Quilt Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. Borders are cut to exact length required plus 1/4" seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

- Fabric A** Cut (1) 3 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strips into (12) 3 1/2" squares.
- Fabric B** Cut (2) 18 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (3) 18 1/4" squares and (2) 9 3/8" squares. Cut the 18 1/4" squares across both diagonals to make (12) 18 1/4" triangles. *Note: You will only use (10) 18 1/4" triangles.* Cut the 9 3/8" squares across (1) diagonal to make (4) 9 3/8" triangles.
- Fabric C** Cut (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (12) 2" x 9 1/2" strips.
Cut (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (12) 2" x 8" strips.
- Fabric D** Cut (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (6) 2" x 8" strips.
Cut (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (6) 2" x 6 1/2" strips.
- Fabric E** Cut (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (12) 2" x 11" strips.
Cut (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (12) 2" x 9 1/2" strips.
- Fabric F** Cut (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (6) 2" x 11" strips.
Cut (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (6) 2" x 9 1/2" strips.
- Fabric G** Cut (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (6) 2" x 12 1/2" strips.
Cut (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (6) 2" x 11" strips.
- Fabric H** Cut (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (12) 2" x 6 1/2" strips.
Cut (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (12) 2" x 5" strips.

- Fabric I** Cut (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (6) 2" x 5" strips.
Cut (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (6) 2" x 3 1/2" strips.
- Fabric J** Cut (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (12) 2" x 5" strips.
Cut (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (12) 2" x 3 1/2" strips.
- Fabric K** Cut (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (12) 2" x 12 1/2" strips.
Cut (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (12) 2" x 11" strips.
- Fabric L** Cut (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (6) 2" x 6 1/2" strips.
Cut (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (6) 2" x 5" strips.
- Fabric M** Cut (1) 3 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (6) 3 1/2" squares.
- Fabric N** Cut (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (6) 2" x 9 1/2" strips.
Cut (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (6) 2" x 8" strips.

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Quilt Cutting Directions - Continued


- Fabric O** Cut (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (12) 2" x 8" strips.
Cut (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (12) 2" x 6 1/2" strips.
- Binding** Cut (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips.
- Backing** Cut (2) 59" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make (1) 59" x 76" backing.

Making the Quilt


Note: The arrows in diagrams represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

Block Assembly


1. Sew (1) 2" x 3 1/2" Fabric J strip to the top of (1) 3 1/2" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2" x 5" Fabric J strip to the left side of the newly sewn rectangle to make (1) 5" Unit 1 square (Diagram 1). Repeat to make an additional (11) Unit 1 squares.




2. Sew (1) 2" x 5" Fabric H strip to the bottom of (1) Unit 1 square. Sew (1) 2" x 6 1/2" Fabric H strip to the right side of the newly sewn rectangle to make (1) 6 1/2" Unit 2 square (Diagram 2). Repeat to make an additional (11) Unit 2 squares.




3. Sew (1) 2" x 6 1/2" Fabric O strip to the top of (1) Unit 2 square. Sew (1) 2" x 8" Fabric O strip to the left side of the newly sewn rectangle to make (1) 8" Unit 3 square (Diagram 3). Repeat to make an additional (11) Unit 3 squares.




4. Sew (1) 2" x 8" Fabric C strip to the bottom of (1) Unit 3 square. Sew (1) 2" x 9 1/2" Fabric C strip to the right side of the newly sewn rectangle to make (1) 9 1/2" Unit 4 square (Diagram 4). Repeat to make an additional (11) Unit 4 squares.




5. Sew (1) 2" x 9 1/2" Fabric E strip to the top of (1) Unit 4 square. Sew (1) 2" x 11" Fabric E strip to the left side of the newly sewn rectangle to make (1) 11" Unit 5 square (Diagram 5). Repeat to make an additional (11) Unit 5 squares.



6. Sew (1) 2" x 11" Fabric K strip to the bottom of (1) Unit 5 square. Sew (1) 2" x 12 1/2" Fabric K strip to the right side of the newly sewn rectangle to make (1) 12 1/2" Block One square (Diagram 6). Repeat to make an additional (11) Block One squares.



7. Repeat Steps 1-6 and refer to Diagram 7 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (6) 12 1/2" Block Two squares.



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
Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the *Quilt Layout* when assembling the quilt top.)

8. Sew (1) 18 ¼" Fabric B triangle to each side of (1) Block One square. Sew (1) 9 ⅜" Fabric B triangle to the top of the Block One square to make Row One.
9. Sew (1) Block One square to each side of (1) Block Two square. Sew (1) 18 ¼" Fabric B triangle to each end of the newly sewn strip to make Row Two. Repeat to make Row Five.
10. Sew together (3) Block One squares and (2) Block Two square alternating them from left to right. Sew (1) 18 ¼" Fabric B triangle to the left end and (1) 9 ⅜" Fabric B triangle to the right end of the newly sewn strip to make Row Three.
11. Sew together (3) Block One squares and (2) Block Two square alternating them from left to right. Sew (1) 9 ⅜" Fabric B triangle to the left end and (1) 18 ¼" Fabric B triangle to the right end of the newly sewn strip to make Row Four.
12. Sew (1) 18 ¼" Fabric B triangle to each side of (1) Block One square. Sew (1) 9 ⅜" Fabric B triangle to the bottom of the Block One square to make Row Six.
13. Sew together the (6) pieced Rows, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the Quilt Top.

Finishing the Quilt


14. Layer and quilt as desired.
15. Sew together the (6) binding strips end to end with 45-degree seams. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
16. Bind as desired.




Quilt Layout




