## Quilt Cutting Directions

**Note: Read assembly directions before cutting.**

Borders are cut to exact length required plus 1/4" seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

### Fabric A

#### Block 1

Cut (2) 3 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (22) 3 1/2" squares.

#### Block 4

Cut (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 3" squares.

#### Block 9

Cut (1) 5 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 5 1/2" squares.

Cut (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (8) 3" squares.

### Fabric B

#### Block 1

Cut (1) 3 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 3 7/8" squares.

#### Block 3

Cut (1) 6 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 6 1/2" squares.

#### Block 6

Cut (1) 7 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 7 1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (8) 7 1/4" triangles.

#### Block 8

Cut (1) 3 1/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 3 1/8" squares.

#### Block 10

Cut (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (8) 3" squares.

### Fabric C

#### Block 1

Cut (2) 3 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (12) 3 7/8" squares.

Cut (1) 3 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (8) 3 1/2" squares.

#### Block 7

Cut (1) 4 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (6) 4 7/8" squares.

#### Block 8

Cut (1) 5 3/4" square. Cut the square across both diagonals to make (4) 5 3/4" triangles.

#### Block 7

Cut (1) 4 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 4 7/8" squares.

### Fabric E

#### Block 1

Cut (2) 6 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (8) 6 7/8" squares.

Cut (2)  $6\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (8)  $6\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.

Cut (1)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (8)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

#### Block 3

Cut (1)  $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (1)  $7\frac{1}{4}$ " square and (4)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Cut the  $7\frac{1}{4}$ " square across both diagonals to make (4)  $7\frac{1}{4}$ " triangles.

#### Block 5

Cut (1)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and (4)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

### Fabric G

#### Block 1

Cut (1)  $6\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4)  $6\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.

Cut (2)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (16)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

#### Block 2

Cut (2)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (24)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Cut (4)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (58)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

#### Block 4

Cut (1)  $3\frac{3}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4)  $3\frac{3}{8}$ " squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (8)  $3\frac{3}{8}$ " triangles.

Cut (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (8) 3" squares.

#### Block 5

Cut (1)  $3\frac{3}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (7)  $3\frac{3}{8}$ " squares.

Cut (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (12) 3" squares.

#### Block 6

Cut (1)  $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2)  $7\frac{1}{4}$ " squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (8)  $7\frac{1}{4}$ " triangles.

#### Block 7

Cut (1)  $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (6)  $5\frac{1}{4}$ " squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (24)  $5\frac{1}{4}$ " triangles.

Cut (1)  $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2)  $4\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.

### Fabric G

#### Block 8

Cut (1) 5" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 5" x  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Cut (1)  $3\frac{1}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4)  $3\frac{1}{8}$ " squares and (8)  $2\frac{3}{4}$ " squares.

#### Block 9

Cut (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (12) 3" squares.

#### Block 10

Cut (1)  $5\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2)  $5\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.

Cut (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (8) 3" x  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

### Fabric H

#### Block 1

Cut (1)  $6\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4)  $6\frac{7}{8}$ " squares and (2)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

#### Block 3

Cut (1)  $8\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (1)  $8\frac{1}{4}$ " square and (4) 4" squares. Cut the  $8\frac{1}{4}$ " square across both diagonals to make (4)  $8\frac{1}{4}$ " triangles.

#### Block 4

Cut (1)  $5\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2)  $5\frac{7}{8}$ " squares and (1)  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Cut the  $5\frac{7}{8}$ " squares across (1) diagonal to make (4)  $5\frac{7}{8}$ " triangles.

#### Block 8

Cut (1)  $5\frac{3}{4}$ " square. Cut the square across both diagonals to make (4)  $5\frac{3}{4}$ " triangles.

### Fabric I

#### Block 2

Cut (2)  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (12)  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " square.

Cut (3)  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (29)  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.

#### Block 5

Cut (1)  $3\frac{3}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (1)  $3\frac{3}{8}$ " square and (8) 3" squares.

### Fabric J

#### Block 2

Cut (2)  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (12)  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " square.

Cut (3)  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (29)  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.

#### Block 3

Cut (1) 7 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (5) 7 1/2" squares.

#### Block 7

Cut (1) 4 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 4 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (8) 4 7/8" triangles.

#### Block 10

Cut (1) 3 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (8) 3 1/2" squares.

### Fabric L

#### Block 3

Cut (1) 8 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 8 1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (8) 8 1/4" triangles.

#### Block 5

Cut (1) 3 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (8) 3 1/2" squares.

