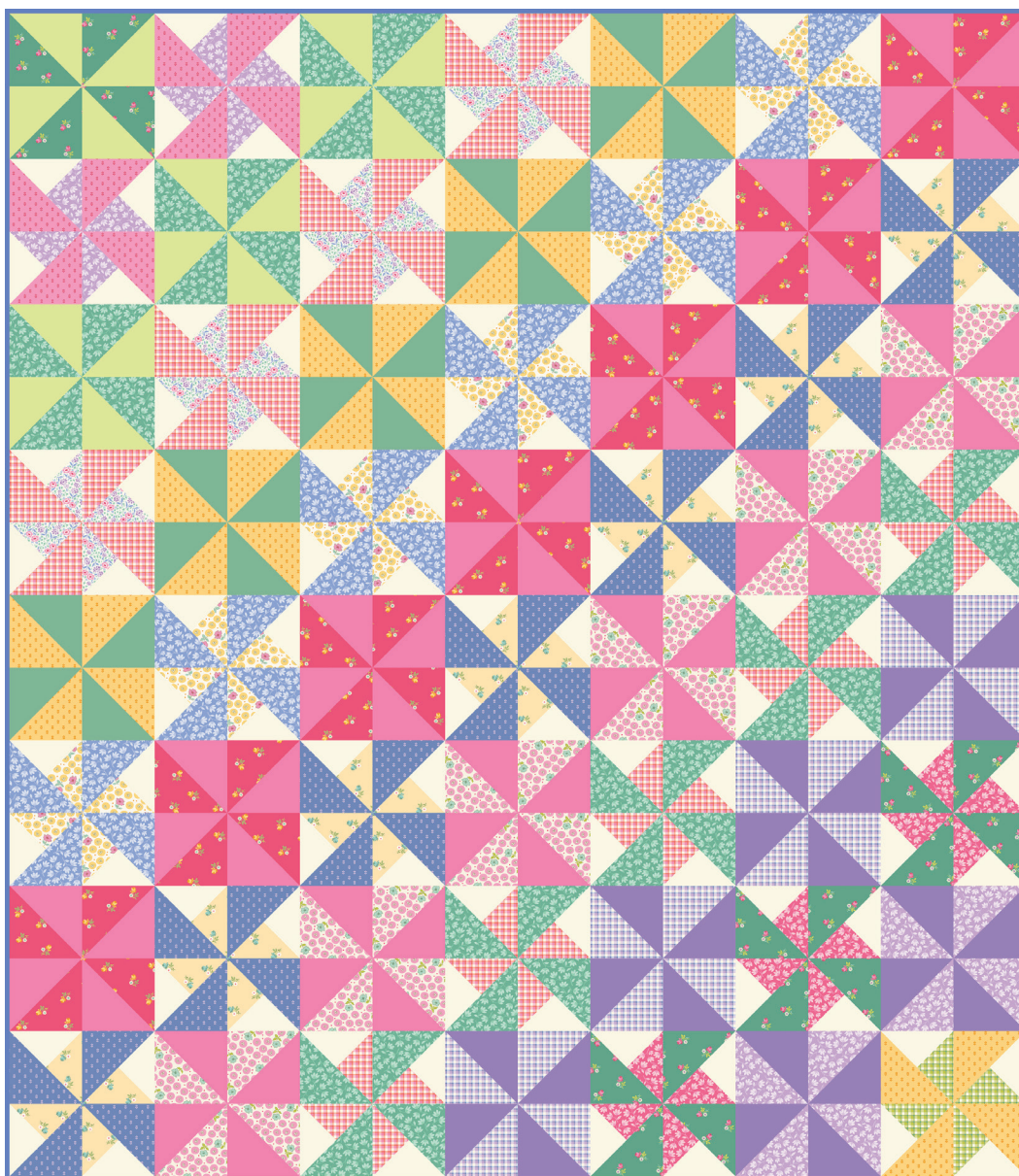

Quilt Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting.

WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

Fabric A	Cut (2) 4 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (12) 4 7/8" squares.
Fabric B	Cut (1) 5 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (6) 5 1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (24) 5 1/4" triangles.
Fabric C	Cut (1) 5 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 5 1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (16) 5 1/4" triangles.
Fabric D	Cut (1) 5 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (5) 5 1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (20) 5 1/4" triangles. Cut (1) 4 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (8) 4 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (16) 4 7/8" triangles.
Fabric E	Cut (1) 5 1/4" square. Cut the square across both diagonals to make (4) 5 1/4" triangles.
Fabric F	Cut (1) 4 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (8) 4 7/8" squares.
Fabric G	Cut (2) 4 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (12) 4 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (24) 4 7/8" triangles.
Fabric H	Cut (1) 5 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (3) 5 1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (12) 5 1/4" triangles.

Fabric I	Cut (2) 4 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (16) 4 7/8" squares. Cut (10) of the squares across (1) diagonal to make (20) 4 7/8" triangles.
Fabric J	Cut (1) 5 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 5 1/4" squares and (4) 4 7/8" squares. Cut the 5 1/4" squares across both diagonals to make (8) 5 1/4" triangles.
Fabric K	Cut (2) 4 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (14) 4 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (28) 4 7/8" triangles.

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Quilt Cutting Directions - Continued

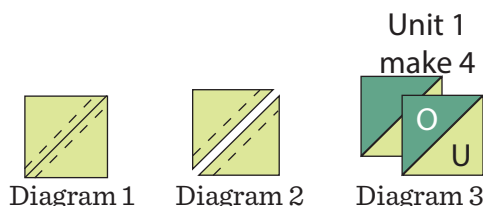
Fabric L	Cut (1) 4 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 4 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (8) 4 7/8" triangles.
Fabric M	Cut (2) 4 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (14) 4 7/8" squares. Cut (2) of the squares across (1) diagonal from the upper left to the lower right to make (4) 4 7/8" left/right triangles. Note: You will use only (2) 4 7/8" left/right triangles. Cut (2) of the squares across opposite direction to make (4) 4 7/8" right/left triangles.
Fabric N	Cut (2) 4 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (14) 4 7/8" squares.
Fabric O	Cut (1) 4 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (8) 4 7/8" squares. Cut (6) of the squares across (1) diagonal to make (12) 4 7/8" triangles.
Fabric P	Cut (1) 5 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (7) 5 1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (28) 5 1/4" triangles.
Fabric Q	Cut (4) 5 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (28) 5 1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (112) 5 1/4" triangles.
Fabric R	Cut (4) 4 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (26) 4 7/8" squares.
Fabric S	Cut (2) 4 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (10) 4 7/8" squares.
Fabric T	Cut (2) 4 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (12) 4 7/8" squares.
Fabric U	Cut (1) 4 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (8) 4 7/8" squares.
Binding	Cut (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips.
Backing	Cut (2) 64" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make (1) 64" x 72" backing

Making the Quilt

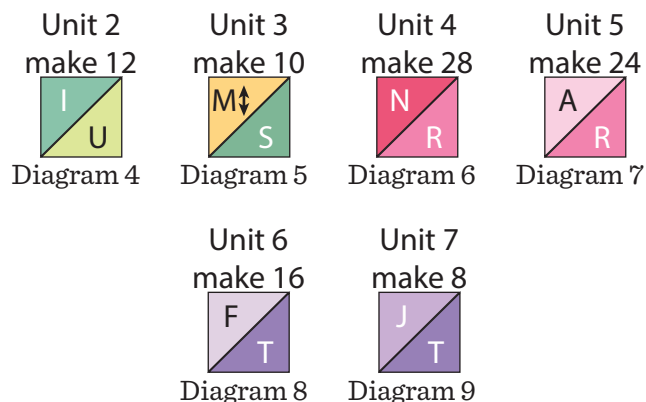
Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.

Block Assembly

- Place (1) 4 7/8" Fabric U square on top of (1) 4 7/8" Fabric O square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 1). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 1). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 2) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" to make (2) Unit 1 squares (Diagram 3). Repeat to make an additional (2) Unit 1 squares.



