## Quilt Cutting Directions

**Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches.** Borders are cut to exact length required plus  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

- Fabric A** Cut (2)  $6\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (4)  $6\frac{7}{8}$ " triangles.
- Fabric B** Cut (2)  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.
- Fabric C** Cut (2)  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.
- Fabric D** Cut (4)  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (8)  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " triangles.
- Fabric E** Cut (1)  $6\frac{7}{8}$ " square. Cut the square across (1) diagonal to make (2)  $6\frac{7}{8}$ " triangles.
- Fabric F** Cut (1)  $6\frac{7}{8}$ " square and (1)  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " square. Cut the  $6\frac{7}{8}$ " square across (1) diagonal to make (2)  $6\frac{7}{8}$ " triangles.
- Fabric G** Cut (2) 2" x  $33\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.  
Cut (2) 2" x  $30\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.  
Cut (2)  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares from (1) 10" square. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (4)  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " triangles.
- Fabric H** Cut (2)  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.
- Fabric I** Cut (4)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
- Fabric J** Cut (4)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
- Fabric K** Cut (4)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
- Fabric L** Cut (1)  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " square and (4)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
- Fabric M** Cut (2)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
- Fabric N** Cut (4)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

**Fabric O** Cut (4)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

**Fabric P** Cut (4)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

**Fabric Q** Cut (2)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

**Fabric R** Cut (1)  $6\frac{7}{8}$ " square. Cut the square across (1) diagonal to make (2)  $6\frac{7}{8}$ " triangles.

## Quilt Cutting Directions - Continued


- Fabric S** Cut (1)  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " square.
- Fabric T** Cut (2)  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.
- Fabric U** Cut (1)  $6\frac{7}{8}$ " square. Cut the square across (1) diagonal to make (2)  $6\frac{7}{8}$ " triangles.
- Fabric V** Cut (1)  $6\frac{7}{8}$ " square. Cut the square across (1) diagonal to make (2)  $6\frac{7}{8}$ " triangles.
- Fabric W** Cut (2)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
- Fabric X** Cut (1)  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " square.
- Fabric Y** Cut (2)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
- Fabric Z** Cut (2)  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (4)  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " triangles.
- Fabric AA** Cut (1)  $6\frac{7}{8}$ " square. Cut the square across (1) diagonal to make (2)  $6\frac{7}{8}$ " triangles.
- Fabric BB** Cut (2)  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (12)  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Cut (8) of the squares across (1) diagonal to make (16)  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " triangles.  
Cut (7) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (144) 2" squares.
- Fabric CC** Cut (2)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $37\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.  
Cut (2)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $33\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.
- Binding** Cut (4)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips.
- Backing** Cut (2) 45" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make (1) 45" x 45" backing.

## Making the Quilt


*Note: The arrows in diagrams represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.*

### Block Assembly


- Place (1)  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric B square on top of (1)  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric C square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Diagram 1). Sew  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 1). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 2) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " to make (2) Unit 1 squares (Diagram. 3). Repeat to make an additional (2) Unit 1 squares.



- Repeat Step 1 and refer to Diagrams 4-7 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (4)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 2 squares, (2)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 3 squares, (4)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 4 squares and (2)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 5 squares.



- Sew (2)  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric D triangles to the Fabric B sides of (1) Unit 1 square. Sew (1)  $6\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric A triangle to the long side of the newly sewn triangle to make (1)  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 6 square (Diagram 8). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 6 squares.



# Secret Seasons - Amber

4. Repeat Step 3 and refer to Diagrams 9-14 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (2) of each unit square for Unit 7 through Unit 12.



5. Place (1) 2" Fabric BB square on the top left corner of (1) 3 1/2" Fabric I square, right sides together (Diagram 15). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 15). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 16). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam.
6. Follow Diagram 17 for the seam direction to add a 2" Fabric BB square to each of the remaining corners of the 3 1/2" Fabric I square to make (1) Unit 13 square (Diagram 18).

7. Repeat Steps 5-6 to make an additional (3) Unit 13 squares.



8. Repeat Steps 5-6 and refer to Diagrams 19-28 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make the indicated number of unit squares for Unit 14 through Unit 23.



9. Sew (1) Unit 13 square to the top of (1) Unit 14 square. Sew (1) Unit 6 square to the left side of the newly sewn strip and (1) Unit 7 square to the right side of the strip to make the top row (Diagram 29).
10. Sew together (1) Unit 15 square, (1) Unit 16 square, (1) Unit 17 square, (1) Unit 18 square and (1) Unit 19 square, in that order from left to right, to make the middle row (Diagram 29).
11. Sew (1) Unit 20 square to the top of (1) Unit 21 square. Sew (1) Unit 8 square to the left side of the newly sewn strip and (1) Unit 9 square to the right side of the strip to make the bottom row (Diagram 29).







# Secret Seasons - Amber

14. Repeat Steps 9-12 and refer to Diagram 30 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (2) 15 1/2" Block Two squares.



15. Sew (1) Block One square to the left side of (1) Block Two square to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Paying attention to the orientation of the rows, sew the (2) newly sewn rows together lengthwise to make the 30 1/2" x 30 1/2" Quilt Center (Diagram 31).




## Quilt Top Assembly

*(Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)*

16. Sew (1) 2" x 30 1/2" Fabric G strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew (1) 2" x 33 1/2" Fabric G strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center.
17. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 33 1/2" Fabric CC strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 37 1/2" Fabric CC strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center to make the Quilt Top.

## Finishing the Quilt

18. Layer and quilt as desired.
19. Sew together the (4) binding strips end to end with 45-degree seams. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
20. Bind as desired.
