

### **Quilt Cutting Directions** (All Versions)

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. Borders are cut to exact length required plus  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

Fabric A	Cut (216) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
Fabric B	Cut (6) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (36) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Cut (33) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (66) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $14\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
Fabric C	Cut (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (31) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
Fabric D	Cut (2) 21" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (3) 21" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (12) 21" triangles. <i>Note: You will only use (10) 21" triangles.</i> Cut (1) 10 ¾" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 10 ¾" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (4) 10 ¾" triangles.
Binding	Cut (9) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the binding.
Backing	Cut (2) 99" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make (1) 76" x 99" backing.



## Making the Quilt (All Versions)


Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.

#### **Block Assembly**


- 1. Sew together (3) assorted 2 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric A strips and (1) 2 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric B strip, lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom, to make (1) 6 ½" x 8 ½" Unit 1 rectangle (Diagram 1). Repeat to make an additional (35) Unit 1 rectangles.

- 2. Sew together (3) assorted 2 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric A strips, lengthwise from left to right, to make (1) 6 ½" Unit 2 square (Diagram 2). Repeat to make an additional (35) Unit 2 squares.



3. Sew (1) Unit 1 rectangle to the top of (1) Unit 2 square to make (1) 6 ½" x 14 ½" Unit 3 rectangle (Diagram 3). Repeat to make an additional (35) Unit 3 rectangles.



4. Paying attention to the orientation of the units, sew (1) Unit 3 rectangle to each side of (1) 2 ½" x 14 ½" Fabric B strip to make (1) 14 ½" Block One square (Diagram 4). Repeat to make an additional (17) Block One squares.



- **5.** Sew (1) 2 ½" Fabric C square to each end of (1) 2 ½" x 14 ½" Fabric B strip. Sew (1) 10 ¾" Fabric D triangle to the top of the newly sewn strip to make Row One (Diagram 5). Repeat to make Row Thirteen.
- **6.** Sew together (1) 21" Fabric D triangle, (1) 2 ½" x 14 ½" Fabric B strip, (1) Block One square, (1) 2 ½" x 14 ½" Fabric B strip and (1) 21" Fabric D triangle, in that order from left to right, to make Row Two (Diagram 5). Repeat to make Row Twelve.
- 7. Sew together (4) 2 ½" Fabric C squares and (3) 2 ½" x 14 ½" Fabric B strips, alternating them from left to right, to make Row Three. Repeat to make Row Eleven.
- 8. Sew together (4) 2 ½" x 14 ½" Fabric B strips and (3) Block One squares, alternating them from left to right. Sew (1) 21" Fabric D triangle to each end of the newly sewn strip to make Row Four (Diagram 5). Repeat to make Row Ten.
- 9. Sew together (6) 2 ½" Fabric C squares and (5) 2 ½" x 14 ½" Fabric B strips, alternating them from left to right, to make Row Five. Repeat to make Row Nine.
- **10.** Sew together (6) 2 ½" x 14 ½" Fabric B strips and (5) Block One squares, alternating them from left to right. Sew (1) 21" Fabric D triangle to the left end and (1) 10 ¾" Fabric D triangle to the right end of the newly sewn strip to make Row Six (Diagram 5).
- **11.** Sew together (7)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C squares and (6)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $14\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strips, alternating them from left to right, to make Row Seven.
- **12.** Sew together (6) 2 ½" x 14 ½" Fabric B strips and (5) Block One squares alternating them from left to right. Sew (1) 10 ¾" Fabric D triangle to the left end and (1) 21" Fabric D triangle to the right end of the newly sewn strip to make Row Eight (Diagram 5).
- 13. Sew together the (13) pieced Rows, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make(1) Unit 4 rectangle (Diagram 5).


#### **Quilt Top Assembly**

(Refer to the Diagrams 6-7 when assembling the quilt top.)

- **14.** Trim the Fabric C squares even with the Fabric D triangles to make the Unit 5 rectangle (Diagram 6).
- **15.** Rotate the Unit 5 rectangle to make the Quilt Top (Diagram 7).

## Finishing the Quilt (All Versions)

- 16. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 17. Sew the (9) binding strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 18. Bind as desired.