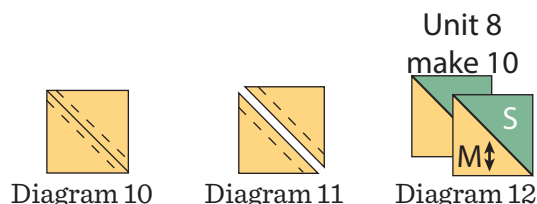
- Repeat Step 1 and refer to Diagrams 4-9 for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make the indicated number of 4 1/2" unit squares for Unit 2 through Unit 7.



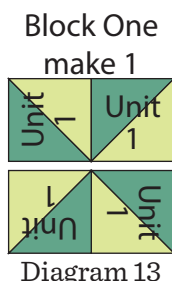
- Place (1) 4 7/8" Fabric M square on top of (1) 4 7/8" Fabric S square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Diagram 10). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 10). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 11) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" to make (2) Unit 8 squares

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(Diagram 12). Repeat to make an additional (8) Unit 8 squares. *Note: A total of (112) 4 1/2" unit squares will be made from Steps 1-3.*

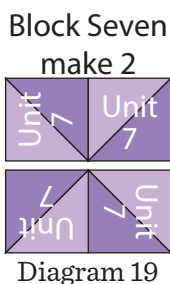
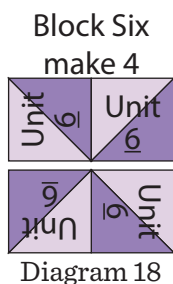
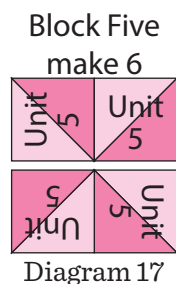
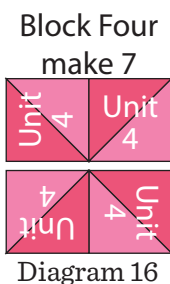
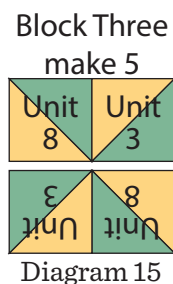
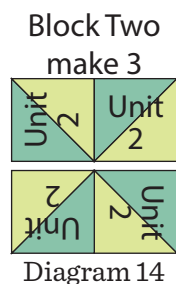


4. Sew together (4) Unit 1 squares into a 2 x 2 matrix to make (1) 8 1/2" Block One square (Diagram 13).

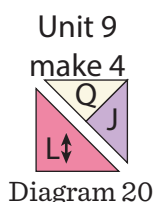


5. Repeat Step 4 and refer to Diagrams 14-19 for component identification, placement and orientation to make the indicated number of 8 1/2" block squares for Block Two through Block Seven.

Note: A total of (28) 8 1/2" block squares will be made.

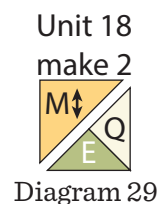
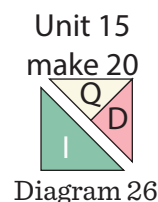
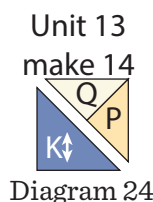
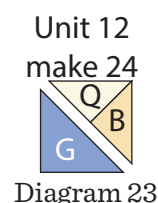
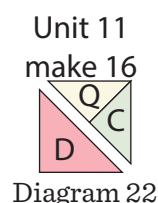
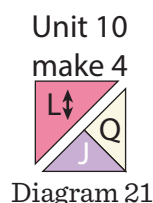


6. Sew together (1) 5 1/4" Fabric Q triangle and (1) 5 1/4" Fabric J triangle along short sides. Sew (1) 4 7/8" Fabric L triangle to the long side of the newly sewn triangle to make (1) 4 1/2" Unit 9 square (Diagram 20). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 9 squares.

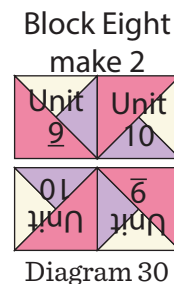


7. Repeat Step 6 and refer to Diagrams 21 through 29 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make the designated number of 4 1/2" unit squares for Unit 10 through Unit 18.