#### Block 11

Cut (1) 3 1/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (3) 3 1/8" squares.

### Fabric M

#### Block 3

Cut (1) 8 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (1) 8 1/4" square, (1) 6 1/2" square, and (1) 7 1/4" square. Cut the 8 1/4" square across both diagonals to make (4) 8 1/4" triangles. Cut the 7 1/4" square across both diagonals to make (4) 7 1/4" triangles.

Cut (2) 4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (12) 4" squares.

Cut (1) 3 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (12) 3 1/2" squares.

#### Block 4

Cut (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 3" squares.

#### Block 5

Cut (1) 3 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 3 7/8" squares and (4) 3 1/2" squares.

Cut (1) 3 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" strips.

#### Block 10

Cut (1) 6 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 6 7/8" squares.

Cut (2) 3 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (8) 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" strips.

### Fabric M

#### Block 11

Cut (2) 3 1/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (18) 3 1/8" squares. Cut (8) of the squares across (1) diagonal to make (16) 3 1/8" triangles.

Cut (1) 2 3/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (8) 2 3/4" squares.

### Fabric N

#### Block 3 and Block 9

Cut (1) 7 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 7 1/4" squares for Block 3 and (8) 3" squares for Block 9. Cut the 7 1/4" squares across both diagonals to make (8) 7 1/4" triangles.

### Fabric O

#### Block 4

Cut (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (8) 3" squares.

#### Block 6 and Block 8

Cut (1) 7 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 7 1/4" squares for Block 6 and (2) 5 3/8" squares for Block 8. Cut 7 1/4" the squares across both diagonals to make (8) 7 1/4" triangles. Cut the 5 3/8" squares across (1) diagonal to make (4) 5 3/8" triangles.

#### Block 11

Cut (1) 3 1/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (5) 3 1/8" squares.

### Fabric P

#### Block 4

Cut (1) 5 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 5 1/2" squares.

#### Block 11

Cut (1) 5 3/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 5 3/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (8) 5 3/8" triangles.

### Fabric Q

#### Block 5

Cut (1) 3 3/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (8) 3 3/8" squares.

### Fabric R

#### Block 5 and Block 9

Cut (1) 6 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (1) 6 1/2" square for Block 5 and (4) 5 1/2" squares for Block 9.

### Fabric S

#### Block 5

Cut (1) 3 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (8) 3 1/2" squares.

#### Block 7

Cut (1) 5 ¼" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (1) 5 ¼" square and (4) 4 ½" squares. Cut the 5 ¼" square across both diagonals to make (4) 5 ¼" triangles.

#### Block 9

Cut (1) 5 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (1) 5 ½" square and (8) 3" squares.

#### Block 10

Cut (1) 6 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 6 ⅞" squares.

#### Block 11

Cut (1) 3 ⅛" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 3 ⅛" squares and (8) 2 ¾" squares.

### Fabric T

#### Block 5 and Block 11

Cut (1) 3 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 3 ⅞" squares for Block 5 and (4) 3 ⅛" squares for Block 11.

#### Block 7

Cut (1) 5 ¼" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 5 ¼" squares and (6) 4 ⅞" squares. Cut the 5 ¼" squares across both diagonals to make (8) 5 ¼" triangles.

#### Block 8

Cut (1) 5" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (8) 5" squares.

### Fabric U

#### Block 6

Cut (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 6 ½" squares.

### Fabric V

#### Block 6 & Block 7

Cut (1) 7 ¼" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 7 ¼" squares for Block 6 and (3) 5 ¼" squares for Block 7. Cut the 7 ¼" squares across both diagonals to make (8) 7 ¼" triangles. Cut the 5 ¼" square across both diagonals to make (12) 5 ¼" triangles.

#### Block 10

Cut (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (8) 3 ½" squares.

### Fabric W

#### Block 1 and Block 6

Cut (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (5) 4 ½" squares for Block 6 and (4) 3 ⅞" squares for Block 1.

### Fabric X

#### Block 6

Cut (4) 4 ½" squares.

### Fabric Y

#### Block 10

Cut (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (1) 6 ½" square, (1) 5 ½" square and (8) 3" squares.

### Fabric Z

#### Background

Cut (2) 4" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (1) 4" x 43 ½" strip.

Cut (1) 3 ½" x 42" WOF strip.

Cut (2) 3 ½" x 24 ½" WOF strips.

Cut (1) 3 ½" x 24" WOF strip.

Cut (1) 3 ½" x 23" WOF strip.

Cut (2) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (3) 3 ½" x 18 ½" strips.

Cut (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 3 ½" x 15 ½" strips.

