Quilt Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. Borders are cut to exact length required plus $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide). LOF designates the length of fabric perpendicular to the selvedge.

Fabric A Fussy cut (8) $10\frac{1}{2}$ " squares, centered on the blocks.

Fabric B Cut (9) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (18) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $16\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
Cut (6) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (18) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Fabric C Cut (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (10) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " strips, (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Fabric D Cut (1) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Fabric E Cut (6) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (16) 2" x $13\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
Cut (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (16) 2" x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
Cut (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
Cut (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Fabric F Cut (4) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (36) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Fabric G Cut (7) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (4) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $64\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Fabric H Cut (12) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (24) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $16\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Fabric I Cut (24) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (48) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $16\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Fabric J Cut (2) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (16) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares and (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

Fabric K Cut (4) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $64\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
Cut (3) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $60\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Fabric L Cut (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " strip, (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " strip, (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " strip and (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " strip.

Binding Cut (8) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the binding.

Backing Cut (2) 82" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make (1) 82" x 82" backing.



Making the Quilt


Note: The arrows in diagrams represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

Block Assembly

1. Sew (1) 2" x 10 1/2" Fabric E strip to each side of (1) 10 1/2" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2" x 13 1/2" Fabric E strip to the top and bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Diagram 1). **Trim the unit to measure 12 1/2" x 12 1/2"**. Repeat to make an additional (7) Unit 1 squares.



2. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 16 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and bottom of the Unit 1 square to make (1) 16 1/2" Unit 2 square (Diagram 2). Repeat to make an additional (7) Unit 2 squares.



3. Place (1) 4 1/2" Fabric F square on the top left corner of (1) Unit 2 square, right sides together (Diagram 3). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 3). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 4). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam.





4. Follow Diagram 5 for the seam direction to add a 4 1/2" Fabric F square to each of the remaining corners of the Unit 2 square to make (1) 16 1/2" Block One square (Diagram 6).





6. Place (1) 2 1/2" Fabric C square on the left side of (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric L strip, right sides together (Diagram 7). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 7). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 8). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.

7. Place (1) 2 1/2" Fabric C square on the right side of the 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric L strip, right sides together (Diagram 9). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Diagram 9). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Unit 3 strip (Diagram 10).

8. Repeat Steps 6-7 using (2) 2 1/2" Fabric C squares and (1) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" Fabric L strip to make (1) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" Unit 4 strip (Diagram 11).



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9. Repeat Steps 6-7 using (2) 2 1/2" Fabric C squares and (1) 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric L strip to make (1) 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" Unit 5 strip (Diagram 12).
10. Repeat Steps 6-7 using (2) 2 1/2" Fabric C squares and (1) 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" Fabric L strip to make (1) 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" Unit 6 strip (Diagram 13).





11. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" Fabric C strip to each end of the Unit 3 strip to make (1) 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" Unit 7 strip (Diagram 14).
12. Sew (1) 2 1/2" Fabric C square to each end of the Unit 4 strip to make (1) 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" Unit 8 strip (Diagram 15).



13. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" Fabric C strip to each end of the Unit 5 strip to make (1) 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" Unit 9 strip (Diagram 16).
14. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric C strip to each side of (1) 2 1/2" Fabric J square to make (1) 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" Unit 10 strip (Diagram 17).





15. Sew together the Unit 7 strip, Unit 8 strip, Unit 9 strip, Unit 6 strip and the Unit 10 strip, lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom, to make (1) 10 1/2" Unit 11 square (Diagram 18).



16. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" Fabric E strip to each side of the Unit 11 square. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric E strip to the top and bottom of the Unit 11 square to make (1) 12 1/2" Unit 12 square (Diagram 19).



17. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the Unit 12 square. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 16 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and bottom of the Unit 12 square to make (1) 16 1/2" Unit 13 square (Diagram 20).
18. Repeat Steps 3-4 and refer to Diagram 21 for component identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make (1) Block Two square.





19. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 16 1/2" Fabric I strip to the top and bottom of (1) 1 1/2" x 16 1/2" Fabric H strip lengthwise to make (1) 16 1/2" x 3 1/2" Block Three rectangle (Diagram 22). Repeat to make an additional (23) Block Three rectangles.



The Wild Life

- 20.** Sew together (4) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J squares and (3) Block Three rectangles, alternating them from left to right, to make Row One (Diagram 23). Repeat to make Row Three, Row Five and Row Seven.
- 21.** Sew together (4) Block Three rectangles and (3) Block One squares, alternating them from left to right, to make Row Two (Diagram 23). Repeat to make Row Six.
- 22.** Sew together (1) Block Three rectangle, (1) Block One square, (1) Block Three rectangle, (1) Block Two square, (1) Block Three rectangle, (1) Block One square and (1) Block Three rectangle, in that order from left to right, to make Row Four (Diagram 23).
- 23.** Sew together the (7) pieced Rows, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the $60\frac{1}{2}$ " x $60\frac{1}{2}$ " Quilt Center (Diagram 23).

Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)

- 24.** Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $60\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $64\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center.
- 25.** Sew (1) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $64\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip to each side of the Quilt Center.
- 26.** Sew (1) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D square to each end of (1) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $64\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip to make (1) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $74\frac{1}{2}$ ". Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $74\frac{1}{2}$ " strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center to make the Quilt Top.




Finishing the Quilt

27. Layer and quilt as desired.
28. Sew together the (8) binding strips end to end with 45-degree seams. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
29. Bind as desired.