Note: A total of (112) 4 1/2" unit squares will be made from Steps 6-7.



8. Sew (1) Unit 9 square to the left side of (1) Unit 10 square to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Paying attention to the row orientations, sew together the (2) pieced rows lengthwise to make (1) 8 1/2" Block Eight square (Diagram 30). Repeat to make a second Block Eight square.



9. Repeat Step 8 and refer to Diagrams 31 through 36 for unit identification, placement and orientation to make the indicated number of 8 1/2" block squares for Block Nine through Block Fourteen.

Note: A total of (28) 8 1/2" block squares will be made from Steps 8-9.

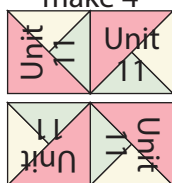

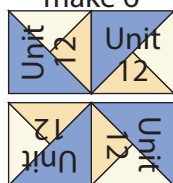

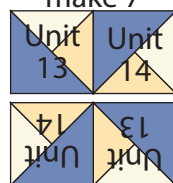

Quilt Top Assembly

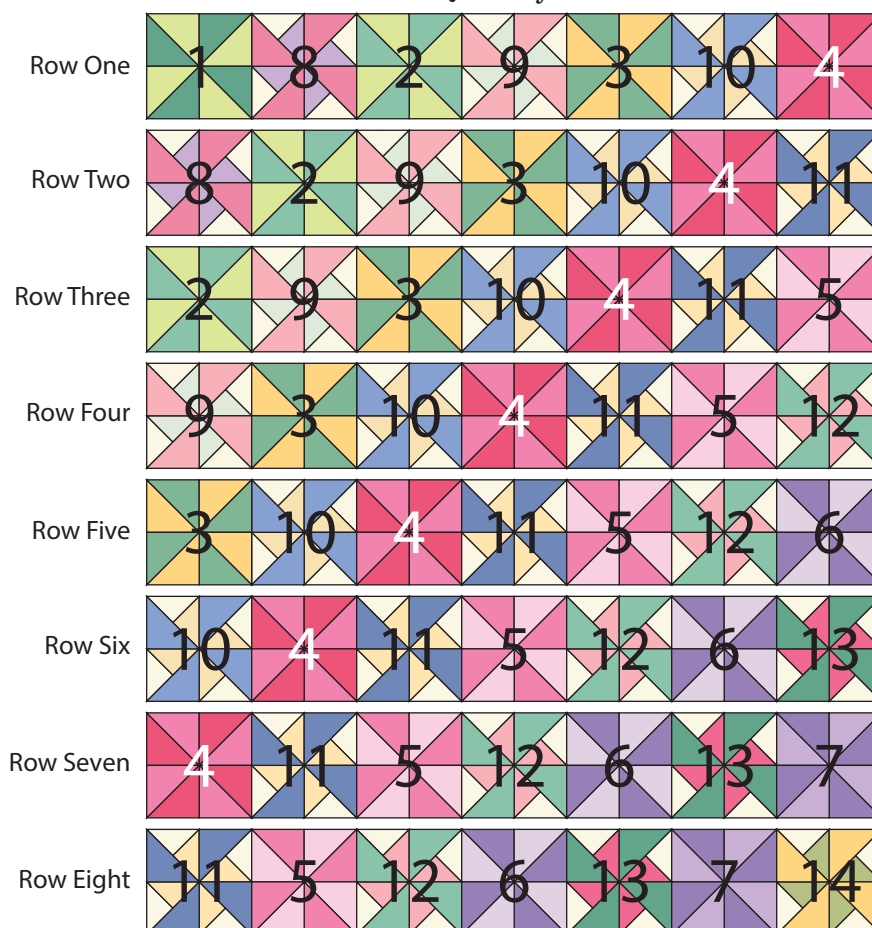
(Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)

10. Sew together (7) assorted 8 1/2" block squares end to end as shown to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Two through Row Eight.
11. Sew together the (8) pieced Rows, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the 56 1/2" x 64 1/2" Quilt Top.

Finishing the Quilt

12. Layer and quilt as desired.
13. Sew the (6) binding strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
14. Bind as desired.
