

## Quilt Cutting Directions

**Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches.** Fabrics are cut to exact length required plus ¼" seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

<b>Fabric A</b>	Cut (4) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.	<b>Fabric E</b>	Cut (20) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
<b>Fabric B</b>	Cut (24) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.	<b>Fabric F</b>	Cut (8) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
<b>Fabric C</b>	Cut (20) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.	<b>Fabric G</b>	Cut (28) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
<b>Fabric D</b>	Cut (24) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.	<b>Fabric H</b>	Cut (16) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.


<b>Fabric I</b>	Cut (12) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.
<b>Fabric J</b>	Cut (12) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.
<b>Fabric K</b>	Cut (20) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.
<b>Fabric L</b>	Cut (4) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.
<b>Fabric M</b>	Cut (20) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.
<b>Fabric N</b>	Cut (16) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.
<b>Fabric O</b>	Cut (8) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.
<b>Fabric P</b>	Cut (12) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.
<b>Fabric Q</b>	Cut (12) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.

<b>Fabric V</b>	Cut (16) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.
<b>Fabric W</b>	Cut (8) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.
<b>Fabric X</b>	Cut (3) 8 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (12) 8 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (24) 8 7/8" triangles. Cut (1) 9 1/4" square. Cut the square across both diagonals to make (4) 9 1/4" triangles.
<b>Fabric Y</b>	Cut (38) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (340) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.
<b>Fabric Z</b>	Cut (4) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.
<b>Binding</b>	Cut (8) 2 1/2" x WOF strips.
<b>Backing</b>	Cut (3) 87" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make (1) 87" x 87" backing.

## Making the Quilt


**Note:** Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.

### Block Assembly









1. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric Y strip to the top of (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric U strip lengthwise to make (1) 4 1/2" Unit 1 square (Diagram 1). Repeat to make an additional (3) Unit 1 squares.



2. Paying attention to the unit orientations, sew together the (4) Unit 1 squares into a 2 x 2 matrix as shown to make (1) 8 1/2" Block One square (Diagram 2).



3. Repeat Steps 1-2 and refer to Diagrams 3-25 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make the indicated number of block squares for Block Two through Block Twenty-Four.

make 4





make 2




## Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Diagram 26 on Page 5 when assembling the quilt center.)

- Sew (1) 8 7/8" Fabric X triangle to each side of the Block One square. Sew (1) 9 1/4" Fabric X triangle to the top of the Block One square to make Row One (Diagram 26).
- Repeat Step 4 and refer to Diagram 26 for component identification, placement and orientation to make Row Two through Row Thirteen.
- Sew together the (13) pieced Rows, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to complete the Quilt Center/Quilt Top (Diagram 26).

## Finishing the Quilt

- Layer and quilt as desired.
- Sew together the (8) binding strips end to end with 45-degree seams. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- Bind as desired.
