

Quilt Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. Borders are cut to exact length required plus $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

Fabric A Cut (25) $9\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Fabric B Cut (1) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (1) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " square and (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " strip.
Cut (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (36) 2" squares.

Fabric C Cut (20) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (60) 2" x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Fabric D Cut (2) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $69\frac{1}{2}$ " length of fabric (LOF) strips.
From the remaining fabric, cut (2) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $81\frac{1}{2}$ " strips, piece as needed.

Fabric E Cut (1) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " square and (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " strip.

Fabric F Cut (1) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (1) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " square and (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " strip.

Fabric G Cut (1) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (1) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " square and (2) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Fabric H Cut (1) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares and (3) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Fabric I Cut (1) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares and (3) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Fabric J Cut (1) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.
Cut (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Fabric K Cut (1) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.
Cut (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Fabric L Cut (1) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (3) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares and (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " strip.
Cut (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Fabric M Cut (1) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (3) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares and (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " strip.
Cut (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

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Quilt Cutting Directions - Continued


- Fabric N** Cut (1) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.
Cut (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- Fabric O** Cut (1) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.
Cut (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- Fabric P** Cut (1) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares and (3) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- Fabric Q** Cut (1) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares and (3) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- Fabric R** Cut (1) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (1) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " square and (2) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- Fabric S** Cut (1) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (1) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " square and (2) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- Fabric T** Cut (1) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " square and (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " strip.
- Fabric U** Cut (1) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " square and (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " strip.
- Binding** Cut (8) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips.
- Backing** Cut (2) 89 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make (1) 89 " x 89 " backing.

Making the Quilt


Note: The arrows in diagrams represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

Block Assembly

- Place (1) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric E square on top of (1) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric B square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Diagram 1). Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 1). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 2) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " to make (2) Unit 1 squares (Diagram 3).




- Repeat Step 1 and refer to Diagrams 4-11 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make the indicated number of unit squares for Unit 2 through Unit 9. *Note: Not all units will be used.*











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3. Sew (1) 9 1/2" Fabric A square to the left side of (1) 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" Fabric B strip to make the top row. Sew (1) 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" Fabric E strip to the left side of (1) Unit 1 square along the Fabric side to make the bottom row (Diagram 12). Sew together the (2) rows lengthwise to make the 12 1/2" Block One square (Diagram 12).



4. Repeat Step 3 and refer to Diagrams 13-20 for component identification, placement and orientation to make the designated number of block squares for Block Two through Block Nine.



5. Sew together (6) 2" Fabric B squares and (5) 2" x 12 1/2" Fabric C strips, alternating them from left to right, to make Row One (Diagram 21). Repeat to make Row Three, Row Five, Row Seven, Row Nine and Row Eleven.
6. Sew together (1) 2" x 12 1/2" Fabric C strip, (1) Block One square, (1) 2" x 12 1/2" Fabric C strip, (1) Block Two square, (1) 2" x 12 1/2" Fabric C strip, (1) Block Three square, (1) 2" x 12 1/2" Fabric C strip, (1) Block Four square, (1) 2" x 12 1/2" Fabric C strip, (1) Block Five square and (1) 2" x 12 1/2" Fabric C strip, in that order from left to right, to make Row Two (Diagram 21).
7. Repeat Step 6 to make Row Four, Row Six, Row Eight and Row Ten (Diagram 21).
8. Sew together the (11) pieced Rows, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the 69 1/2" x 69 1/2" Quilt Center (Diagram 21).

Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)

9. Sew (1) 6 1/2" x 69 1/2" Fabric D strip to each side of the Quilt Center.
10. Sew the 6 1/2" x 81 1/2" Fabric D strips to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center to make the Quilt Top.


Finishing the Quilt

11. Layer and quilt as desired.
12. Sew together the (8) binding strips end to end with 45-degree seams. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
13. Bind as desired.