Cut (2) 3" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (1) 3" x 49" strip.

Cut (2) 3" x 36" WOF strips.

Cut (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (1) 3" x 18 ½" strip and (1) 3" x 4 ½" strip.

Cut (1) 2 ¾" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 2 ¾" x 18 ½" strips.

Cut (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (3) 2 ½" x 18 ½" strips.

Cut (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

Cut (1) 2" x 36 ½" WOF strip.

Cut (1) 2" x 28 ½" WOF strip.

Cut (2) 2" x 24 ½" WOF strips.

Cut (1) 2" x 22" WOF strip.

Cut (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (3) 2" x 21 ½" strips.

Cut (1) 2" x 18 ½" WOF strip.

Cut (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 2" x 15 ½" strips and (3) 2" x 4 ½" strips.

Cut (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 1 ½" x 15 ½" strips.

### Binding

Cut (9) 2 ½" x WOF strips.

### Backing

Cut (3) 92" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make (1) 92" x 105" backing.

## Making the Quilt

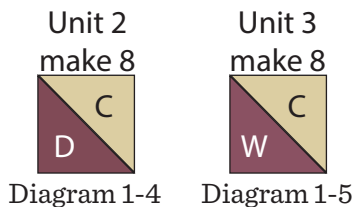
**Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.**

### Month One Assembly

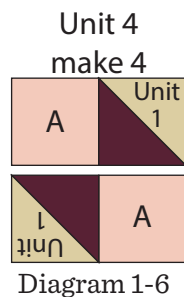
- Place (1)  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric B square on top of (1)  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric C square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Diagram 1-1). Sew  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 1-1). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 1-2) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " to make (2) Unit 1 squares (Diagram 1-3). Repeat to make an additional (6) Unit 1 squares.



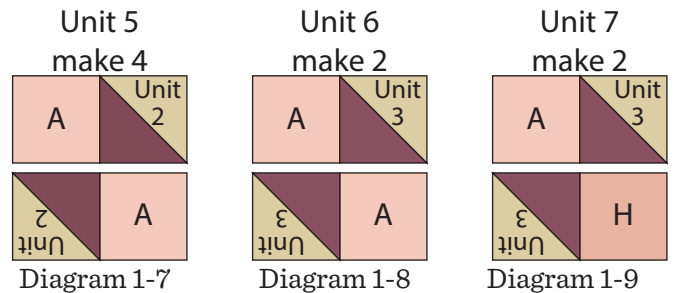
- Repeat Step 1 and refer to Diagrams 1-4 – 1-5 for fabric identification and placement to make (8) Unit 2 squares and (8) Unit 3 squares.



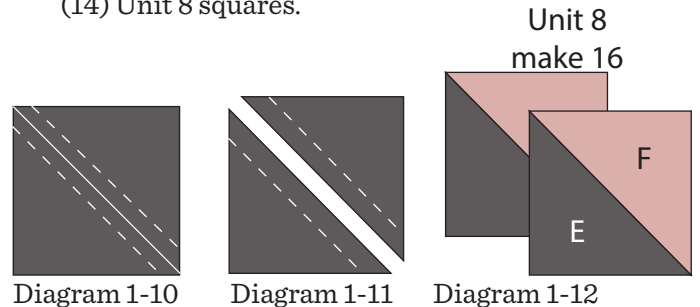
- Sew together (2)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A squares and (2) Unit 1 squares as shown to make (1)  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 4 square (Diagram 1-6). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 4 squares.



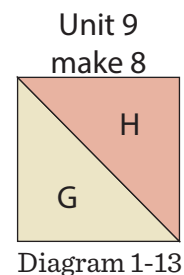
- Repeat Step 3 and refer to Diagrams 1-7 – 1-9 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (4) Unit 5 squares, (2) Unit 6 squares and (2) Unit 7 squares.



- Place (1)  $6\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric E square on top of (1)  $6\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric F square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Diagram 1-10). Sew  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 1-10). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 1-11) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " to make (2) Unit 8 squares (Diagram 1-12). Repeat to make an additional (14) Unit 8 squares.



- Repeat Step 5 and refer to Diagram 1-13 for fabric identification and placement to make (8)  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 9 squares.

7. Place (1) 3 1/2" Fabric G square on the top right corner of (1) Unit 8 square, right sides together (Diagram 1-14). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Diagram 1-14). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam to make (1) Unit 10 square (Diagram 1-15). Repeat to make an additional (15) Unit 10 squares.

