## Quilt Cutting Directions

**Note: Read assembly directions before cutting.**

Fabrics are cut to exact length required plus 1/4" seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

**Fabric A** Cut (3) 10 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (8) 10 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangles.

**Fabric B** Cut (3) 10 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (9) 10 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangles.

**Fabric C** Cut (3) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 1/2" x 60 1/2" strips.  
Cut (3) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 1/2" x 50 1/2" strips.

**Fabric D** Cut (2) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (12) 4 1/2" x 5 1/2" strips.

**Fabric E** Cut (2) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (12) 3" x 4 1/2" strips.

**Fabric F** Cut (2) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (12) 3" x 4 1/2" strips.

**Fabric G** Cut (2) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (12) 3" x 4 1/2" strips.

**Fabric H** Cut (2) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (12) 3" x 4 1/2" strips.

**Fabric I** Cut (2) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (12) 3" x 4 1/2" strips.

**Fabric J** Cut (2) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (12) 3" x 4 1/2" strips.

**Fabric K** Cut (2) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (12) 3" x 4 1/2" strips.

**Fabric L** Cut (2) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (12) 3" x 4 1/2" strips.

**Fabric M** Cut (2) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (12) 3" x 4 1/2" strips.

**Fabric N** Cut (2) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (12) 3" x 4 1/2" strips.

**Fabric O** Cut (6) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (4) 2" x 60 1/2" strips.  
Cut (6) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (4) 2" x 50 1/2" strips.

**Fabric P** Following the manufacturer's instructions, press the fusible web to the wrong side of the fabric. Fussy cut (17) triangles each centered on a banner.

## Quilt Cutting Directions - Continued

**Fabric Q** Cut (6) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (4) 3" x 50 1/2" strips.  
Cut (6) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (4) 2" x 60 1/2" strips.

**Binding** Cut (8) 2 1/2" x WOF strips.

**Backing** Cut (2) 92" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make (1) 78" x 92" backing.

## Making the Quilt

*Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.*

### Block Assembly

- Center and press (1) Fabric P triangle onto (1) 10 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric A strip (Diagram 1).
- Finish the raw edges of the triangle with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make (1) Block One rectangle (Diagram 1).
- Repeat Steps 1-2 to make an additional (7) Block One rectangles.
- Repeat Steps 1-2 and refer to Diagram 2 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (9) 10 1/2" x 12 1/2" Block Two rectangles.

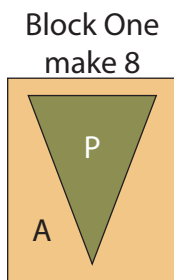

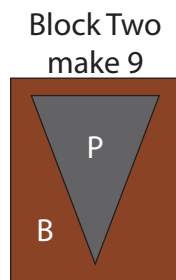

- Sew together (1) 3" x 4 1/2" Fabric E strip, (1) 3" x 4 1/2" Fabric I strip, (1) 3" x 4 1/2" Fabric H strip and (1) 3" x 4 1/2" Fabric M strip, lengthwise and in that order from left to right, to make the top row (Diagram 3).

- Sew together (1) 3" x 4 1/2" Fabric N strip, (1) 4 1/2" x 5 1/2" Fabric D strip and (1) 3" x 4 1/2" Fabric J strip in that order from left to right to make the middle row (Diagram 3).

- Sew together (1) 3" x 4 1/2" Fabric K strip, (1) 3" x 4 1/2" Fabric F strip, (1) 3" x 4 1/2" Fabric L strip and (1) 3" x 4 1/2" Fabric G strip, lengthwise and in that order from left to right, to make the bottom row (Diagram 3).

- Sew together the (3) pieced rows from Steps 5-7 lengthwise to make the 10 1/2" x 12 1/2" Block Three rectangle (Diagram 3).

- Repeat Steps 5-7 and refer to Diagrams 4-14 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (1) of each block rectangle for Block Four through Block Fourteen.

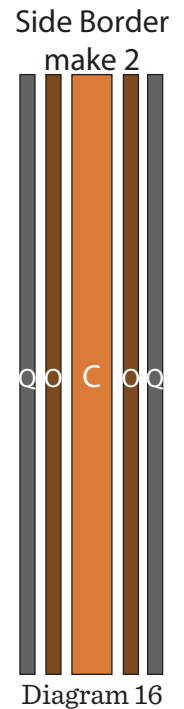
**10.** Sew together (1) Block One rectangle, (1) Block Three rectangle, (1) Block Two rectangle, (1) Block Four rectangle and (1) Block 1 rectangle, in that order from left to right, to make Row One (Diagram 15).

**11.** Repeat Step 10 and refer to Diagram 15 for component identification, placement and orientation to make Row Two through Row Five.

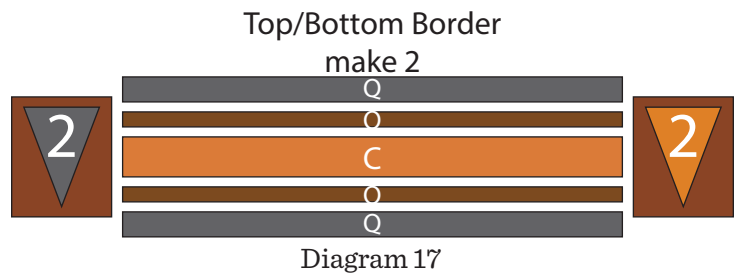
**12.** Sew together the (5) pieced Rows, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the 50 1/2" x 60 1/2" Quilt Center (Diagram 15).



