## Quilt Cutting Directions

**Note: Read assembly directions before cutting.**

Fabrics are cut to exact length required plus 1/4" seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

**Fabric A** Cut (1) 9 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 9 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (4) 9 7/8" triangles.

**Fabric B** Cut (1) 9 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (3) 9 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (6) 9 7/8" triangles.

**Fabric C** Cut (1) 9 7/8" square. Cut the square across (1) diagonal to make (2) 9 7/8" triangles.

**Fabric D** Cut (1) 9 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 9 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (4) 9 7/8" triangles.

**Fabric E** Cut (1) 9 7/8" square. Cut the square across (1) diagonal to make (2) 9 7/8" triangles. *Note: You will only use (1) 9 7/8" triangle.*

**Fabric F** Cut (1) 9 7/8" square. Cut the square across (1) diagonal to make (2) 9 7/8" triangles.

**Fabric G** Cut (1) 9 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (3) 9 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (6) 9 7/8" triangles.

**Fabric H** Cut (2) 9 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (7) 9 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (14) 9 7/8" triangles.

**Fabric I** Cut (1) 9 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 9 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (4) 9 7/8" triangles. *Note: You will only use (3) 9 7/8" triangles.*

**Fabric J** Cut (2) 9 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (7) 9 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (14) 9 7/8" triangles. *Note: You will only use (13) 9 7/8" triangles.*

**Fabric K** Cut (1) 9 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 9 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (4) 9 7/8" triangles.

**Fabric L** Cut (1) 9 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 9 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (4) 9 7/8" triangles. *Note: You will only use (3) 9 7/8" triangles.*

| <b>Fabric N</b> | Cut (1) 9 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (3) 9 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (6) 9 7/8" triangles.                                                          |
| <b>Fabric O</b> | Cut (1) 9 7/8" square. Cut the square across (1) diagonal to make (2) 9 7/8" triangles.                                                                                                           |
| <b>Fabric P</b> | Cut (3) 9 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (10) 9 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (20) 9 7/8" triangles.                                                      |
| <b>Fabric Q</b> | Cut (1) 9 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 9 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (4) 9 7/8" triangles.                                                          |
| <b>Fabric R</b> | Cut (2) 9 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (8) 9 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (16) 9 7/8" triangles. <i>Note: You will only use (15) 9 7/8" triangles.</i> |
| <b>Fabric S</b> | Cut (2) 9 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (7) 9 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (14) 9 7/8" triangles.                                                       |
| <b>Fabric T</b> | Cut (1) 9 7/8" square. Cut the square across (1) diagonal to make (2) 9 7/8" triangles. <i>Note: You will only use (1) 9 7/8" triangle.</i>                                                       |
| <b>Binding</b>  | Cut (8) 2 1/2" x WOF strips.                                                                                                                                                                      |
| <b>Backing</b>  | Cut (2) 80" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make (1) 80" x 80" backing.                                                                                                         |

## Making the Quilt

### Block Assembly

1. Sew together (1) 9 7/8" Fabric R triangle and (1) 9 7/8" Fabric H triangle along their long sides to make (1) Block One square (Diagram 1). Trim the block to measure 9 1/2" square.

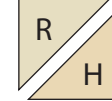

2. Repeat Step 1 and refer to the Quilt Layout on Page 4 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make an additional (63) 9 1/2" block squares.

### Quilt Top Assembly

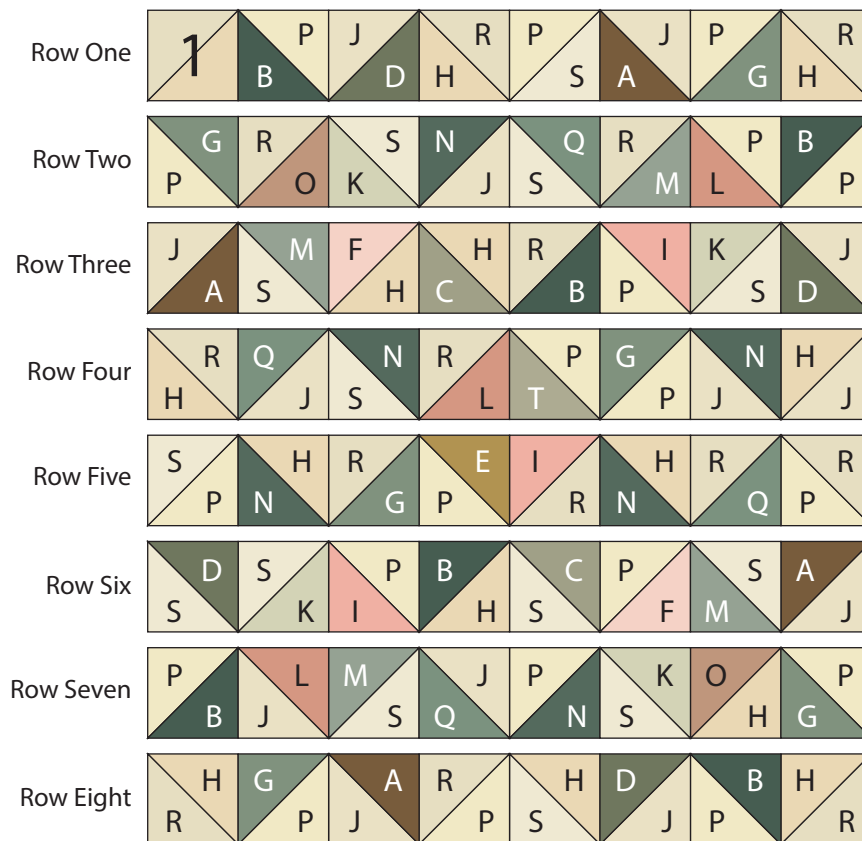
*(Refer to the Quilt Layout on Page 4 when assembling the quilt top.)*

3. Sew together (8) assorted block squares as shown to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Two through Row Eight.
4. Sew together the (8) pieced Rows, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the Quilt Top.

### Finishing the Quilt

5. Layer and quilt as desired.
6. Sew together the (8) binding strips end to end with 45-degree seams. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
7. Bind as desired.

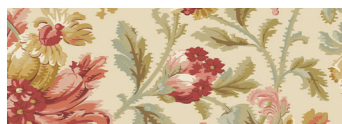




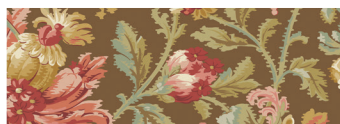
