## Quilt Cutting Directions

**Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches.** Borders are cut to exact length required plus ¼" seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

- Fabric A** Cut (2) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (24) 3 ½" x 3" strips.
- Fabric B** Cut (3) 5" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5" x 60 ½" strips.  
Cut (3) 5" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5" x 51 ½" strips.
- Fabric C** Cut (1) 11 ¼" square. Cut the square across both diagonals to make (4) 11 ¼" triangles. *Note: You will only use (2) 11 ¼" triangles.*
- Fabric D** Cut (2) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (8) 3" x 5 ½" strips.
- Fabric E** Cut (4) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (24) 3" x 5 ½" strips.
- Fabric F** Cut (3) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (16) 3" x 5 ½" strips.
- Fabric G** Cut (2) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (8) 3" x 5 ½" strips.
- Fabric H** Cut (3) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (16) 3" x 5 ½" strips.
- Fabric I** Cut (1) 11 ¼" square. Cut the square across both diagonals to make (4) 11 ¼" triangles. *Note: You will only use (2) 11 ¼" triangles.*
- Fabric J** Cut (2) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (12) 3 ½" x 5 ½" strips.

\* Spritz Collection

- Fabric K** Cut (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (12) 3 ½" x 3" strips.  
Cut (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (12) 3" x 3 ½" strips.
- Fabric L** Fussy cut (8) 10 ½" squares each centered on a block.
- Fabric M** Cut (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 3 ½" squares.
- Fabric N** Cut (11) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (144) 3" squares.
- Fabric O** Cut (3) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (36) 3" squares.
- Binding** Cut (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips.
- Backing** Cut (2) 68" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make (1) 68" x 68" backing.

## Making the Quilt

**Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.**

### Block Assembly

- Place (1) 3" Fabric N square on the left side of (1) 3" x 5 1/2" Fabric G strip, right sides together (Diagram 1). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.

- Place another 3" Fabric N square on the right side of the 3" x 5 1/2" Fabric G strip, right sides together (Diagram 3). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Diagram 3). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 1 rectangle (Diagram 4).





- Repeat Steps 1-2 and refer to Diagrams 5-8 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make the indicated number of unit rectangles for Unit 2 through Unit 5.







- Sew together (2) Unit 1 rectangles end to end to make (1) 10 1/2" x 3" Unit 6 strip (Diagram 9). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 6 strips.



- Repeat Step 5 and refer to Diagrams 10-13 for component identification, placement and orientation to make the indicated number of unit strips for Unit 7 through Unit 10.



- Refer to Diagram 14 and sew together (2) 11 1/4" Fabric I triangles and (2) 11 1/4" Fabric C triangles to make (1) 10 1/2" Unit 11 square.



- Sew (1) 3" Fabric O square to each end of (1) Unit 6 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 6 strip to each side of the Unit 11 square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) 15 1/2" Block One square (Diagram 15).









# Tippy Toes



- 9.** Sew (1) 3" Fabric O square to each end of (1) Unit 7 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 7 strip to each side of (1) 10 1/2" Fabric L square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together lengthwise to make (1) 15 1/2" Block Two square (Diagram 16). Repeat to make an additional (2) Block Two squares.



- 10.** Repeat Step 9 and refer to Diagrams 17-19 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (2) Block Three squares, (2) Block Four squares and (1) Block Five square.



- 11.** Sew together (1) 3 1/2" x 3" Fabric K strip, (1) 3 1/2" x 3" Fabric A strip, (1) 3 1/2" x 5 1/2" Fabric J strip, (1) 3 1/2" x 3" Fabric A strip and (1) 3 1/2" x 3" Fabric K strip, in that order from top to bottom, to make (1) 3 1/2" x 15 1/2" Block Six strip (Diagram 20). Repeat to make an additional (5) Block Six strips.



- 12.** Repeat Step 11 and refer to Diagram 21 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (6) Block Seven strips.

- 13.** Sew together (1) Block Two square, (1) Block Six strip, (1) Block Three square, (1) Block Six strip and (1) Block Two square, in that order from left to right, to make Row One.

- 14.** Repeat Step 13 and refer to Diagram 22 for component identification, placement and orientation to make Row Three and Row Five.

- 15.** Sew together (3) Block Seven strips and (2) 3 1/2" Fabric M squares, alternating them from left to right, to make Row Two (Diagram 22). Repeat to make Row Four.

- 16.** Sew together the (5) pieced Rows, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the 51 1/2" x 51 1/2" Quilt Center (Diagram 22).

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


## Quilt Top Assembly

*(Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)*

- Sew (1) 5" x 51 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew (1) 5" x 60 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Quilt Center to make the Quilt Top.

## Finishing the Quilt

- Layer and quilt as desired.
- Sew together the (6) binding strips end to end with 45-degree seams. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- Bind as desired.