**13.** Sew (1) 2" x 60 1/2" Fabric O strip to each side of (1) 4 1/2" x 60 1/2" Fabric C strip. Sew (1) 2" x 60 1/2" Fabric Q strip to each side of the newly sewn strip to make (1) 10 1/2" x 60 1/2" Side Border (Diagram 16). Repeat to make a second Side Border.



**14.** Sew (1) 2" x 50 1/2" Fabric O strip to the top and bottom of (1) 4 1/2" x 50 1/2" Fabric C strip. Sew (1) 3" x 50 1/2" Fabric Q strip to the top and bottom of the newly sewn strip. Sew (1) Block Two rectangle to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the 12 1/2" x 70 1/2" Top Border (Diagram 17). Repeat to make the Bottom Border.

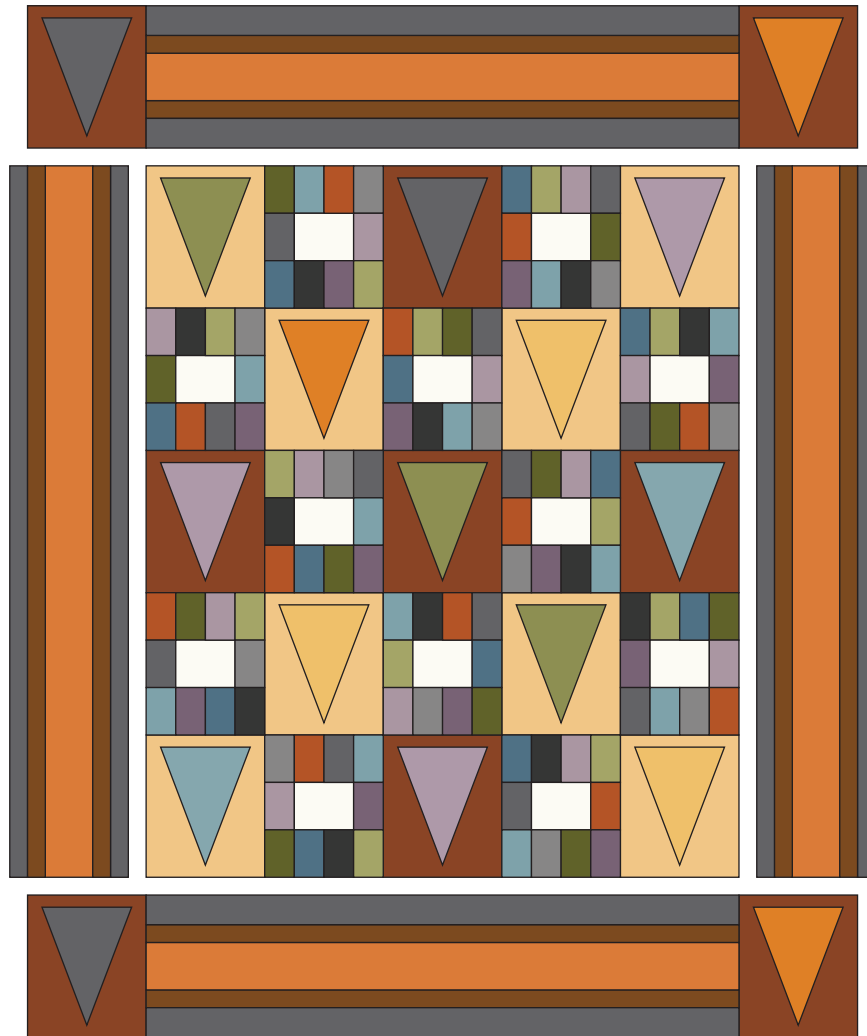
## Quilt Top Assembly

*(Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)*

15. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Quilt Center.
16. Sew the Top Border and the Bottom Border to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center to make the Quilt Top.

## Finishing the Quilt

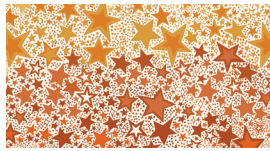
17. Layer and quilt as desired.
18. Sew together the (8) binding strips end to end with 45-degree seams. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
19. Bind as desired.



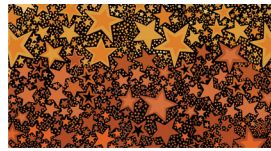
Quilt Layout

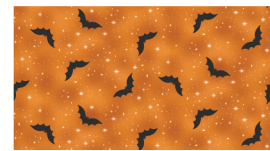

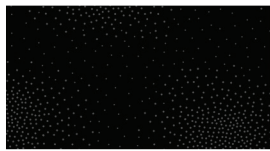

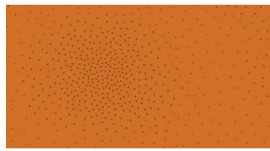