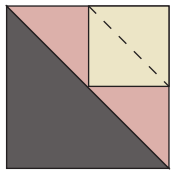

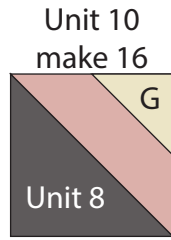

8. Repeat Step 7 and refer to Diagram 1-16 for component identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make (8) Unit 11 squares.

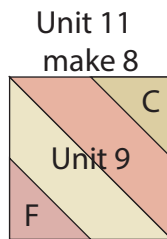

9. Sew together (1) Unit 4 square, (1) Unit 10 square and (1) Unit 11 square, in that order from left to right, to make the top row (Diagram 1-17).
10. Sew (1) Unit 10 square to each side of (1) Unit 5 square to make the middle row (Diagram 1-17).
11. Sew together (1) Unit 11 square, (1) Unit 10 square and (1) Unit 6 square, in that order from left to right, to make the bottom row (Diagram 1-17).

12. Sew together the (3) pieced rows from Steps 9-11 lengthwise to make (1) 18 1/2" Block One - A square (Diagram 1-17).

13. Repeat Steps 9-12 to make a second Block One - A.

## Month Two Assembly

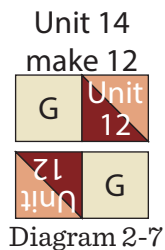
- Place (1)  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric J square on top of (1)  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric I square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Diagram 2-1). Sew  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 2-1). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 2-2) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " to make (2) Unit 12 squares (Diagram 2-3). Repeat to make an additional (22) Unit 12 squares.

3. Sew (1) Unit 60 to the left side of (1)  $2\frac{3}{4}$ " Fabric M square to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew the (2) rows together lengthwise to make (1) 5" Unit 64 square (Diagram 11-7). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 64 squares.



4. Repeat Step 3 and refer to Diagrams 11-8 – 11-9 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (2) 5" Unit 65 squares and (2) 5" Unit 66 squares.

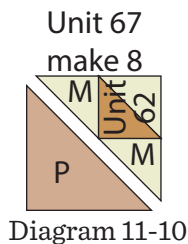

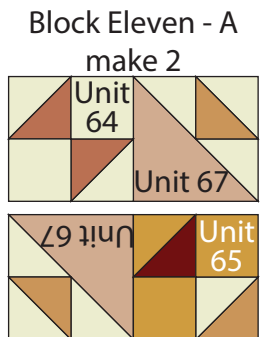

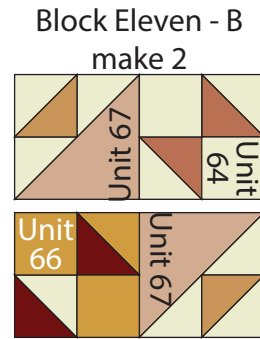

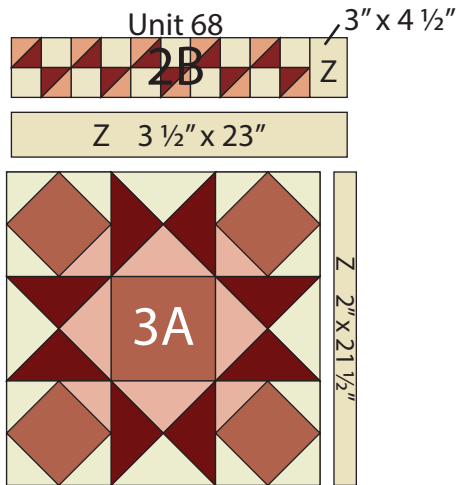

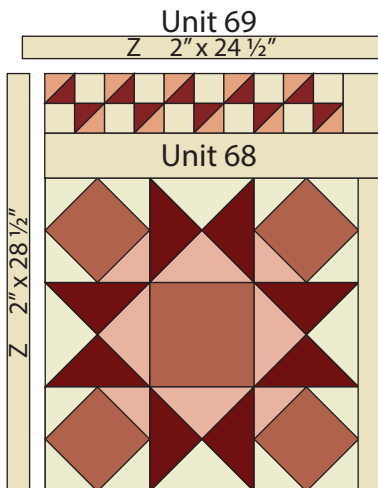

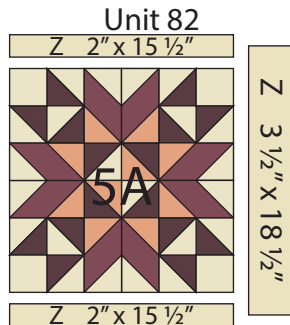
