 1/2" x 4" strips.
Cut (8) 2" x 2 1/2" strips.

Fabric G Cut (12) 2 1/2" x 4" strips.
Cut (12) 2" x 2 1/2" strips.

Fabric H Cut (7) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (80) 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" strips.

Fabric I Cut (13) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (49) 3" x 10 1/2" strips.

Fabric J Cut (3) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (30) 3" squares.

Binding Cut (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips.

Backing Cut (2) 61" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make (1) 61" x 73" backing.

Making the Quilt

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.

Block Assembly

1. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 4" Fabric B strip to each end of (1) 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" Fabric H strip to make the top row (Diagram 1). Repeat to make the bottom row.
2. Sew (1) 2" x 2 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and bottom of (1) 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" Fabric H strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) strip to each side of (1) 6 1/2" Fabric A square to make the middle row (Diagram 1).
3. Sew together the (3) pieced rows from Step 1-2 lengthwise to make (1) 10 1/2" Block One square (Diagram 1).
4. Repeat Steps 1-3 to make an additional (4) Block One squares.



Patchwork Panes

- Repeat Steps 1-3 and refer to Diagrams 2-6 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make the indicated number of block squares for Block Two through Block Six. *Note: There will be (20) block squares total.*










Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)

- Sew together (5) 3" Fabric J squares and (4) 3" x 10 1/2" Fabric I strips, alternating them from left to right, to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Three, Row Five, Row Seven, Row Nine and Row Eleven.
- Sew together (1) 3" x 10 1/2" Fabric I strip, (1) Block One square, (1) 3" x 10 1/2" Fabric I strip, (1) Block Two square, (1) 3" x 10 1/2" Fabric I strip, (1) Block Three square, (1) 3" x 10 1/2" Fabric I strip, (1) Block Four square and (1) 3" x 10 1/2" Fabric I strip, in that order from left to right, to make Row Two.
- Repeat Step 7 and refer to the Quilt Layout for component identification, placement and orientation to make Row Four, Row Six, Row Eight and Row Ten.
- Sew together the (11) pieced Rows, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the Quilt Top.

Finishing the Quilt

- Layer and quilt as desired.
- Sew together the (6) binding strips end to end with 45-degree seams. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- Bind as desired.
